LAST OUTING: Small totaled a career high 102 pitches in his last start on June 14 to open the series. He took the loss, allowing five runs (all earned) on four hits and five walks. The loss was his second in as many starts for the Sounds.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is facing Memphis for the third time in his career and the second time this season. His only outing against the Redbirds (before Tuesday) came on September 10, 2021 at First Horizon Park. Small pitched 4.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 2 BB, 2 K) in Nashville's 8-2 win that night.
