Today: It's the first Capital City Market Kids Day of the year: inflatables, balloon-twisting, face-painting, Kids Run the Bases after the game, followed by an Extra Inning of free ice cream and music across the street at Capital City Market, as the Lugnuts play the finale in a six-game set against the Great Lakes Loons. The Loons have won three of the first five games in the series; they send Tuesday's starter, Christian Romero, to the mound vs. Lugs right-hander Grant Judkins, who fired four hitless innings in his first start.

Yesterday: Loons 12, Lugnuts 6. Center fielder Rodney Green, Jr. sparked a four-run first inning with a leadoff home run, helping the Lugnuts build leads of 4-0 and 6-3, but the Loons scored seven runs in the seventh inning on their way to the Saturday matinee victory. In the loss, the Nuts collected 16 hits but stranded 16 runners on base.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head on the road to Appleton, Wisconsin, opening up a six-game series against the Timber Rattlers featuring a scheduled Friday doubleheader. The next Nuts home game arrives on Tuesday, April 22, beginning a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days against Fort Wayne and Lake County.

**2010:** With the score tied at 1-1 in the top of the ninth inning at Great Lakes, the Lugnuts called upon slugger Brad Glenn to pinch-hit. Glenn came through with a tie-breaking home run to give the Lugnuts a three-game sweep at Dow Diamond with a 2-1 win.

2018: Seventh-inning magic: The Lugnuts (6-3) scored four runs in the seventh to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps (6-2), 4-2, in a battle of Eastern Division powerhouses at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2024: Ten days after walloping a grand slam in the Crosstown Showdown, Will Simpson knocked a grand slam against the Great Lakes Loons... but the Lugnuts were still swept in a Saturday doubleheader, 12-1 and 8-5.

Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.
