Tonight, Reading finishes a three-game series with Portland. It is the third series of the season between the teams and second in the last four weeks. The season-series is tied at four and Reading won four-of-six in Portland the last week of June.

Bats Ouiet

Reading's offense was quiet in a 3-2 loss to Portland last night. Max McDowell homered and Oliver Dunn drove in Matthew Kroon on an infield single in the eighth. But, Blaze Jordan hit his first double-A home run off Orion Kerkering in the ninth to give Portland the eventual 3-2 win. Griff McGarry started and went a season-high six innings, while striking out a season-best nine hitters as well.

Bullpen Success

Before the two-run home run allowed by Orion Kerkering in the ninth last night, Reading's bullpen had gone 24.2 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run, dating back to July 5. Since July 5, Reading's bullpen has posted a 2.76 ERA, which ranks second in the Eastern League.

Welcome to the Show

Johan Rojas made his Major League Debut yesterday and was excellent. Over two games, he had a great catch and outfield assist and then had a three-hit game, which included two RBI and a run scored. Rojas is the second member of the 2023 R-Phils to play in a Major League game this season, joining Drew Ellis, who was with the Fightin Phils in early-May.

Pitching Efficiency

A key to the pitching staff's recent success has been its ability to limit walks, while picking up strikeouts. Over the last two nights, Reading's staff has 32 strikeouts to just four walks. Ironically, the staff had 16 strikeouts and two walks in each game. Those numbers come out to 16 K's/9 and 2 BB's/9. Over the season Reading's numbers sit at 9.54 K's/9 and 4.51 BB's/9.

Friday Night's Game

With the win Friday, Reading has set a new season-high with four-straight wins. The R-Phils had nine extra-base hits which is a season high. The pitching staff struck out 16, led by 10 from David Parkinson. Parkinson's 10 punchouts are a season-high for him, the most by an R-Phils starter in 2023 and the first 10 strikeout game by an R-Phil since James McArthur on Aug. 13, 2021 against Bowie.

Around the Organization

The Phillies swept a doubleheader with the Padres yesterday and go for the series win today. Lehigh Valley earned its second-straight shutout with a 4-0 win over Charlotte. Drew Hutchinson and Noah Skirrow combined for the effort on the mound. Jersey Shore beat Rome 8-5 as Hao Yu Lee had two hits and a home run. Clearwater topped Fort Myers 8-7 as Otto Kemp and Ricardo Rosario had three-hits each.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 16, 1968: At Reading, Larry Bowa goes 5-for-7 with 3 RBIs on the day as Reading sweeps a double-header from Waterbury, 3-2 and 7-1. Bowa's RBI single ties Game 1 in the 6th and his bunt single in the 8th leads to the game-winner when the throw to 1st sails into the stands.

Scouting the Sea Dogs

Portland enters tonight with the best record in the Eatsern League in the second half at 11-3. The Sea Dogs fell just short of Somerset in the race for the First Half Northeast Title. Overall, Somerset enters tonight with a 51-32 record, which is the best in all the Eastern League. Prior to the break, Portland hosted Binghamton and took five-of-six, including the last four, from the Rumble Ponies. After this week, Portland hosts New Hampshire.

Wikelman Gonzalez makes his double-A debut after being called up to Portland on July 14. He made 15 starts for high-A Greenville and went 6-3 with a 5.14 ERA, Over 63 innings, Gonzalez allowed 49 hits, issued 42 walks and struck out 105 batters. That is good for a 15 K/9 rate. Gonzalez split 2022 between single-A Salem and Greenville, going 4-3 with a 4.21 ERA over 25 starts between both. He split 2021 between the Rookie League and Salem and spent all of 2019 with the Dominican Summer League. He signed with the Red Sox for \$250,000 in 2018 out of Venezuela at just 16-years old. According to MLB, he ranks as Boston's number-11 overall prospect. Scouts grade all his pitches as plus and his fastball sits 93-97, and he also offers a curveball and changeup. Scouts project he will develop more physically and look for his control to improve too as he develops.
