Today: It's the first game of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, and the host West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Tigers. The Nuts are 2-4 vs. West Michigan this season, losing a home series at the end of June; 18 more meetings remain between the two clubs this year.

Sunday: Lugnuts 1, Loons 0. **Jonny Butler's** RBI double in the eighth inning supplied the game's only run, helping the Nuts avert a three-game home sweep at the hands of Great Lakes. It was the Nuts' second 1-0 win of the season – and the first since Opening Night at Dayton. **Jacob Watters, Garrett Irvin** and **Will Johnston** not only combined on a five-hit shutout, they struck out nine straight batters from the 4th through the 7th innings.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, **Adam Jaks** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, enjoy an off day on July 29, and then welcome in the Dayton Dragons for a six-game series running from July 30 - August 4. Only three more homestands remain in the Nuts' 28th season.

LUG•NOTES

To the Show: 2023 Nuts sensation **Jacob Wilson** made his Major League debut on July 19, starting at shortstop for the A's and collecting a single in his first at-bat before leaving with a strained hamstring. Wilson became the fifth former Lugnut to make his MLB debut this year and the 189th all-time player to work his way from Lansing to the Majors. He played only 72 games in Minor League Baseball, posting a career .401 batting average; with the Nuts, Wilson hit .318 in 23 games to conclude last season.

All-Star Alumni: The Lugnuts were represented in the MLB All-Star Game by 2017 Nuts alum **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went hitless, and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller**, who tossed a perfect frame for the A.L., striking out **Shohei Ohtani** and **Trea Turner** and hitting 103.6 mph, the fastest pitch in All-Star Game history.

What a Crowd! The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in the Midwest League this season, leading all High-A single game attendances this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

SC Top 10: CF **Ryan Lasko's** leaping catch at the wall on Saturday on a drive from Great Lakes' **Thayron Liranzo** made No. 7 on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays.

Prospecting: The Nuts have four Top 30 A's prospects on their roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 15), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), and pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27), as ranked by MLB Pipeline.

The Future is Here: 21-year-old **Luis Morales**, the youngest player on the Lugnuts, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out **Jeral Perez** and **Deyvison De Los Santos** alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the Prospect Showcase, and the fifth all-time Lugnut to participate in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: It took 16 innings, 10 combined errors and 29 combined hits, but the Lugnuts finally put away the Swing of the Quad Cities, 11-10, in a franchise record five hours and 31 minutes.

2010: For the second straight start, Ryan Tepera and his relievers combined on a one-hitter, with only Leonardo Gil's one-out infield single in the 5th stopping the no-hitter in a 3-0 home win over Kane County before 8,912. Tepera tossed the first five innings, followed by Scott Gracey (2 IP) and Matt Wright and Nestor Molina pitching an inning apiece, and Kevin Ahrens and Sean Ochinko each homered.

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Lugnuts Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, June 2, after promotion from Stockton, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Temporarily Inactive List: Inactive from June 28-July 4, returning to Taiwan in connection to compulsory military enlistment.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).

Path to Lansing: Pitched at National Taiwan Sport University, signing with the Athletics in November 2021 for approx. \$500,000... debuted in 2022 with Stockton, making eight starts from April 12 - June 1, 2022... did not pitch again until April 10, 2024, a hiatus of 679 days between professional appearances... excelled with Stockton this season, never allowing more than one run in an appearance... of nine total appearances with the Ports, did not walk a batter in seven of them.

He will be known in English romanisation as Chen Zhang-Ao (given name) Zhuang (family name)."

Last Time Out: Won his first professional game! Tossed four innings of two-hit, one-run ball at Lake County in relief of Will Johnston, and the Lugnuts rallied for a 6-5 win on a Braylan Buevas two-run go-ahead double in the ninth inning off league-leading closer Magnus Ellerts.

Back Home: Signed for \$75,000... high school teammates with current Lugnuts teammate Hunter Breault, who was one year older at Kamehameha-Kapalama H.S... graduated HS with 3.5 GPA... played club ball for Team California Baseball, top 10 nationally ranked... First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... notable Rainbow Warriors in the pros include Cleveland's Cade Smith, Seattle's Josh Rojas, longtime infielder Kolton Wong and former Brewers closer Chuck Crim.

The Aloha State: The most career MLB games for any Hawaiian: former A's catcher Kurt Suzuki, 1,635, who also owns the most career homers (143); among pitchers, Charlie Hough's 25-year career stands alone. Former Lugnuts from Hawai'i include Dustin Antolin (also from Mililani) and Bryson Namba. 2009 lights-out closer Matt Daly is the only other Lugnut in team history to play ball at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.
