This Afternoon: The Lugnuts play a matinee in the second game of a six-game series with the West Michigan Whitecaps, the eighth meeting of 24 total between the archrivals this season. Lansing leads the season series, 4-3, splitting a six-game series at LMCU Ballpark in June before winning the opener last night. Right-hander Seth Shuman, the Nuts' Opening Day starting pitcher, makes his tenth start of the season, opposed by Whitecaps left-hander Adam Wolf in his sixth start of the year.

Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Whitecaps 3. Shortstop Cobie Vance homered amid reaching base five times, left fielder Shane Selman singled, doubled and drew three walks, and four Lugnuts pitchers combined to strike out 16 Whitecaps, including 12 of the last 14 outs, as the Nuts seized the first game of the series.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday before returning home July 27-August 1 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field<sup>™</sup>, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

# LUG. NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Vladdy Jr. is third in the Majors in batting average (.328), second in home runs (31), first in RBIs (78), first in on-base percentage (.427), first in total bases (220), first in OPS (1.095) and tied for first in runs (73) with fellow 2017 Lugnut/2021 American League All-Star Bo Bichette

No Place Like... Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts do not have to leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Alumni Report: 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, plaving for Beloit (MIA), leads the minors with 23 homers and is tied for first with 59 RBIs, 2021 Lugnuts infielder Max Schuemann, now playing in Double-A Midland, is tied for fifth in the minors with 34 steals.

Bruised: After two more HBPs yesterday, the Lugnuts have now been hit 15 times in 17 games this month. (Meanwhile, Nuts pitchers have hit 17 batters themselves.) Lugnuts pitchers have hit 55 batters this year, third in the league -- West Michigan is second with 56 batters plunked -- while Lugnuts hitter have been struck 63 times, tops in the High-A Central.

Heating Up, Hitters: The Lugs' leading batsmen in July are Jordan Díaz, hitting .362/.448/.552 with 11 runs, 14 RBIs, 7 XBH (2 HRs) and a 9/6 BB/K ratio in 16 games; Shane Selman, slashing .315/.422/.519 with 9 runs, 7 XBH (2 HRs) and a 9/11 BB/K ratio in 15 games; and Cobie Vance, who is slashing .283/.371/.491 with 6 XBH (2 HRs) and 13 runs scored in 15 games. In addition, Drew Millas has drawn 10 walks in 13 games (.397 OBP).

Heating Up, Pitchers: Starter Reid Birlingmair gave up one unearned run in five innings Friday and has now posted a 1.06 ERA in three starts this month (3 R/2 ER, 17 IP) with a .153 opponent batting average. Fellow starter Jack Cushing has a 1.00 ERA in three starts (2 R/18 IP), allowing an OBA of .145.

Trusted Relief: This series involves some of the most heavily used relief pitchers in the High-A Central, with Jared Tobey (27 gms., 1st), Dalton Sawyer (26 gms., 2nd), and Zack Hess, Charles Hall and Angel Reyes (24 gms., T-3rd). Tobey, Sawyer, Hall and Reyes all appeared in last night's series opener.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2013:** Leadoff hitter Dalton Pompey reached base six times, going 4-for-4 with four singles and two walks and stealing two bases (No. 2 hitter Emilio Guerero was 0-for-6 with an astounding 11 LOB), and the Lugnuts were walked off at Kane County, 6-5, in 10 innings, on a Dan Vogelbach one-out RBI single up the middle.

**2017:** The Quad Cities River Bandits scored at least one run in the first seven innings (before Griffin Glaude needed only six pitches in a 1-2-3 eighth), beating the Lugnuts 14-3 at Modern Woodmen Park. Daz Cameron and Chuckie Robinson hit three-run HRs; QC outscored the Nuts 36-9 in taking two of three. Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Roster Index:** The newest Nut, **José Mora**, is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1999 (38), 2001 (40) and 2009 (38) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.6% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Scott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Personal: The first letter of Richard's last name is pronounced with an "h" sound, as in "hwahsh"... rated Baseball America's No. 35 Oakland prospect, with his slider rated as the best in the organization.

