#### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Matt Gorski's 12th home run of the season alone could not lift the Indianapolis Indians from an early deficit as they suffered a 3-1 loss to the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp on Wednesday night at 121 Financial Ballpark. Following a leadoff single by Andrés Alvarez to begin the game, the Indians offense was held hitless as Jacksonville took a three-run lead. Two runs came in the second inning, with Victor Mesa Jr. tacking on insurance with a solo home run in the fifth. The Indians got back in the hit column in the seventh courtesy of a leadoff home run by Gorski. A two-out rally attempt continued from there, with Gilberto Celestino reaching safely on an error and Alvarez's second hit of the night setting up runners at the corners. Joshua Palacios, playing in his second game back from the injured list, struck out to end the threat.

HE PACKED THE POWER: Matt Gorski jumped back on his hot streak of home runs last night, plating the Indians lone run with a solo shot in the seventh inning. It was his first home run since June 2, with his seven consecutive homerless games marking the longest streak without a home run in his last 25 games dating back to May 16. Eleven of his 12 home runs this season have come in that 25-game stretch, and in that time he owns a .286 batting average (26-for-91) with 20 runs, 18 extra-base hits, 29 RBI, .747 slugging percentage and 1.087 OPS. Through 51 games this season, Gorski is over halfway to besting his 2023 season total of 20 home runs in 108 games. The Fishers, Ind. native launched a career-high 24 home runs in 81 games between Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis in 2022.

ALVAREZ FOR TWO: Andrés Alvarez broke a 0-for-14 stretch with two of Indianapolis' three hits last night at Jacksonville. He opened the game with a single. Indy's lone hit until the seventh inning when Matt Gorski homered to lead off the frame. With two outs and Gilberto Celestino on base following an error, Alvarez was well-timed in his second hit to set up runners at the corners. With runners on base, the infielder is hitting 263 (15-for-57) with two extra-base hits and nine RBI. The two-single performance was Alvarez's eighth this season with Indianapolis, following a career-high four-hit game on June 5 vs. Columbus.

SPLITS FOR THIS STRETCH: The Indians offense has been in a slump as of late, being held to a season-low three hits for the second time in their past three games last night. The offense boomed over its first 33 games, outhitting opponents in 18 of 33 contests (total of 299 hits compared to 277 by opponents) en route to a 17-16 record through May 9, the last time the Indians were above .500. Since, they have been outhit by their opponent in 16 of 30 contests (being outhit 291-242) en route to a 9-21 record over their last 30 games. The Indians have hit 26 fewer doubles over their past 30 games than in their first 33, while hitting 15 more home runs in the second stretch than the first. TONIGHT'S PROBABLES: In the third game of the six-game series between the Indians and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp at 121 Financial Ballpark, the Indians will send RHP Braxton Ashcraft to the mound for his Triple-A debut (more listed below). Countering for Jacksonville is RHP Valente Bellozo (0-1, 7.71), making his fourth career Triple-A start after being promoted from Double-A Pensacola on May 21.

AFFILIATES TO ADVERSARIES: This week marks the first time the Indians have played a team from Jacksonville since they last faced a different franchise in the International League during the 1963 season. The current Jacksonville franchise served under Indianapolis as the Double-A affiliate to the Montreal Expos from 1985-90, with a roster boasting future Hall of Famers Randy Johnson and Larry Walker before they became Indians. With the realignment of Minor League Baseball in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp moved from the Double-A Southern League to the International League.

CRAFTING: Pittsburgh Pirates No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, RHP Braxton Ashcraft, was promoted from Double-A Altoona to Indianapolis on Tuesday ahead of his Triple-A debut tonight vs. Jacksonville. He began the season with the Curve, going 2-for-2 with a 3.69 ERA (22er/53.1ip) and 63 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts). The right-hander's season has been highlighted by his first career complete-game on May 2 (1) at Harrisburg and a career-high 12-strikeout performance in his final Double-A start on June 6 at Richmond. Ashcraft was selected by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson (Waco, Texas) High School.

ALIKA ON THE MEND: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that infielder Alika Williams will begin a rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians as they continue a six-game road trip at the Jacksonville tonight. The 25-year-old was placed on the 10-day injured list on June 2 (retroactive to May 30) with a right wrist sprain. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster and hit .210 (13-for-62) with eight runs and three extra-base hits in 23 games. He split time between both middle infield positions, logging a .971 fielding percentage (two errors, 68 total chances) combined. The infielder swung a hot bat with Indianapolis last season, hitting .305 (39-for-128) with 25 runs, eight doubles, seven home runs and 20 RBI in 36 games prior to making his major league debut with Pittsburgh on July 25 at San Diego.

THIS DATE IN 2005: After losing Game 1 of a doubleheader vs. Ottawa, 2-1, starting pitcher Rodney Bolton tossed a 7.0-inning complete game shutout to win the nightcap, 3-0. Bolton improved to 6-5 on the season with the win as he surrendered hits runs, two walks and struck out five. The Indians were backed by an RBI single in the first off the bat of Mike Frank and a two-run homer by Mark Johnson in the fourth inning.

**Braxton Ashcraft:** Right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline Braxton Ashcraft is set to make his Triple-A debut tonight at Jacksonville.

**Last Outing:** Ashcraft struck out a career-high 12 batters in his Double-A finale on June 6 at Richmond, logging a career-high tying 7.0 innings on 93 pitches (74 strikes) to earn his second win of the season.

**Against the Jumbo Shrimp:** Ashcraft has never faced Jacksonville.

**Prospectus:** Ashcraft entered the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 10 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 10 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, jumping up from being ranked No. 22 in '21 and undergoing Tommy John surgery later that season.

**Miscellaneous:** Ashcraft was selected by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). ... Had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
