## FROM THE CROWS NEST

NASTY NAVARRO: Left hander Reinold Navarro will take the ball today as the Marauders seek the bounce-back win against the Cardinals. Over three outings and 3.0 innings with Bradenton, Navarro has walked 12 batters and allowed nine runs. Last Sunday at Lakeland, he completed a Single-A-career best 2.1 innings while allowing two runs. In the process, he allowed just one hit but walked four. His hardest bolt of the season registered at 99.0 mph (7/26 vs DUN), marking the hardest pitch from any Marauder left hander since statcast began measuring in FSL games. It also slots as the 3rd hardest by a southpaw in the FSL this season. His slider has sat at 84 mph. Over nine appearances and eight starts with the FCL this season, the Dominican Republic native pitched to a 2.81 ERA over 25.2 innings. In the process, he fanned 47 hitters and allowed just seven hits (.088 BAA). In his career, the southpaw has surrendered just three extra-base hits (one home run) against 245 batters faced (.155 opp. SLG). This season, he's topped out at four innings of work three times, and has punched out a career-high eight hitters in three seperate starts. 2025 marks his first year in the states after signing as an International MilB Free Agent in January of 2024. He was named a Dominican Summer League All Star in 2024.

POWER OUTAGE: Despite the Marauders overall power numbers in 2025, they have struggled to hit for extra bases in the month of August. Through 15 games, they're slashing .198/304/.288 with seven home runs and 28 extra-base hits. This follows a prolific month at the plate where they launched the 20 homers, tying both Palm Beach and St. Lucie for the most longballs in the FSL and all of Class-A. Overall, their 89 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second in Single-A (San Jose - California League, 92). 135 of their 503 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27%). They're 33-27 when leaving the yard at least once, and 19-34 when not homering at all. They've seen five players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino, E. Florentino).

**WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN:** As we approach the end of the second half, Bradenton is 22-25, currently 5.0 games behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot (also up 2.0 games up on Dunedin). With 20 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels two weeks ago, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders don't have the head-to-head advantage with Clearwater.

**ELECTRIC EDWARD:** Bradenton Marauders outfielder Edward Florentino was named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed. 301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. demolished his first two Single-A homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MilB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

**BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 47th stolen bases on Saturday night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he's passed **Jesus Castillo** (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (58) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-Mil.B history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis
