TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints offense bounced back with an 8-2 victory over lowa on Saturday night. Yunior Severino got the offense started with an RBI single in the first inning to give the Saints a 1-0 lead. Chris Williams hit a solo home run in the second inning to make it 2-0. Then in the fourth inning, the Saints plated four runs. Anthony Prato doubled to bring in Alex Isola, followed by an RBI single from Edouard Julien. Two batters later, Severino and Keirsey Jr. singled to score two more runs. Meanwhile, Louie Varland spun 5.0 scoreless innings, striking out seven. The Saints pushed their lead to 8-0 in the sixth thanks to a wild pitch that scored Matt Wallner and an Isola RBI single. After the I-Cubs grabbed a pair in the seventh, Ryan Jensen and Jeff Brigham tossed 2.0 no-hit innings to finish the win. LAST TIME OUT: The Saints offense bounced back with an 8-2 victory innings to finish the win.

BORN TO RUN: While the Saints may be in the middle of the pack with their 82 stolen bases this season, they have picked their spots well. The clubs is successful on 85.4% of their stolen base attempts, the sixth-best rate in the league. The Saints are also perfect on their last 15 steal attempts since June 20. It's the second-best streak in the league, trailing Columbus, who have not been thrown out in their last 27 attempts dating back to June 17.

SUNDAY SCARIES: Sundays have not been kind to the Saints pitching staff in 2024. Their Sunday ERA is 7.07, with their next-closest the 5.81 ERA on Tuesdays. The 89 hits and 20 long balls allowed on Sundays are also the most of any day of the week. They have, however, walked only 38 batters on Sundays, their fewest of any day.

DK SMASHING: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. is on a season-long, 13-game hit by Symashing: Dashawn Keirsey Jr. is on a season-long, 13-game hit streak, dating back to May 21, prior to his stint on the Injured List. Over the streak, Keirsey Jr. is hitting .407 (24-for-59), with a .419 on-base percentage and a .678 slugging percentage. He's hit four doubles and four home runs over the 13-game streak. Keirsey Jr. is the fifth different Saints batter to collect a 13-game hit streak, only four have made it to 14-or-more games. The franchise record is 17 games, set by Andrew Stevenson from June 8-July 3, 2023.

JUNE JOLT: June has been a major turning point for the Saints in 2024. They lead all full-season clubs with a .391 on-base percentage in June, ranking second in batting average (.295) slugging percentage (.521) and OPS (.914). Their 161 runs scored this month are the seventh-most and their 46 homers are the fourth-most. The 133 walks drawn are the third-most. Below is how the Saints' offense has fared in each month this

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 31 games since May 21, he has hit .396 (44-for-111), with nine home runs, drawing 26 walks to 29 strikeouts, owning a 1.178 OPS. In June, Severino leads the IL in batting average (.414), on-base percentage, sporting a .556 clip, and OPS, at 1.267, ranking second in slugging percentage at .711. His 21 June walks are tied for the the third-most in the league.

Severino is having one of the best months a for a Saints hitter in franchise history. Severino's .437 June batting average is the highest for any Saints player (min. 35 PA's) in any month dating back to 2021. His .564 on-base percentage is also the highest and his 1.267 OPS is the third-highest. He's also just the eighth player to register a 30-hit month in franchise history.

WALLNER WARMING UP: In his 24 June games, Matt Wallner has hit .317/.400/.723 sporting a 1.123 OPS. He's hit a league-high 12 home runs in his this month, averaging a 93.3 mph exit velocity and owns a .406 ISO in that span. He's also the league leader in June in RBI (28), total bases (73), slugging percentage, and extra-base hits (17) and runs (27)

(27). \$\\$ Wallner's 12 home runs in June are the most for any Triple-A player in any month this season and tied for the most for any IL batter in any month since 2021. Wallner is the 18th IL batter since 2021 to hit 10 home runs in a month and just the second Saint to accomplish the feat, joining Chris Williams, who hit 10 home runs in lune of 2023.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins combined to strike out 15 Seattle Mariners in a 5-1 victory on Saturday. Pablo López punched out nine hitters across six innings, allowing one run. The offense backed him up with a three-run homer from Byron Buxton in the sixth inning. Carlos Santana also collected three hits in the win.

NOT PERFECT, BUT STILL PRETTY GOOD: On June 2, 2018, Plutko was spinning a gem with Columbus, not allowing a baserunner until the ninth inning at Syracuse when he issued a one-out walk. He followed that with a fly out and a strikeout to finish off the no-hitter. It was just the ninth complete-game no-hitter in the IL since 2005. It continued a stellar stretch for Plutko, who took a no-hitter
