### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dropped their eighth game in the last nine yesterday, falling 6-2 to the Erie SeaWolves. It was a rough start for Bowie, as right-hander Chayce McDermott yielded a pair of home runs in the first inning to Colt Keith and Grant Witherspoon to dig a 3-0 hole. McDermott would bounce back to strike out seven across four innings and allow no further damage, but the Baysox were unable to dig out of the early hole. Despite getting a run back in the bottom of the fourth off an RBI single from Ramon Rodriguez, Erie had the answers against the Baysox bullpen. The SeaWolves notched a run in the top of the sixth on a solo home run from Dillon Dingler, as well as plating two in the top of the seventh on a two-run single from Wenceel Perez. Coby Mayo scored his second run of the game for Bowie off a sacrifice fly from John Rhodes, but it was the only run the Baysox managed against a struggling Erie bullpen in four frames, as they were unable to complete the comeback.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 9-13. Yesterday's win over Bowie snapped a five-game losing streak for the SeaWolves, who sit in fifth place in the Southwest division standings - two games ahead of Bowie. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the SeaWolves lead the Eastern League with 23 home runs, but have the worst staff ERA at 5.55. Erie arms has allowed the most hits (209), earned runs (124), and home runs (25) in the league. The SeaWolves welcome back Gabe Alvarez for his second season as the team's manager, alongside a mostly new staff. Erie's roster consists of nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Position players include infielders Colt Keith (No. 4 DET/ No. 94 overall), Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 29 DET), along with C Dillon Dingler (No. 14 DET). Right-handers Wilmer Flores (No. 3 DET/ No. 85 overall), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), and Elvis Alvarado (No. 23 DET), alongside left-hander Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET) feature on the mound.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Erie's projected starter this evening is right-hander Keider Montero. The international free agent signed by the Tigers in 2016 out of Venezuela has spent the past three seasons at High-A West Michigan, including all four of his starts in 2023. Still, Montero appears to have turned a corner early on this season. After pitching to a combined 4.80 ERA in 40 starts across 2021 and 2022, Montero has only allowed five earned runs in 16 innings this season, good for an ERA of 2.81. In addition, Montero has struck out 22 batters, compared to just four walks. Command will be something to watch for Montero, who's walk numbers were respectable, but hit the second-most batters (11) in the Tigers' system last season. He did not allow a run in either of his final two starts (eight innings) at the High-A level, accumulating 15 of his 22 strikeouts. Montero features a fastball that tends to sit in the mid-90s, alongside a high-70s-low-80s curveball, and a mid-80s changeup.

### HAIL CÉSAR

Cesar Prieto has been on a tear at the plate to start the season. The No. 17 prospect in the O's system leads the Eastern League with 28 hits. Prieto also leads the Eastern League and is fourth in Double-A with a .350 average, among qualified players. Among Baysox, Prieto leads the way in hits, average, and on-base percentage. He's also third on the team in OPS. Prieto's 28 hits are the third-most in the Orioles' system in 2023.

### HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his sixth Double-A home run in just his 15th game, and his six long balls lead the Eastern League and are the third-most at the Double-A level. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated consistency across the Eastern League leaderboards - ranking fourth in OPS (.992), second in slugging percentage (.611) and tops in total bases (44). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is fifth-best and his slugging percentage sits at third.

### MOUND REBOUND

The pitching staff as a whole has bounced back nicely for Bowie so far in 2023. After posting a 4.42 staff ERA last season, Bowie has the third-best team ERA in the Eastern League, and the fifth-best in all of Double-A, through 20 games at 3.56. Baysox starters have been effective throughout the early portion of the season in particular, with a 2.79 staff ERA amongst starters, including six outings of at least five shutout innings. Baysox right-hander Justin Armbruester ranks fourth in the league, among qualifiers, with a 1.40 ERA, while right-hander Chayce McDermott and left-hander Cade Povich both rank tied for third in the Eastern League with 27 strikeouts. Bowie arms have limited the free passes, with the second fewest number of HBP (5) and walks (76) at the Double-A level. The 76 walks by Baysox pitchers are the fewest in the Eastern League.

### DOUBLE THE MAYO

INF Coby Mayo has gotten on a roll for the Baysox through this most recent home stand. The No. 9 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, went 5-for-15 at the plate last week against Richmond, with a double in four of five games. Mayo leads the Orioles' system with seven doubles, while his 10 extra-base hits are the third-highest total on the farm. In addition, he has walked in six of his last seven games, after his two walks yesterday. In the first six games of the current home stand, Mayo has posted a .500 on-base percentage, reaching in 11 of his 22 plate appearances.

## CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

## COACHING STAFF

### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

### Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

### Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

### Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

### Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
