David Griffin earned the win and Paul Gervase and Daison Acosta shut the door behind him with a combined 3.1 no-hit frames in relief. Every hitter in the lineup recorded a hit.

Ruiz Rampage: Outfielder **Agustin Ruiz** had his third-straight multi-hit game on Saturday night. Ruiz crushed his third home run of the series with a two-run shot, and he now has a team-leading 17 homers. Ruiz has now recorded an RBI in seven of his last eight games, with 11 RBIs in that span. Over his last eight games, Ruiz is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with a 1.529 OPS, four home runs, 11 runs batted in, eight runs scored, seven walks, a .529 OBP, and 1.000 SLG. He has seven hits, five RBIs, and two homers in his last three games.

Action Jackson: Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** singled twice and drove in two runs on Saturday night, extending his hitting streak to 11 games. Jackson is the fourth Rumble Ponies hitter to have a hitting streak of 10+ games this season. Over his 11-game hitting streak, Jackson is hitting .310 (13 hits) with three homers, eight runs batted in, six runs scored, and a .912 OPS. He homered in each of the first three games in this series and has five runs batted in this week.

JT Slams: First baseman JT Schwartz had three hits and three runs batted in on Saturday night. It was Schwartz's fifth game with three-plus hits and sixth game with three-plus RBIs. He is currently riding an 12-game on-base streak. Over his last 12 games, Schwartz has 13 hits, 12 RBIs, four doubles, a homer, seven runs, 11 walks, and an .891 OPS. He has four hits and has driven in seven runs over the past two games. Schwartz belted the second grand slam of his professional career and first of his Double-A career on Friday night. His first professional grand slam came for High-A Brooklyn last season on July 27 at Hudson Valley.

Rhylan is Riding: Outfielder **Rhylan Thomas** recorded two hits and scored a run in his Double-A debut on Saturday night. The 23-year-old slashed .368/.444/.462 with a .906 OPS for High-A Brooklyn in his final 35 games (since July 4) with the Cyclones. He drew 17 walks (12.6 BB%) to only eight strikeouts (5.9 K%) in that span. Since the start of July, the former USC product led the South Atlantic League in batting average (.358) and he had seven fewer strikeouts (9) than any other batter (min. 130 PA). Thomas also ranked 2nd in on-base percentage (.439) in the SAL since the start of July.

Last Appearance: Juarez tossed 1.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen on Wednesday at New Hampshire. He gave up one hit and one walk with two strikeouts.

Last Start: Juarez threw three no-hit innings on August 18, the Friday night game against Portland last series. He allowed no runs and no hits, while allowing two walks with three strikeouts. He left the game with the Ponies leading 5-0

2022: Juarez made 26 appearances for Class-A St. Lucie and five for High-A Brooklyn. He did not allow a run over his five appearances with the Cyclones last season, and that carried into this year. Juarez did not allow an earned run in 12 appearances with Brooklyn this season, meaning he did not allow an earned run over 15 appearances in High-A since last season.

BACKGROUND: He signed with the Mets as an international free agent on January 30, 2019, out of Venezuela. He played for the DSL Mets in 2019, both rookie ball and St. Lucie in 2021, and St. Lucie and Brooklyn in 2022 and Brooklyn and Binghamton in 2023. He has made 84 career appearances and two starts in the minors. He is 9-5 with a 2.27 ERA in his career with seven saves, 200 career strikeouts in 143.0 innings, and a 1.07 WHIP.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization. Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays.
