



runs down to take an 8-3 win over the Visalia Rawhide at LoanMart Field. RBI hits from Jose Meza, Samuel Munoz and Carlos Rojas got the Quakes even. Kendall George broke the tie with a bases-loaded walk, before Wilman Diaz blew it open with a three-run triple off Visalia starter Casey Anderson (2-6). Rancho's bullpen got shutout work from Felix Cabrera (3-2), Reynaldo Yean, Callum Wallace and Christian Ruebeck to seal their second straight win overall. WELCOME TO TOWN: The Quakes got an exciting debut from Alexander Albertus last Tuesday night. He saved a run in the fourth inning, when he made a diving catch at third base with a runner at second. He later tied the game with his first hit in a Rancho uniform, a solo blast to left field. He finished the game 1-for-4 and followed it up on Wednesday with two sacrifice flies. On Thursday, he again made a huge impact, as he went 2-for-5 with two runs scored and an RBI. Friday night, he struck out three times, but also had a two-run double. Albertus hit .342 in 32 games in the ACL this year, slugging two homers with 26 RBIs and more walks (27) than strikeouts (20). **SECOND HALF STUFF:** In order to make the playoffs in 2024, the Quakes must win the second half, or else finish

second in the South Division's second-half race, while having the first-half champion Storm win the division again. The Storm will meet the second-half winner or the team with the next best second-half record. Lake Elsinore last went to the playoffs in 2022, when they won the Cal League title. Modesto won the North Division First Half Title. JOE KELLY: Right-hander Joe Kelly of the Los Angeles Dodgers is scheduled to start and throw one inning for the Quakes tonight, as part of a rehab assignment. Kelly has been on the Injured List since early May, making his last appearance on May 5 against the Atlanta Braves. In 15 games this year, Kelly was 0-0 with a 4.73 ERA for the Dodgers

across 13.1 innings. Kelly pitched for the Quakes on rehab assignment on two occasions in 2021 and then again in 2023, when he made two more appearances. Kelly, who won a World Series with the Dodgers in 2020, is currently in his second stint with the Dodgers, after spending 2022 and part of 2023 with the Chicago White Sox. Kelly was originally drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 2009 draft out of UC Riverside.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta is scheduled to follow Joe Kelly tonight, as he was the originally-scheduled starter. This will be Zazueta's fifth appearance overall and third in relief, his second outing against Visalia. Made his Cal League debut against Visalia on June 7, allowing three runs on five hits over four innings in a no-decision. Zazueta was acquired by the Dodgers in a trade with the New York Yankees in February of 2024 for former Quake Caleb Ferguson. Zazueta was originally signed by the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico.

DANIEL NUNEZ: Right-hander Daniel Nunez will make his 11th appearance and second start for Visalia, his first start against Rancho and third overall appearance. In two relief outings against the Quakes, he's given up just three hits over four scoreless innings. In his last start, he scattered two hits over four scoreless innings at Inland Empire on June 26 in a no-decision. Nunez was signed by Arizona out of Mexico in December of 2023.
