HOME SWEET HOME: After splitting last week's road series in Lynchburg, the FredNats return home to the friendly confines of Virginia Credit Union Stadium for the first full homestand of 2024 against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers, Single-A affiliate of the Houston Astros. In a scheduling quirk, this is Fayetteville's first-ever trip to Fredericksburg since VACU Stadium opened in 2021. Fredericksburg has only traveled to Fayetteville the last two seasons, but this week marks the only meeting in the 2024 regular season for the two clubs that share the spring training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. The Woodpeckers are the final team to visit Fredericksburg, meaning all 11 of the other current Carolina League clubs have now played in this ballpark. Georgia lefty Liam Sullivan gets the ball in the series opener, for FXBG, and pitched into the 5th inning with a career-high nine strikeouts in his first start of the year last week against the Hillcats. The FredNats are 6-3, 2.0 games behind Carolina in the North Division standings, while Fayetteville (also 6-3), is tied for the lead in the South Division with the Columbia Fireflies in the early stages of the first half.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: The FredNats scored 29 combined runs in two easy wins in the first two games of the series, then a rainout Thursday brought the first loss of the season on Friday when the Hillcats scored 10 runs in the first three innings. The two teams split a doubleheader Saturday to make up for the Thursday rainout, and then the Freddies tried to climb out of a 6-0 hole on Sunday, but ultimately came up short, falling 7-5.

STRONG STARTS: The FredNats have several hitters near the top of the Carolina League leaderboards through the first nine games of the season. Brandon Pimentel leads the league in RBI (14), slugging (.700), and total bases (21) and 4th in OPS (1.087). Pimentel and Gavin Dugas are tied for the league lead in doubles (4), and Dugas is 2nd in batting average (.435), 2nd in OBP (.536) and 2nd in OPS (1.145). Phillip Glasser is 4th in average (.393), and tied for third in hits with 11. Elijah Green is the league leader runs scored with 11.

PROSPECTS IN THE 'BURG: Three of the Nationals' Top-30 prospects are beginning the season with Fredericksburg. All three spent time with the FredNats in 2023, and all three of those prospects are ranked in the Top-10 in the system. Elijah Green is ranked as the 6th-best prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline, Cristhian Vaquero is the 9th-best, and Jarlin Susana is the 10th ranked prospect. All three are also in the Top-10 in the Baseball America prospect rankings.

ANOTHER TO THE SHOW: Last night, 2021 FredNat Mitchell Parker became the sixth FredNat to make his Major League debut since the team moved to FXBG in 2020. Parker got the win for the Nats on the mound against the powerful Los Angeles Dodgers last night, pitching five innings of two-run ball with four strikeouts. He joins Amos Willingham ('21), Jackson Rutledge ('21 &'22), Jose A. Ferrer ('22), Jacob Young ('22) and Trey Lipscomb ('22) as former FredNats to debut in Major Leagues. All made their debuts with Washington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 147-123 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Liam Sullivan is making second start of the year for the FredNats tonight, against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. Drafted out of Georgia in the 13th round last year, Sullivan recorded a 5.28 ERA with a 1.50 WHIP for the Nats last year, in six appearances. The big lefty also struck out 24 batters in 15.1 IP.

GOT THAT DAWG IN HIM: Sullivan was primarily a starter for the Bulldogs, making 42 appearances total with 30 starts. In his final season at UGA, Sullivan was exclusively a starter in his 14 games. The big lefty sported a 5-2 record, with 75 punchouts to just 33 walks in 64 innings of work.

For his career, Sullivan holds a 10-7 record in 151.0 innings, to go along with 178 K's and 73 BB. He also spent a summer in the prestigous Cape Cod Summer League, with the Harwich Mariners. On the cape, Sullivan sported a 2.17 ERA in eight appearances (five starts), while punching out 14 batters per nine innings.

FAMILY TIES: Liam has two older brothers who both played college baseball. Ryan was a first baseman at Rhodes College from 2019 to 2021, and Patrick was also a first baseman at Georgia from 2016 to 2020.

AGAINST FAYETTEVILLE: Sullivan did not face the Woodpeckers in 2023, so both sides will be getting their first look at each other tonight.
