**INDIANAPOLIS, IND.** - Despite trailing by five runs after the first inning, the Omaha Storm Chasers battled back in the final third of the game, to beat the Indianapolis Indians, 8-6 on Friday night at Victory Field, Omaha's third straight Opening Day win.

Storm Chasers starter **Mike Mayers** was tagged for five runs on six hits in the first inning, as Indianapolis sent 10 batters to the plate to jump out to a big lead early. Mayers settled down over his final three innings in the game, keeping his opposition to just one hit the rest of his outing. The veteran right-hander did not issue a walk over 4.0 innings of work, while striking out four.

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drove in three runs early in the comeback, with a groundout in the 5th inning, RBI single in the 7th and bases-loaded walk in the 8th.

Second baseman **Samad Taylor** drove in two runs as well, with an RBI triple in the 7th and go-ahead 2-run single in the 9th inning to cap a four-run inning.

After Indianapolis responded in the bottom of the 8th to add a run, Omaha entered the ninth inning trailing 6-4 but opened the inning with three straight singles from **Tyler Gentry**, **CJ Alexander** and **Nick Loftin**. Gentry scored on a fielders' choice and **Tucker Bradley** drew a bases-loaded walk to score Alexander and tie the game, before Taylor put Omaha ahead for the first and only time all night.

**Andrés Núñez**, **Brooks Kriske** and **Evan Sisk** each threw scoreless innings of relief in the 5th, 6th and 7th innings. A leadoff walk from Sisk in the 8th scored, but **Collin Snider** finished the frame and **Josh Staumont** fired a scoreless 9th to earn the save.

### ROSTER RETURNERS

17 members of Omaha's Opening Day roster spent time with the Chasers last season.

2 players spent the entire 2022 season with Omaha: pitchers **Austin Cox** and **Andrés Núñez**.

8 players were on Omaha's Opening Day roster in 2022: pitchers **Austin Cox**, **Jonathan Heasley**, **Marcelo Martinez** and **Andrés Núñez**; catcher **Freddy Fermin**; infielders **Angelo Castellano** and **Nick Pratto**; and outfielder **Dairon Blanco**.

6 players are making their Royals organization debuts in this series, after joining Kansas City in the offseason: pitchers **Brooks Kriske**, **Mike Mayers**, **Evan Sisk**, **Josh Taylor** and **Nick Wittgren** and infielder **Samad Taylor** (acquired in July 2022, did not appear in a game for a Royals affiliate) ... Kriske, Mayers, Sisk and Taylor all made their organization debuts in last night's game, leaving Taylor and Wittgren as the only ones not to appear in a game in the Royals system yet.

### TRIPLE-A DEBUTS

3 members of Omaha's Opening Day roster made their Triple-A debuts in last night's 8-6 win over Indianapolis and combined to go 7-for-14 (.500) at the plate.

Infielder **CJ Alexander** opened the season with a bang, going 3-for-5 against Indianapolis with a 4th inning double and singles in the 6th and 9th ... he joined the Royals organization in July 2022, acquired by Kansas City in the trade with Atlanta that also sent outfielder Drew Waters to the Royals.

Outfielder **Tyler Gentry** hit cleanup in his Triple-A debut last night and went 1-for-5, singling in the 9th to kickstart the rally after walking in the first ... he was drafted by the Royals in the 3rd Round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of Alabama and split last season between High-A Quad Cities and Double-A NW Arkansas, where he finished the season. Gentry was named both the Nationals' Player of the Year, but the Royals' George Brett Hitter of the Year too.

Like Alexander, outfielder **Tucker Bradley** produced a three-hit night, going 3-for-4 with a walk ... his first Triple-A hit came on a bunt single in the 5th, then he doubled and scored in the 7th, singled in the 8th and walked in the 9th ... he with Kansas City as an undrafted free agent in the summer of 2020 after playing collegiately as the University of Georgia.

### FOUR MORE

After managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 to 2013, **Mike Jirschele** returns in 2023 to manage the Storm Chasers, his 15th season at the helm in Omaha and is quickly approaching an incredible milestone.

Over his now 15 seasons in Omaha, "Jirsch" has managed 2,014 games ... with last night's win, he has a 996-1,018 record (.495 winning %). The team's fifth win this season will mark his 1,000th all-time with Omaha, so he currently sits **FOUR** away.

When factoring in three seasons managing lower-level Royals affiliates between 1992 and 1994, Jirsch has managed 2,343 games with a 1,209-1,134 all-time managerial record (.516 winning %).

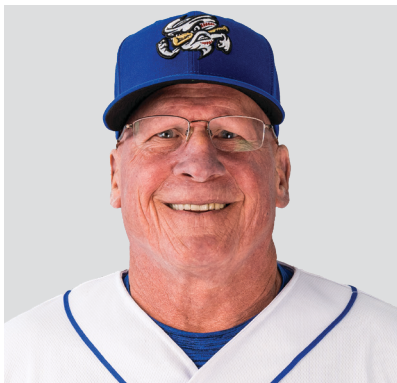

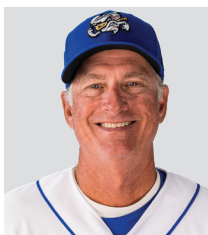

## MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHLE • 36

- ✦ **Mike Jirschele** returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- ✦ Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Witheridge during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Witheridge's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- ✦ In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- ✦ He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- ✦ Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- ✦ He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



## PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • 59

- ✦ **Dane Johnson** enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- ✦ He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- ✦ Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- ✦ Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



## HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- ✦ **Bijan Rademacher** (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- ✦ Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- ✦ Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- ✦ Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



## BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • 33

- ✦ **David Noworyta** (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- ✦ Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- ✦ Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



## CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- ✦ **James Stone** is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- ✦ He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- ✦ Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- ✦ He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- ✦ Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.



## STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH: YANNICK PLANTE

- ✦ **Yannick Plante** is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
- ✦ He began with the Kansas City Organization in 2019 as the athletic trainer for the Burlington Royals (Advanced Rookie, Appalachian League). He was then a staff member of the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.
- ✦ Plante has a master's degree in kinesiology from the University of Calgary and a bachelor's degree in human kinetics with specialization in biophysics from the University of Ottawa. He currently lives in Ottawa, Ontario.
