**Today:** It's the first **Capital City Market Kids Day** of the year: inflatables, balloon-twisting, face-painting, Kids Run the Bases after the game, followed by an Extra Inning of free ice cream and music across the street at Capital City Market, as the Lugnuts play the finale in a six-game set against the Great Lakes Loons. The Loons have won three of the first five games in the series; they send Tuesday's starter, **Christian Romero**, to the mound vs. Lugs right-hander **Grant Judkins**, who fired four hitless innings in his first start.

**Yesterday:** **Loons 12, Lugnuts 6.** Center fielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** sparked a four-run first inning with a leadoff home run, helping the Lugnuts build leads of 4-0 and 6-3, but the Loons scored seven runs in the seventh inning on their way to the Saturday matinee victory. In the loss, the Nuts collected 16 hits but stranded 16 runners on base.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts head on the road to Appleton, Wisconsin, opening up a six-game series against the Timber Rattlers featuring a scheduled Friday doubleheader. The next Nuts home game arrives on Tuesday, April 22, beginning a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days against Fort Wayne and Lake County.

### LUG•NOTES

**Best in the League:** The Lugnuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.265), walks (49), fewest strikeouts (58) and on-base percentage (.392)... though the Nuts also rank 1st in runners left on base (85).

**Traffic on the Bases:** One of the reasons for Lansing's offensive success has been how well the Nuts have knocked around the Loons' pitchers. In five games of this series, the Lugnuts are hitting .315 with a .439 on-base percentage, averaging 10 hits and six walks per game.

**Epic:** Yesterday's game had 29 combined hits (16 by Lansing); 17 walks (11 issued by the Lugnuts); 30 stranded base runners (16 by the Nuts); and a whopping 421 combined pitches.

**Best in the Minors:** A level below the Nuts on the A's organizational ladder, the Stockton Ports' pitching corps has lowest ERA in all of Minor League Baseball (1.73) and leads the Minors with the fewest walks issued (20) while striking out 95 batters in 72 2/3 innings. Yesterday, **Tzu-Chen Sha** fanned nine in six scoreless innings and **Jefferson Jean** followed with seven strikeouts in three scoreless innings in the Ports' 3-0 win over Rancho Cucamonga. In their first outing of the season, Sha and Jean had combined on a no-hitter at Fresno.

**Up the Ladder:** Former Lugnut **Jacob Wilson** (2023 in Lansing) extended his hitting streak to an MLB-high 15 games with an RBI double in the A's 3-1 victory over the Mets last night. Wilson's 20 hits are tied for second most in the Majors, and his .368 batting average ranks third in the American League.

**Green Power:** OF **Rodney Green, Jr.** is tied for the Midwest League lead with three home runs, tied for third with seven runs scored, is fifth in the circuit with 18 total bases.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 30.

**Welcome Back:** The Lugnuts' roster features 17 returning players, from position players **Jonny Butler**, **Cole Conn**, **Jared Dickey**, **Clark Elliott**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Nate Nankil**, **CJ Rodriguez**, **T.J. Schofield-Sam** and **Casey Yamauchi** to pitchers **Mark Adamiak**, **Hunter Breault**, **Jake Garland**, **Garrett Irvin**, **Grant Judkins**, **Blaze Pontes** and **Yehizon Sanchez**.

**Atop the Minors:** 2024 Athletics first-rounder **Nick Kurtz** jumped over Lansing on his way up A's system and is currently excelling with Triple-A Las Vegas. Kurtz leads Minor League Baseball with seven home runs, 13 extra-base hits, 49 total bases and 21 RBIs. Additionally, former Lugnut **Grant Holman** is tied for the MiLB lead with three saves.

**2010:** With the score tied at 1-1 in the top of the ninth inning at Great Lakes, the Lugnuts called upon slugger Brad Glenn to pinch-hit. Glenn came through with a tie-breaking home run to give the Lugnuts a three-game sweep at Dow Diamond with a 2-1 win.

**2018:** Seventh-inning magic: The Lugnuts (6-3) scored four runs in the seventh to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps (6-2), 4-2, in a battle of Eastern Division powerhouses at Cooley Law School Stadium.

**2024:** Ten days after walloping a grand slam in the Crosstown Showdown, Will Simpson knocked a grand slam against the Great Lakes Loons... but the Lugnuts were still swept in a Saturday doubleheader, 12-1 and 8-5.

**History:** Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

**At Pella High School:** 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

**Onward to Des Moines:** Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

**International Stage:** With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
