## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox won their third in a row with a 5-3 victory over Richmond. Starter **Levi Wells** earned his professional win with five innings of two-run ball and six strikeouts. **Austin Overn** collected three hits and stole four bases. **Reed Trimble** hit a two-run go-ahead triple in the fifth and **Doug Hodo**'s hit an RBI ground-rule double in the eighth. **Trace Bright** threw 3.1 shutout innings and struck out five and **Micah Ashman** induced a game-ending double play for his first Double-A save.

## CREED CRUSHES

After going 2-for-18 to start the month of August, C **Creed Willems** has been red hot ever since. The 22-year-old is on a **nine-game hit streak and is slashing .333/.400/.692 with two doubles, four homers and 13 RBI** during this span. Willems has hit safely in 10 consecutive games twice this season, which are the longest hit streaks on the team.

## BRADFIELD IS BACK

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** is on a career-high **14 game on-base streak after tallying three hits Thursday night**. Since being activated off the IL on August 12, the Orioles **No. 4 prospect is slashing .344/.447/.500 with nine stolen bases**. The All-Star Futures Game selection has missed 53 games this season due to hamstring injuries.

## SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW

OF **Austin Overn** stole a career-high four bases on Friday night. **Overn is just the third Baysox player since 2011 to steal four bases in a game**. The No. 30 Orioles prospect leads the Orioles farm with 56 stolen bases and is fourth in walks drawn (56) this season between High-A and Double-A.

## SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF **Brandon Butterworth** has reached base in his first **16 games with hits in 11 of those contests since joining the Baysox**. One of six prospects received from the Padres in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, the 22-year-old had the sixth-most extra base hits (35) and the most triples (7) in the Midwest League while with High-A Fort Wayne (SD).

## ANDERSON HAS ARRIVED

C **Ethan Anderson** collected his first Double-A hit on Wednesday. The 21-year-old was promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. Before earning promotion, **Anderson slashed .410/.479/.615 in the month of August and was tied for the South Atlantic League lead with 16 RBI**. The Virginia Beach native was drafted by the Orioles in the second round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Virginia.

## CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

The Baysox have played 39 one-run games this season, **which is third-most in all of Double-A**. Chesapeake has won 21 of those one-run games - **which is tied for the second-most in the Eastern League**. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, **which is tied for the most in full-season MiLB**.

## ASSESSING THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - are 22-22 in the second half and 3.5 games out of the division lead in the Southwest. Despite a series loss at home to Altoona this past week, Richmond is 14-7 on the road in the second half. Richmond's active roster includes three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - OF Bo Davidson (No. 5), LHP Joe Whitman (No. 15) and IF Diego Velasquez (No. 24).

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Trystan Vrieling makes his 14th start of the season and his fourth with Richmond. The 24-year-old was one of four Yankees prospects sent to the Giants in exchange for Camilo Doval during the trade deadline. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, he has not allowed more than three earned runs in each of his first four starts. Vrieling was originally drafted in the third round by the Yankees in 2022 out of Gonzaga.

**2025:** Struck out seven in 5.2 innings, allowing 4 R on 5 H (3 HR) and 2 BB to pick up first Baysox win in most recent start on 8/16 vs ERI. T-11th in MiLB in K (135). Acquired by Orioles from Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Seranthony Dominguez on 7/31. Walked along Prince George's Stadium concourse to Baysox clubhouse after hearing he had been traded since Fisher Cats were visiting Baysox that week coincidentally. At time of trade, T-2nd in TOR system in K (115) and 6th in IP (89.0). Started season in High-A Vancouver. In eight starts, recorded a 3.62 ERA in 37.1 IP with 62 K/12 BB. Departed High-A as the team-leader in Ks (62) and T-2nd in IP (37.1) and starts (8). Promoted to Double-A New Hampshire on 5/20. In 11 starts, posted a 3.48 ERA over 51.2 IP with 53 K/26 BB. Delivered first Double-A quality start in just his second Double-A outing on 5/30 @ HFD. Fanned a Double-A high eight batters in 4.2 IP on 6/18 vs SOM. Tossed longest pro outing on 7/25 in final Fisher Cats start with 7.0 IP vs HFD, his first win since June 5.

**2024:** Split first full season in minors between Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver...**Led Blue Jays system in K (131), BB (60) and 6th in IP (103.0).** Went 3-5 in 12 starts for Dunedin with a 3.43 ERA, allowed 22 ER in 57.2 IP with 74 K to 29 BB and a 11.5 K/9 ratio... Boasted a 2.91 ERA in June with 7 ER and 23 K across 21.2 IP, including 9 K in 6 IP vs Single-A Daytona on 6/19... Assigned to Vancouver on 6/30 and made his first start on 7/4 @ High-A Everett... **Career Notes:** Did not pitch in '23 upon being drafted.

**College:** Spent two seasons at Long Beach St. before transferring to Oklahoma State in 2023. Suffered a shoulder injury during senior year of HS and redshirted freshman year at Long Beach St. Threw the first complete game no-hitter in LBSU program history on 5/8/22 vs UC Riverside with 16 Ks, one K shy of the single-game program record. Named a Freshman All-American and Honorable Mention All-Big West Conference in 2022. At Oklahoma State in '23, his 124 total strikeouts were the most in the Big 12 and were the 10th most by a Cowboys pitcher in a single season. His 13.55 K/9IP ranked 6th in the NCAA. **Oklahoma St. head coach is Josh Holliday, uncle of former Baysox and now current Orioles INF Jackson Holliday.**

**Personal:** Drafted by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 Draft out of Oklahoma State. Native of Visalia, Calif. A three-sport athlete in high school, playing quarterback in football, basketball and baseball all four years at Hanford High School (Calif.)...

## COACHING STAFF

### **ROBERTO MERCADO**

#### *Manager*

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

### **JORDIE HENRY**

#### *Pitching Coach*

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

### **JOSH BUNSELMEYER**

#### *Hitting Coach*

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. In November 2024, the Baysox officially announced the team's renaming to the Chesapeake Baysox during a special event at The Chesapeake Bay Foundation in Annapolis, Maryland.

The updated team name represents a new chapter in Baysox baseball, expanding the brand to better reflect the broad and diverse community of fans who support the team across the region. The Baysox will continue to play at their home, Prince George's Stadium, in Bowie, Maryland.

The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).



## ALTERNATE IDENTITIES

### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