Last Outing: Fared poorly vs. Lake County, July 14: 3 2/3 IP, 10 H, 7 R (6 ER), 1 HR, 2 HBP, 1 BB, 5 K... knocked out by seven-run fourth inning in which he gave up a three-run oppo homer to George Valera... Lugnuts lost, 17-10.

#### 2021 in the High-A Central:

- Opened the season as the No. 3 starter in the Lugnuts' rotation, working 2 1/3 scoreless innings on May 6th vs. Lake County... struggled with command, working around a one-out walk in the 1st inning with a strikeout of top prospect George Valera... hit a batter and walked a batter in the 2nd inning but stranded runners at the corners... gave up a double and a walk in the 3rd inning, but responded by striking out Valera and cleanup hitter Jonathan Engelmann before he was relieved in favor of Bryce Nightengale, who escaped the jam... departed with the Lugnuts leading, 3-0, only to see bullpen relinquish the lead in a 7-6 loss.

- Relieved Shohei Tomioka in a piggyback assignment on Thursday, May 13th, at Dayton... struck out six Dragons in four innings. allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and a walk in a no-decision... relieved Tomioka starting the 3rd inning, allowing a home run to Jose Tello, the second batter faced; Victor Ruiz followed with a single, but was erased on a strike 'im out, throw 'im out double play... pitched around singles by James Free and Jonathan Willems in a scoreless 4th... whiffed Quincy McAfee and Ruiz in a perfect 5th... in frustrating 6th, walked Quin Cotton on a 3-2 pitch, Cotton stole 2nd and then stole 3rd on a strikeout of James Free, coming home

on a throwing error by catcher Jared McDonald, giving Dayton an enormous insurance run, on their way to a 4-2 win over the Lugnuts. - Pitched brilliantly in a start Thursday, May 20, at Fort Wayne, tossing five scoreless innings while allowing two hits, two walks, and striking out seven... pitched around an Agustin Ruiz single in the 1st inning... allowed a leadoff double to Justin Lopez in the 2nd inning and wild-pitched him to third, then struck out the side to strand him... walked Adam Kerner and Reinaldo Ilarraza to open the 3rd and wild-pitched them to scoring position, but stranded them there... struck out two in a perfect 4th... struck out his seventh batter in a perfect 5th... Lugnuts went on to win, 12-1. - Disaster on May 27: Richard relieved Seth Shuman with two outs in the 3rd inning, held the Great Lakes Loons scoreless in the 4th and 5th innings, and then was charged with eight unearned runs in the 6th on three

walks, three errors behind him, an HBP, a fielder's choice, a dropped sacrifice fly, and zero hits... Charles Hall relieved him and gave up a pair of two-run singles in a nine-run inning, and the Loons went on to win, 10-1. Dominance on June 3: Richard mesmerized the South Bend Cubs, posting six scoreless three-hit innings, walking one and striking out eight... departed with the Lugnuts leading 4-0, only to see the Cubs rally for three runs in the 7th and two in the 9th for a 5-4 comeback win... eight strikeouts tied career high for most in an appearance.

- After allowing 1 ER in his first 20 1/3 innings, Richard gave up four runs on nine hits in four innings at West Michigan on June 10, jumping his ERA from 0.44 to 1.85... removed after facing three batters in the 5th and not recording an out; lefty Dalton Sawyer allowed a run on a sacrifice fly but stranded the other two runners... Guasch was charged with the loss as the Lugnuts fell, 10-0.

Started June 17 vs. Great Lakes, receiving no-decision... whiffed eight batters in five innings, allowing two runs on four hits, three walks and three HBPs... Lugnuts won, 4-3, scoring four unearned runs thanks to four Loons errors... stranded bases loaded in the 1st, stranded two in the 2nd... stranded one in the 3rd... stranded two in the 4th... finished with a perfect 5th.
