TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve continue their first playoff series since 2018 tonight against Erie. The Curve lead the series 1-0 after an 11-5 win on Tuesday night at PNG Field.

Andrew Sears starts for Erie tonight. Sears threw 4.0 scoreless innings against the Curve last Tuesday with four strikeouts in a 6-1 win for the Wolves. Sears was a 10th round selection by Detroit out of the University of Connecticut in 2023, played his first two seasons of college baseball at Rhode Island College.

STARTED OFF RIGHT: Altoona hammered Erie for a Game One win in the Southwest Division series, 11-5, on Tuesday September 16 at PNG Field. The 4,890 fans in attendance was the 5th-highest attendance for a Curve playoff game at home, highest since 2010.

Esmerlyn Valdez set a playoff franchise record with 5 runs batted in and **Konnor Griffin** added three hits, including a double and a walk, in his playoff debut. Altoona's bullpen held Erie to just 1 run on 1 hit and 1 walk in 6 innings.

PLAYOFF HISTORY: Altoona's qualification for the postseason is the 10th time in 27 years of play that the team has reached the playoffs. The Curve swept the SeaWolves in 2004 on their way to a championship series defeat at New Hampshire. All-time, the Curve are 24-23 in postseason play.

DUCE IS LOOSE: Infielder **Duce Gourson** has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. On Friday, September 12 he had a career-high 4 hits in a 8-4 loss at Erie. He was named the Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after batting .417 last week against Erie. In his last 28 regular season games, he batted 39-for-104 (.375) with 8 2B, 4 HR, 15 RBI and 17 BB (since August 7).

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, **Konnor Griffin**, has a hit in 19-of-22 games with the Curve (including playoffs), batting .356 (31-for-87) with a .960 OPS in the regular season. He has 8 multi-hit games since joining the Curve and was reached base safely in each of his last 20 games played.

Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since **Paul Skenes** in 2023. Griffin finished the regular season ranked among all minor league players in runs scored (2nd, 117), stolen bases (8th, 65), hits (3rd, 161), 4th in RBI (94), 9th in OPS (.942) and batting average. (5th, .333).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravelo stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and Hickory.

TERMINATING: Infielder **Termarr Johnson** went 15-for-41 (.366) across his last 14 regular season games, adding 14 walks for a .536 on-base percentage. Johnson turned in his most well-rounded month of the season in August, batting .318 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 10 RBI (.798 OPS) led the club with 32 multi-hit games during the regular season.

20 NICK'S: First baseman **Nick Cimillo** is the first Curve batter since 2022 (**Andres Alvarez**, **Aaron Shackelford**) to hit 20 homers in a season with Altoona. Cimillo, who is fourth among PIT MiLB i behind teammates **Esmerlyn Valdez** (26), **Konnor Griffin** (21) and **Javier Rivas** (21), returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. In his last 45 games, he's picked up 30 extra base hits (.276 BA, .999 OPS). Cimillo led all Double-A players with 11 HR the most in a calendar month since **Brad Eldred** in August of 2005 hit 11.

Cimillo had an 11 game hit streak end on September 11, batting .400 (18-for-45), with 4 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 17 RBI, with an insane 1.371 OPS, he had a 14-game on-base streak end on Sunday.

THE 'MERYLN OF VALDEZ: Outfielder **Esmerlyn Valdez** homered four times across three games August 28-30, marking the first time in his career that he's homered in three straight games. Valdez leads all Pirates minor leaguers with 26 homers this season. In August, Valdez batted .311 with a 1 2B, 6 HR and 19 RBI, he ranked 3rd among Eastern League players in HR and 4th in RBI in the calendar month.

In his last 14 games, Valdez has a hit in 10 of them, he's gone 18-for-52 (.346) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 12 RBI, totaling a 1.079 OPS.

RECORD WATCH: Righty **Wilber Dotel** finished his regular season in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 131 strikeouts are 4th-most in a single season in franchise history, right behind **Rudy Owens'** mark of 132 strikeouts in 2010. **Ian Snell** holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004.

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder **Mitch Jebb** has 33 stolen bases this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchise history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.

His average fastball velocity has increased from 91.0 in 2023 to 94.0 in 2024 to 97.0 in 2025...
