JUMBO SHRIMP ROLL TO 10-4 WIN

Lorenzo Quintana's bases-clearing double highlighted a four-run seventh and the Jumbo Shrimp added four in the eighth to best Charlotte 10-4. Tristan Pompey's two-run single in the second inning got the scoring started. However, thanks to a Danny Mendick homer in the fourth and Jake Lamb RBI double in the fifth, the Knights were able to tie the score. In the seventh, Zack Zehner walked with the bases loaded before Quintana's three-run two-bagger made it 6-2 Aftere a two-run Lamb shot in the bottom of the seventh, Tevin Mitchell's leadoff long ball in the eighth sparked another four-run frame to put Jacksonville ahead by the winning margin of 10-4.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville's 26-15 (.634) road record trails only Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre's 25-14 (.641) for the best such mark in Triple-A. Oddly enough, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled at 121 Financial Ballpark, going just 17-18 (.486) in games played on the First Coast. The most meaningful difference for the club in games played at home versus on the road has been offensively. On the road, Jacksonville's .752 OPS in away games is the eighth-best such mark in Triple-A East. Additionally, over 41 road contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 208 runs, an average of 5.1 per game. Conversely, at home, Jacksonville has posted just a .711 OPS that places 17th in the 20-team league. The Jumbo Shrimp are also scoring about a run fewer per contest on average, with 143 runs scored in 35 games at 121 Financial Ballpark, a mark of 4.1 per game.

Somewhat miraculously, Jacksonville has won five games in its last at-bat during a current stretch that has seen the Jumbo Shrimp claim nine victories over the last 10 games. This trend has underscored the club's fortunes in close games. The Jumbo Shrimp have won six of their last seven contests decided by one run, boasting a 12-9 mark in onerun affairs on the season. Moreover, Jacksonville is a sterling 25-15 (.625) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, the best winning percentage in narrow affairs in Triple-A East. The club's success in close games helps explain wł dif

"NO. 9. LOOK HIM IN THE EYE, AIM NO HIGHER" The Jumbo Shrimp beat Charlotte 10-4 on Saturday, pushing the club games over .500 for the first time since the 2014 campaign, when Jacksonville finished 22 games above water level. Saturday's victory also marked the ninth win in the last 10 games for the Jumbo Shrimp. During this 10-game run, Jacksonville has outscored its opponents 61-31. The 61 runs scored are the most in Triple-A during this span behind a robust .272/.356/.453 (.808 OPS) batting line. The 31 runs allowed by the Jumbo Shrimp are the third-fewest in Triple-A over this run, with the club registering a 2.89 ERA the leads the level by nearly a half-run.

STARTED NEAR THE BOTTOM, NOW WE HERE

Jacksonville starting pitchers have put up a 4.78 ERA on the season, but their most recent 12 games have shown significant signs of a resurgence. Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers vielded three earned runs or fewer in 11 of those last 12 games, combining for a 2.56 ERA (18 R, 15 ER on 47 H in 52.2 IP). In the club's previous 33 games, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters had combined for a 6.14 ERA (99 R, 93 ER on 137 H in 136.1 IP).

MEN OF STEAL

Jacksonville has stolen 14 bases through the first six games of its series at Charlotte, giving the club 72 for the season, which ranks in a tie for fifth in Triple-A East. The Jumbo Shrimp boast a prolific base stealing threat in Brian Miller, who is tied for the league lead with 22 swipes in 27 attempts (81.5 percent). Meanwhile, Corey Bird ranks in a tie for 12th with 12 steals in 13 attempts (92.3 percent). Next in line are several high-efficiency stolen-base threats like Monte Harrison, who is tied for 20th in the circuit with 10 steals in 11 attempts. Bryson Brigman is 9-for-10 in stolen base attempts and Justin Twine is a perfect 7-for-7 swiping bags.



ABOUT LUIS

-Madero was originally siigned as an international free agent by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2013 for \$160,000. At the 2017 trade deadline, he was traded by Arizona to the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for RHP David Hernandez.

-Following the 2018 season, the Angels protected Madero from the Rule 5 draft by placing him on the 40-man roster. However, the right-hander was designated for assignment in January 2020 and claimed by the San Francisco Giants. After becoming a free agent following the 2020 season, Madero signed with the Miami Marlins on December 20, 2020.

2021 SEASON

-Madero made his major league debut on May 10 at Arizona, firing two scoreless innings and scattering a hit and walk against one strikeout. He pitched again the following day before Miami designated him for assignment. After the right-hander cleared waivers, he was outrighted on May 16 to Jacksonville. The Marlins selected Madero's contract again on July 20, and he pitched 1.0 scoreless inning on July 23 against San Diego before being designated for assignment and outrighted again to Jacksonville.

-Madero competed for Team Venezuela in the Olympic Trials, missing more than a month of the regular season.

2019 SEASON

-After posting a 1.13 ERA in four outings with High-A Inland Empire, earned a promotion to Double-A Mobile on April 27, 2019.

-Madero yielded no more than three earned runs in five of his first six appearances with Mobile, including a 1.67 ERA in the month of May. After the All-Star Break, Madero made 12 starts, but was stung for a 7.30 ERA with 77 hits allowed in 49.1 innings.

-With Mobile, left-handers hit nine home runs in 172 at-bats (19.1 AB/HR). However, he held right-handed hitters to just two homers over 202 at-bats (101 AB/HR).

2018 SEASON

-Earned a promotion on July 6, 2018 from Low-A Burlington to High-A Inland Empire. Madero gave up three earned runs or fewer in 11 of his 14 starts prior to his promotion.

-The right-hander was named a Midwest League Midseason All-Star while pitching for the Bees. In his first outing with Inland Empire, Madero worked six shutout innings on July 10, 2018 at Lake Elsinore.

-Left-handed hitters posted a .320 average against Madero while he pitched for Inland Empire. Conversely, he held right-handed batters to a .214 mark.

-In Burlington, opponents batted .317 in the first inning, and in Inland Empire, that mark rose to .324. Outside of the fifth inning with Inland Empire (.320), Madero held opponents' below .300 in each frame he pitched in.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Madero plunked 13 batters in 66.2 innings in 2014, his first professional season. In the 339.0 frames he threw in the minor leagues from 2015-2019, he hit just 14 opposing hitters.
