LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its second-straight victory with a 3-2 triumph at Wilmington...The Cyclones jumped in front for good in the second inning on a three-run home run by DH **Estarling Mercado**...LF **D'Andre Smith** extended his hitting streak with a 9th-inning single and RF **Omar De Los Santos** stole his 36th base of the year...Brooklyn's LHP **Zach Thornton** tossed 5.0 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball to earn his first High-A win...RHP **Eduardo Herrera** recorded the final 6 outs to earn his 3rd save with the Cyclones...SS **Armando Cruz** powered a solo home run for Wilmington.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 17, 2008, CF **Sean Rattliff** clubbed a game-tying solo home run in the bottom of the 9th...A fielder's choice and a throwing error off the bat of SS **Juan Lagares** brought home the winning run in a 6-5, 10-inning win vs. Tri-City...In 2012, CF **Brandon Nimmo** tied a franchise record with 6 RBI during a 3-for-6 performance, adding a 9th-inning grand slam in a 12-4 win at Tri-City...In 2011, the Cyclones added former Brooklyn Dodgers and New York Mets OF **Duke Snider's** No. 4 to the Ring of Honor during Brooklynite at the ballpark...Brooklyn went on to win 5-2 vs. Jamestown...In 2014, RHP **Casey Meisner** struck out 10 over 6.2 innings to earn the win in a 7-3 victory at Vermont...In 2022, former Cyclone INF **Brett Baty** blasted the second pitch he saw in his Major League debut for a two-run home run off RHP **Jake Odorizzi** in the Mets' 9-7 win at Atlanta.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also tied for 10th in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.11), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), tied for ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%), and 11th in strikeouts (129).

TO SMITH-EREENS: UT **D'Andre Smith** has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old picked up his 3rd multi-hit game during a 7-contest hitting streak dating back to the opening game of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...In that span, Smith is hitting .385/.385/.462 with a .847 OPS, 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and 2 stolen bases...The 23-year-old is hitting .276/.288/.362 in 16 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In 10 games this month, Smith is batting .371/.389/.514 with a .903 OPS, 2 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 4 RBI, and 2 steals...The former 5th-round pick is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.371) during August (min. 35 PA).

EXTRA! EXTRA! The Cyclones' offense picked up 7 extra-base hits in Thursday's 8-5 win at Wilmington...The 7 extra-base knocks (6 doubles and a home run) were the most for Brooklyn in a single game since tallying 8 (6 doubles and 2 home runs) in an 8-5 win at Jersey Shore on August 25, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' record for extra-base hits in a game is 10, accomplished on June 24 and July 10, 2010 vs. Hudson Valley and State College, respectively...The 6 doubles in Thursday's game were a season-high for the club and the most since that 6-double performance on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The franchise mark since 2005 is 7, accomplished three times, most recently on August 3, 2015, at Lowell.

NONE SHALL PASS: The Cyclones' bullpen had a 17.2-inning streak without allowing an earned run snapped with DH **T.J. White's** solo home run in the third inning on Thursday...The stretch began in the fourth inning on Saturday vs. Hudson Valley...The 'Clones bullpen did not allow a hit in 11.0 consecutive innings with 19 strikeouts from SS **George Lombard Jr.'s** two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night until 1B **Roismar Quintana's** single in the sixth inning on Wednesday...RHP **Eduardo Herrera**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** also combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the ninth inning on Saturday until one out in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

A DOZEN DONUTS: Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington on Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones had blanked Wilmington in consecutive matchups and had thrown 21 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back from the fifth inning on July 13 until the first inning on Wednesday...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome and Hudson Valley (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win on Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and one hold in his last 5 appearances (4 starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has

vs. WILMINGTON: The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have two of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (4) and OF **Robert Hassell III** (13)...Hassell is with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 7-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 3-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 51-48 all-time against Wilmington (.515).

surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is 4th in the South Atlantic League (min. 20.0 IP) in ERA (1.31), 8th in batting average against (.192), and tied for 9th in strikeouts (27) in that time.

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (87), is 2nd in stolen bases (38), tied for 2nd in games played (77), and 6th in runs scored (50) and batting average (.282)...The former 2nd-round selection is 4th in the SAL in stolen bases (38) and 7th in batting average (.282) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.305), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.396)...He is also 2nd in hits (118), tied for 2nd in runs scored (64), 3rd in total bases (148), tied for 3rd in triples (4), and 5th in OPS (.778).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 25-year-old clubbed a go-ahead three-run home run in the sixth inning on Thursday in Wilmington and powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28...6 of his 7 home runs since returning from Double-A Binghamton tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for 2nd in the league in triples (2) and home runs (6), tied for 4th in RBI (16), 5th in slugging (.527), tied for 5th in runs scored (14), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (9), tied for 7th in total bases (39), and 10th in OPS (.828)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League for the year with 36 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (73) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for 1st in the South Atlantic League (73) and is 5th across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (145).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of August 4's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just 2 hits and 1 walk, striking out 4...Lawson did not allow an earned run over 13.1 innings from July 21 vs. Jersey Shore until Thursday night in Wilmington...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winnfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.98 ERA (3 ER in 27.2 IP), earning 2 saves in 13 outings (1 start)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 25.0 frames on the bump, the right-hander is fourth in the league in ERA (0.98) in that time.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the 4th time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** 2-run single in the bottom of the 7th in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying 2-run home run in the 9th before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the 6th inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in those 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.63% of all defeats, including 26.09% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 243 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.35%)...The Cyclones have also earned 24 wins in their last at-bat.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF **Nick Morabito** (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth High-A defeat in Game 2 of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...Surrendered four runs on two hits over 5.0 innings...Walked a career-high six and struck out five...Induced a double play...Threw 81 pitches and 40 strikes (49.38%)...Relieved by RHP Alfred Vega to start the top of the sixth inning and Brooklyn trailing 4-0...Cyclones would go on to drop the nightcap, 7-0...Brooklyn won the lid-lifter, 3-2, on a walk-off two-run single by 3B Jacob Reimer in the bottom of the seventh.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 10 prospect in 2024 according to MLB Pipeline and No. 17 by Baseball America...The 21-year-old is the consensus highest-rated pitching prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: The 21-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the ML B Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP Zach Fruit, teammate RHP Jonathan Pintaro, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP Jordan Geber, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
