NEWS & NOTES

HELLO MR. CELERY: The Hudson Valley Renegades continue their 12-game road trip with a six-game series against the Wilmington Blue Rocks this week. It's the second visit to Frawley Stadium this season for Hudson Valley who took four out of six games from them back in May. The 'Gades will make one more trip to Delaware this season at the end of August.

SIMPLY SOUTHERN: In 18 games in SAL South ballparks this year, the Renegades are averaging 8.00 runs/game. In their other 80 games, they are averaging just 4.41 R/G. Incredibly, Hudson Valley has hit 43 of their 105 home runs this season (40.9%) during their trips south, representing 17.0% of games played.

SPENCE HENCE POWER: After a two home run performance in Hickory on Sunday, **Spencer Henson** is now tied with Everson Pereira for the most home runs in franchise history. Henson clubbed 10 home runs last year and is currently leading the 'Gades this season with 13 blasts. The Renegades infielder is also riding an nine-game hitting streak entering Thursday, after finishing Sunday afternoon 4-for-4 with four RBIs.

LAST TIME OUT: The Hudson Valley Renegades shut out the Wilmington Blue Rocks 3-0 on Wednesday night. **Baron Stuart** in his High-A debut struck out five in 6.0 scoreless innings. **Mason Vinyard**, **Harrison Cohen**, and **Jack Neely** each tossed a scoreless frame out of the bullpen to complete the shutout. **Grant Richardson** paced the offense with two hits including a solo blast to right field in the fifth inning.

MORE AWARDS: **C Agustin Ramirez** was named the South Atlantic League Player of the Month in July by Major League Baseball on Thursday. This marks the second straight month that the Renegades have had a player win a monthly award, with **Drew Thorpe** earning SAL Pitcher of the Month honors in June. In July, Ramirez hit .415/.467/.756 and led the league in batting average, hits (34), doubles (10), total bases (62), slugging percentage, and OPS (1.223). The backstop tallied 11 multi-hit games in 20 games.

ROSTER MOVES: The New York Yankees announced on Thursday the promotion of **Eduardo Torrealba** to Double-A Somerset. Torrealba leaves Hudson Valley as the all-time hits leader (134) in 163 games played, which is also the most in franchise history.

GETTING HOT: Over the course of the last eight games, **Christopher Familia** is hitting .379/.486/.828 with one double, four home runs, nine RBIs, five walks, and seven runs. He's collected a hit in nine of the last 12 games.

PAVING THE WAY: Since June 1st, the Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff owns the second-best ERA with 3.01 ERA in this span. Hudson Valley pitching has also punched out a High-A best 549 batters in 442.0 innings during this span. The Somerset Patriots (NYY-AA) sit fifth with a 3.30 ERA.

ANOTHER ONE: On Tuesday, **Luis Velasquez** was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of July 24 - 30. The right-hander had a dominant week out of the bullpen, tossing 5.2 scoreless frames across two games versus the Hickory Crawdads. He earned the win in both of the Renegades' shutout victories and he punched out an impressive 47.1% of batters faced last week. Velasquez earned the Renegades sixth weekly award of the season joining pitchers **Juan Carela**, **Drew Thorpe**, and **Tyrone Yulie**. Outfielder **Aaron Palensky** has won the lone offensive weekly honor this season.

WIDE MARGINS: In the last series against the Hickory Crawdads, the Renegades outscored the Crawdads 51-21 (+30). Hudson Valley shut out the Texas Rangers High-A affiliate twice in the series, including a 6-0 victory on Sunday.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Since his promotion from Single-A Tampa on June 29th, **Agustin Ramirez** is 38-for-98 (.388) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBIs, eight walks, and 19 runs in 24 games. He recorded a hit and reached base safely in his first six games while also already collecting 12 multi-contests in his brief time in High-A.

HE GETS ON BASE: **Ben Cowles** currently holds the Renegades longest active on-base streak at 20 games. The former Maryland Terrapin has reached base in every game since July 4 in Jersey Shore. He surpassed **Rafael Flores** who held the longest on-base streak by a Renegade hitter prior at 18 games. It's currently the longest streak in the South Atlantic League, and tied for the fifth-longest in High-A.

