SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels homered four times but lost to the Bowie Baysox, 7-6, in the road trip finale. Bowie scored the first run of the day in the first inning with an RBI groundout by Toby Welk. The Flying Squirrels tied the score, 1-1, in the third with an RBI double by **Simon Whiteman**. Kyle Stowers put the Baysox back in front with a two-run double in the third. Cody Roberts and Patrick Dorian had RBI hits in the fourth to extend the Bowie lead to 5-1. Richmond scored four runs in the fifth to tie the game, all on homers. **Vince Fernandez** hit a solo homer, his team-best 14th of the season. Later in the inning, **Sandro Fabian** hit a two-run shot and **David Villar** immediately followed with a solo homer to even the score. Zach Watson put the Baysox in front with a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth and Welk opened the lead to 7-5 with an RBI groundout. In the seventh, Villar hit his second home run of the game to close Richmond within a run. It was his 14th home run this year, tying him with Fernandez for the team lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series marks the first time the two teams have faced off this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Erie for a six-game series from September 13-19 to finish the 2021 season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-16 since July 21. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 12.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.98 ERA for the season.

THE SEAWOLVES have won four of the last five games since August 12 and six of the last eight since August 7. Over the last five games, the SeaWolves have outscored opponents 47-10. The SeaWolves are ranked fourth in the league with a .255 team batting average and third with 112 homers. The Erie pitching staff is ranked fourth with a 4.10 ERA. Erie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including LHP Joey Wentz (No. 5), RHP Reese Olson (No. 11), INF Andre Lipcius (No. 23), RHP Paul Richan (No. 26), RHP Elvin Rodriguez (No. 27) and RHP Beau Brieske (No. 29). Prior to this series, the Tigers promoted No. 1 prospect Spencer Torkelson, No. 2 prospect Riley Greene and No. 19 prospect Ryan Kreidler from Erie to Triple-A Toledo.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his fifth start for the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Wednesday at Bowie and was hit with a loss after allowing four runs (three earned) over 5.0 innings, his longest outing since joining Richmond. Blair has gone 0-2 with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) over his last three starts since July 30. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. *For more on Blair, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Joey Wentz makes his 10th Double-A start. He pitched Thursday against Altoona and allowed one run over 4.2 innings, tied for his longest outing since joining Erie. Wentz began the season on a rehab assignment with Low-A Lake-land, going 0-3 with a 6.75 ERA in five starts before jumping to Double-A on June 23. He was selected with the 40th pick in the 2016 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves out of Shawnee Mission East High School in Kansas. He was named the South Atlantic League's Pitcher of the Year in 2017 with Low-A Rome. Wentz was traded to the Tigers on July 31, 2019 along with outfielder Travis Demeritte for RHP Shane Greene. He made five starts for Erie in 2019 but had Tommy John surgery in March 2020. He is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Tigers' No. 5 prospect. At the mid-season update, *Baseball America* ranked Wentz as the No. 9 prospect in the Tigers system.

BIG FLIES IN BOWIE: The Flying Squirrels hit 15 homers in last week's six-game series at Bowie, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast since August 10. They closed out the series with four homers in Sunday's loss. The Flying Squirrels hit 11 homers in their first trip to Bowie this season and combined for 26 home runs in 12 games at Prince George's Stadium this season. In the last 12 home games since July 27, the Flying Squirrels have hit five home runs.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank seventh in the circuit with 98 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 131 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. Richmond's 98 home runs this season is the second-highest homer total in a season in the franchise's history, ahead of the entire 2018 (97), 2017 (93), 2019 (84), 2016 (83), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons. This year, the team has combined for a .394 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013).

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Minicozzi** (10).

FABULOUS FABIAN: In his six games in last week's series, **Sandro Fabian** hit .478 (11-for-23) with four homers and 11 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in four of his last six games, including three hits last Thursday. He hit two homers in the second game of Saturday night's double-header and is now tied for third on the team with 13 this season, which is a new career high.

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: In his last six games, **David Villar** is batting .400 (10-for-25) with three homers and five RBIs. He is now tied for the team lead with 14 home runs this season, which is also tied for the eighth-most in a season in franchise history. Last Thursday, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer, going deep at Bowie. He picked up two home runs in the series finale at Prince George's Stadium on Sunday afternoon.

GO, DIEGO, GO! Over his last 23 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .304 (24-for-79) with six homers, five doubles, one triple and 19 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. He hit homers in Bowie last week on Wednesday and Thursday. Over his last 12 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .341 (15-for-44) with two homers, four doubles and eight RBIs.

GOING STREAKING: **Mitchell Tolman** is currently riding a six-game hitting streak since August 8. In that span, he is batting .368 (7-for-19) with one homer, two doubles and four RBIs. On Sunday, Tolman collected his second two-hit game with the Flying Squirrels.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 27 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 107 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **David Villar** is tied for seventh with 81 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 14 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked ninth with a 5.23 ERA, tied for eighth with 76 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (31/T-3rd), **Joey Marciano** (30/T-4th), **Matt Seelinger** (29/T-7th), **Frank Rubio** (28/T-10th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (28/T-10th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fifth with seven saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for ninth with six.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have two players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10) and **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (12) and Beck (20), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
