Mets RHP Carlos Carrasco to Make Rehab Start: New York Mets right-handed pitcher Carlos Carrasco will make another rehab start with the Rumble Ponies today. He tossed threw 33 pitches across his three innings of work on Tuesday at Mirabito Stadium. Carrasco is in his third season with the Mets organization after being traded to New York from Cleveland in 2021, alongside shortstop Francisco Lindor. The 36-year-old made his major league debut for Cleveland in 2004 and is in the middle of his 14th season in the big leagues. He has made three starts for the Mets this season and tied Chris Bassitt with a team-high 15 wins last season.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Hartford Yard Goats 6-5 on Saturday afternoon at Mirabito Stadium. Binghamton scored all five of its runs in the fourth inning, highlighted by an RBI single from Brandon McIlwain, two-run double from Hayden Senger, and RBI single from Tanner Murphy. For the fourth time in this series, Hartford came back in the ninth inning and eventually won.

Pristine Peroza: Infielder **Jose Peroza** has been red-hot in this series. Peroza is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with 11 runs batted in and seven extra base hits against Hartford this week. He has scored seven times and had a three-homer game on Tuesday in the series opener. It was Binghamton's first three-homer game since Jhoan Urena in 2018.

Extra, Extra Read All About It: The Ponies have had success at the plate all series, combining for 34 runs in the first six games. Binghamton has also combined for 23 extra base hits so far in this series. **Jose Peroza** leads the way with seven (three homers and four doubles). Binghamton smacked six doubles on Friday night and added three more on Saturday..

Hartford Rally Goats: The Hartford Yard Goats have four wins in this series, which have all come in come-from-behind fashion. The Yard Goats have scored a combined 12 runs in the ninth inning across their four wins this series, and 13 runs in the ninth or later. Binghamton led by as much as 9-2 on Tuesday, and 7-2 on Friday. Hartford took the lead in the ninth with a solo homer from Bret Boswell on Saturday afternoon.

#21 Carlos Carrasco

BACKGROUND: The 2019 American League Comeback Player of the Year and Roberto Clemente Award winner joined the Mets after he and Francisco Lindor were traded from Cleveland to New York in January of 2021. Carrasco is in the midst of his third season with the Mets. Carrasco, 36, spent 11 seasons with Cleveland (2009-2020) before coming to the Mets. He is 104-87 with a 3.92 ERA in his MLB career.

Carrasco was honored following the 2019 season after being diagnosed with chronic myeloid leukemia in June of that year. After missing two and half months, he returned to the mound on September 1st. The Roberto Clemente Award is awarded annually to the player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

2022: Made 29 starts for the Mets and went 15-7 with a 3.97 ERA. His 15 wins in 2022 were his most in a single season since 2018 (17 wins) and it marked the third-most wins he's ever had in a single season. Carrasco tied Chris Bassitt for the team-lead in wins and ranked third on the team in innings pitched (152.0) and strikeouts (152).

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

He most recently served as the program's Director of Player Development. Cologna was a catcher and pitcher at Avila University from 2017-18 and began his collegiate baseball career at St. Charles Community College.

Austin Dayton - Athletic Trainer - 1st season with Binghamton - 6th year with the Mets organization.
