ANDERSON HAS ARRIVED

C Ethan Anderson collected his first Double-A hit on Wednesday. The 21-year-old was promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. Before earning promotion, Anderson slashed .410/.479/.615 in the month of August and was tied for the South Atlantic League lead with 16 RBI. The Virginia Beach native was drafted by the Orioles in the second round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Virginia.

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

The Baysox have played 39 one-run games this season, which is third-most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has won 21 of those one-run games - which is tied for the second-most in the Eastern League. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is tied for the most in full-season MiLB.

ASSESSING THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - are 22-22 in the second half and 3.5 games out of the division lead in the Southwest. Despite a series loss at home to Altoona this past week, Richmond is 14-7 on the road in the second half. Richmond's active roster includes three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - OF Bo Davidson (No. 5), LHP Joe Whitman (No. 15) and IF Diego Velasquez (No. 24).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Trystan Vrieling makes his 14th start of the season and his fourth with Richmond. The 24-year-old was one of four Yankees prospects sent to the Giants in exchange for Camilo Doval during the trade deadline. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, he has not allowed more than three earned runs in each of his first four starts. Vrieling was originally drafted in the third round by the Yankees in 2022 out of Gonzaga.

2025: Struck out seven in 5.2 innings, allowing 4 R on 5 H (3 HR) and 2 BB to pick up first Baysox win in most recent start on 8/16 vs ERI. T-11th in MiLB in K (135). Acquired by Orioles from Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Seranthony Dominguez on 7/31. Walked along Prince George's Stadium concourse to Baysox clubhouse after hearing he had been traded since Fisher Cats were visiting Baysox that week coincidentally. At time of trade, T-2nd in TOR system in K (115) and 6th in IP (89.0). Started season in High-A Vancouver. In eight starts, recorded a 3.62 ERA in 37.1 IP with 62 K/12 BB. Departed High-A as the team-leader in Ks (62) and T-2nd in IP (37.1) and starts (8). Promoted to Double-A New Hampshire on 5/20. In 11 starts, posted a 3.48 ERA over 51.2 IP with 53 K/26 BB. Delivered first Double-A quality start in just his second Double-A outing on 5/30 @ HFD. Fanned a Double-A high eight batters in 4.2 IP on 6/18 vs SOM. Tossed longest pro outing on 7/25 in final Fisher Cats start with 7.0 IP vs HFD, his first win since June 5.

Manager

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League BaseballTM teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
