#### SPRINGFIELD TAKES DOWN FRISCO IN 10 INNING THRILLER, 10-8:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Springfield Cardinals 10-8 on Thursday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (23-19, 67-44) found the run column in the bottom of the first inning against Springfield (26-16, 63-48) starter Max Rajcic when **Abimelec Ortiz** singled to drive in Maximo Acosta. A single by **Aaron Zavala** with a throwing error attached allowed Ortiz to score, giving the Riders an early 2-0 lead. **Kumar Rocker**, making his fourth start for Frisco, surrendered his first run after Nathan Church led off the fourth inning with a double and later scored on a groundout to cut the Riders advantage to 2-1. Rocker, the Rangers No. 2 prospect, finished after 4.0 innings where he allowed just the one run on one hit and a walk with five punchouts. The RoughRiders added a run in the home half of the fourth inning where Acosta doubled home **Keyber Rodriguez** to bring the game to a 3-1 score. Springfield came back within a run in the top of the sixth inning against **Damian Mendoza**. Church belted his second double of the game and came around to score on an RBI single by R.J. Yeager. In the visiting half of the seventh, Springfield erupted against Ricky DeVito as they manufactured five runs to take a 7-3 lead. **Larson Kindreich** inherited the bases loaded, allowing each to score. Frisco responded with a dramatic four-run bottom of the seventh, Rodriguez drove in Ortiz with a single before a three-run homer from **Daniel Mateo** evened the game at 7-7. Springfield took the lead in the top of the eighth inning, using a leadoff double by Rotondo and a sacrifice fly from Church to earn an 8-7 advantage. Trailing by a run in the bottom of the ninth, Zavala launched a solo homer to right field to send the game to extras. **Florencio Serrano** (0-3) sat down the first batter he faced in the 10th before allowing an RBI single to Bryan Torres. Torres later scored on an infield single from Jimmy Crooks to give Springfield a 10-8 lead. He finished after 2.0 innings where he surrendered two runs (one earned) on three hits while fanning two. Needing two runs to push the game to the 11th frame, Jack Ralston (5-1) held the Riders scoreless in the tenth to earn the win. Offensively, Frisco collected 14 hits with Acosta leading the way with three hits. Ortiz, Zavala, Rodriguez, Mateo and **Luis Mieses** each recorded two hits.

#### PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strength this season, but the Cardinals have dominated this series on the offensive side. This series, Springfield is hitting .375 (45-for-120)/.400/.517/.917 with nine doubles, two home runs and averaging 7.7 runs per game on the offensive side. Frisco's bullpen has a 12.66 ERA and has allowed 25 hits over 10.2 innings this series while blowing saves in all three games.

#### START ME UP

RoughRidders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last 15 games, owning a 1.91 ERA (16ER/75.1IP). The Riders have played incredibly close games over the last 15 games with 13 of the 15 games being decided by three runs or fewer (Frisco is 5-8 in those

#### RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 21 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .719 OPS, first with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.1 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .191 (37-for-194) with runners in scoring position over their last 21 games

#### READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his four starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 15.0 innings, allowing just one run on six hits and two walks with 21 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 12.2 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

#### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-18 at Riders Field this season. The Riders have now lost three home games in a row for the first time since September 7-9, 2023. At home this season, Frisco has a +68 run differential, a 3.91 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .759 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** is slashing .341/.397/.590/.987 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .341 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.



-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and IT Realmuto.
