#### JUMBO SHRIMP WIN ON BALK OFF

Jerar Encarnacion homered and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp walked-off on a balk against the Norfolk Tides, 3-2, on Wednesday afternoon. Still tied at two in the final frame, Brian Miller reached on a leadoff walk and Jacob Amaya laced a single to put runners on the corners with no outs. A balk by the Norfolk Tides (25-9) reliever Reed Garrett (2-1) plated Miller from third, giving the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (18-15) the victory.

#### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 18 of their last 24 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 60 runs, 52 earned, on 109 hits (8.8 H/9) in 111.0 innings for a 4.22 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 80 punchouts (6.5 K/9). However, they have only issued 40 walks during this run, a rate of 3.2 per nine innings.

#### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 133 free passes over the last 25 games since April 11, a figure that ranks third in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.4 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

#### JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since the season's second week. Over his last 25 games dating back to April 7, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 28-for-98 at the plate, slashing .286/.417/.500/.917 with nine doubles, four homers, 18 RBIs and 22 walks. Encarnacion places amongst the league leaders in several categories this year, including doubles (T-10th, 9), walks (T-15th, 22) and RBIs (T-14th, 25).

#### WAVE RUNNERS

Last year Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022. The 2021 Navy Town Showdown series also featured Jacksonville's record-setting game where the offense put up 20 runs on June 4, 2022, the most in a game since 2005.

#### KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, **Charles Leblanc** went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 11 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 14-for-37 (.378) with two doubles, home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 15 walks for a .558 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (27) nearly as much he has struck out (28). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (22.7 percent) and tied for third in total walks (27). His swingingstrike rate of 7.6 percent is tied for th 21st-lowest out of the circuit's 134 qualified hitters.

#### 'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the 12 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 18 runs, 12 earned, on 23 hits (3.5 H/9) in 59.2 innings for a 1.81 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 62 strikeouts (9.4 K/9) against 37 walks (5.6 BB/9) during this recent run. Heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville relief pitchers have not allowed a run in 11 consecutive innings dating back to Tuesday.



#### **ABOUT DEVIN**

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9–3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transfering to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

#### **2022 SEASON**

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in Iacksonville

#### 2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation.Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

#### **2020 SEASON**

-Smeltxer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-Smeltzer ttended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