HOME RUN BUG: After hitting 11 home runs in their first nine games out of the All-Star break, the Renegades hit 19 in six games versus the Hickory Crawdads. The team's 31 home runs since the All-Star Break are the most in High-A and are tied for the highest mark in all of Minor League Baseball. The Syracuse Mets (NYM-AAA), Wichita Wind Surge (MIN-AA), and the Sacramento River Cats (SF-AAA) are currently tied with Hudson Valley.

LIGHTS OUT: The Hudson Valley Renegades blanked the Wilmington Blue Rocks 3-0 on Wednesday night for their 11th shutout of the season. The 11 shutouts are tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The West Michigan Whitecaps (DET-AA+) lead the way with 13. The 'Gades pitching staff has blanked a team four times over the last 10 games, which is tied for the most with the Tri-City Dust Devils (LAA-AA) during this span.

INTO THE TOP 100: *Baseball America* released its in-season Top 100 Prospects list update on July 14, and the Yankees claimed six players on the list. 2023 Renegades **Chase Hampton** (#60) and **Spencer Jones** (#98) entered the list for the first time. They were joined by former Renegades **Oswald Peraza** (#56), **Jasson Dominguez** (#71), **Austin Wells** (#86) and **Everson Pereira** (#96).

CRISP: Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.
COWLES: Both three-hit games this season have come against Jersey Shore on 6/6 and 7/6...Hit 2 HR's vs BRK on 7/23.
FAMILA: Promoted to Hudson Valley on 6/29...named FSL Player of the Week 6/19-6/25 and FSL Player of the Month in June.
FLORES: Carried a season-long 18-game on-base streak from June 9 - July 3, snapped in a rain shortened five-inning contest vs WIL.
GARCIA: After only playing in only two games (2 AB) from 5/3 - 6/3, appeared in 19 games in June and hit .233/.300/.329
GOMEZ: Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April. Ranked second in High-A in the month of June with a .344 batting average.
HENSON: After hitting .146 in June, slashed .367/.421/.694 in July...hit his 11th home run of the season on 7/26 @ HIC, setting a new career-high.
JONES: Season-long seven-game hitting streak from 6/10 - 6/18... hit .464/.531/.857 with two 2B, three HRs and 6 RBIs during this span.
RAMIREZ: Promoted to Hudson Valley from Tampa on 6/29, named a *Baseball America* prospect to watch beyond the Top 30 for the Yankees.
RICHARDSON: Batted .417/.517/.583 during seven-game hitting streak from May 18-27. Hit 4 HR's in the month of July.
SANCHEZ: Tied franchise record with two triples vs WIL (5/3)...held a 10-game hitting streak from 6/25 - 7/15, slashed .342/.359/.447 during streak.
VARGAS: For the 2018 international signing period, was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 8 prospect.

LAST TIME OUT: Selvidge was in complete control last Friday night as he carved up the Hickory Crawdads for 7.0 shutout innings and picking up his first High-A win. He allowed just one hit -- leadoff single in the second inning to Maximo Acosta -- and one walk while striking out seven in a dominant start. Selvidge retired the final 14 batters he faced in the outing, and combined with Shane Gray to set down 16 in a row at one point.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Tampa Tarpons Break Camp Roster... transferred to Hudson Valley on July 18.
- Allowed 2-or-fewer ER in his final three starts with the Tarpons, and in eight of his final 10 outings since 5/11.
- Threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings on July 28 @ Hickory, retiring the final 14 batters he faced and picking up his first High-A win.

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Joshua Brock Selvidge.
- Is one of just two high schoolers selected by the Yankees in the 2020, 2021 and 2022 First-Year Player Drafts (RHP Sean Hermann -- 14th round, 2021).
- As a senior at Hamilton High School (AZ), went 5-2 with a 2.41 ERA (52.1 IP, 18 ER) in 11 appearances as a pitcher...also hit .304 (21-for-69) with 17 R, 6 doubles, 6 HR, 21 RBI and 12 BB in 23 games as a batter.
- Was ranked by Perfect Game as the top pitcher in Arizona and the No. 2 overall prospect in the state.
- Had committed to LSU prior to being drafted.
