INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: Despite a late comeback effort, the Indianapolis Indians dropped their series finale with the Memphis Redbirds on Sunday afternoon at Victory Field, 3-2. The Redbirds opened scoring in the top of the first against Indianapolis when Luken Baker hit a sacrifice fly to plate rehabbing outfielder Lars Nootbaar. The Indians knotted the game at 1-1 with a sacrifice fly of their own against Redbirds starter Sem Robberse a half-inning later, which came from second baseman Liover Peguero to plate shortstop Nick Gonzales. Scoring halted until the top of the sixth, when Memphis shortstop Thomas Saggese took Indians reliever Kade McClure deep to left-center field. Baker added another sacrifice fly in the eighth to push the advantage to 3-1 in Memphis' favor. Indianapolis had foot traffic on the basepaths in the bottom of the eighth and had a run to show for it thanks to an RBI groundout from first baseman Matt Gorski.

NICK KNACKS: Nick Gonzales continued his hot stretch to begin the season with a 3-for-4 showing on Sunday to extend his on-base streak to nine games since Opening Day in Louisville. Since the season began, he owns a .405 batting average (15-for-37) with 11 runs, five extra-base hits and five RBI. Six of his nine games have featured multi-hit performances. He had his six-game hitting streak snapped in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader vs. Memphis but walked twice. He is now tied with teammate lake Lamb and three others with league-leading nine-game on-base streaks since the season began. Gonzales split the 2023 season between Indianapolis and Pittsburgh and logged a season-high 13-game on-base streak with Indy from 4/6-19.

LAMB WALKS: Jake Lamb has joined Nick Gonzales in jumping out to a hot start to begin the 2024 season, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with three runs, three extrabase hits, five RBI, eight walks, a .408 on-base percentage and .903 OPS in nine games. On Sunday, he walked as a pinch hitter to extend his on-base streak to nine games since 3/29 at Louisville. He spent the majority of the 2023 season in Triple-A and logged a 24-game on-base streak with Salt Lake from 5/23-23. During that stretch, he hit .337 (30-for-89) with 19 runs, eight extra-base hits, 22 RBI, 20 walks, a .473 on-base percentage and .990 OPS.

CELLY'S STREAK SNAPPED: Gilberto Celestino entered Sunday's game as a pinch runner and grounded out in his lone plate appearance, snapping his seven-game hitting streak that began on 3/29 at Louisville. His streak is currently tied for the third-longest in the International League, trailing Norfolk's Heston Kjerstad and Kyle Stowers (8). In eight games this season, Celestino is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with six runs, three doubles and six RBI. The 25-year-old spent most of an injury-shortened 2023 season with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .243 (45-for-185) with 17 extra-base hits and 31 RBI in 55 games. In 114 career Triple-A games, he owns a .266 batting average (107-for-402) with 27 doubles, two triples, nine home runs and 61 RBI.

TODAY: After a successful series victory last week vs. Memphis, the Indians will look to continue their winning ways tonight in the series-opener at the Toledo Mud Hens. The Indians saw success vs. the Mud Hens in 2023, finishing the season series with a 14-4 record while going 5-1 at Fifth Third Field. Tonight marks the first of 24 meetings between the two teams, with 12 games coming at Victory Field from May 14-19 and July 30-Aug. 4. Kicking off the series tonight for Indianapolis is RHP Michael Plassmeyer (1-0, 2.00) who earned the win on Thursday in his second start of the season. Countering for the Mud Hens will be RHP Austin Bergner (0-0, 3.86). Bergner has made two starts at Victory Field since joining the Mud Hens in 2022 and has gone 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8er/6.2ip) and eight strikeouts.

PUNCH 'EM OUT, PLASSMEYER: Southpaw Michael Plassmeyer made his Victory Field debut on Thursday night and fanned eight batters across 5.0 one-run innings to earn his first win of the season. He had struck out six through 3.0 shutout innings of work before giving up a run to begin the fourth inning and has now fanned 14 batters across his first 9.0 innings (two starts). His eight strikeouts on Thursday were his most in an outing since fanning a career-high 11 batters on 8/3/22 vs. Syracuse. The 27-year-old spent most of the '23 season with Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts)

ON THE MEND: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that utilityman Ji Hwan Bae and right-handed relief pitcher Carmen Mlodzinski will continue their respective rehab assignments with the Indians tonight at Toledo. Bae was placed on the 10-day injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle on March 28 (retroactive to March 25). He began his rehab assignment with Single-A Bradenton on April 7 and went 2-for-3 with a double and RBI before being transferred to Indianapolis. Mlodzinski was placed on the 15-day injured list with right elbow inflammation on March 28 (retroactive to March 25). He appeared in one game with Single-A Bradenton to begin his rehab assignment on April 5, allowing one run on two hits while striking out the side in his lone inning of work.

HAMMERING THE HENS: The Indians hammered the Mud Hens in 2023, winning the season-series 14-4. Against Toledo, the Indians offense hit .305 (118-for-616) with 118 runs, 75 extra-base hits and a .896 OPS while scoring at least one run in each of the 18 games played. On the flip side, Indians pitching logged a 3.44 ERA (60er/157.0ip) with four shutouts while holding the Mud Hens offense to a .216 batting average, 62 runs, 44 extra-base hits and .645 OPS.

WE KNOW YOU: Former Indians outfielders and team award winners Bligh Madris (2021 Rookie of the Year) and Ryan Vilade (2023 Gold Glove) each are gearing up to face Indianapolis as part of the Mud Hens active roster this week. Madris appeared in 175 games with the Indians from 2021-22, hitting .282 (116-for-589) with 77 runs, 44 doubles, five triples, 16 home runs and 89 RBI. Vilade appeared in 122 games with Indy during the 2023 season and hit .270 (119-for-440) with 64 runs, 23 doubles, four triples, six homers and 56 RBI.

THIS DATE IN 1989: In the third game of the season, Indy buried Louisville at Bush Stadium, 16-2. The Indians had 19 hits, led by second baseman Junior Noboa who finished 5-for-5 with two doubles, three RBI, three runs scored and one hit by pitch. The five-hit performance raised his average to .615 three games into the season, and he ended the month of April with a .478 average

TONIGHT'S STARTER

Michael Plassmeyer: The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his third start of the season and his second on the road to begin this week's series at Toledo.

Last Outing: Plassmeyer earned his first win of the season last Wednesday vs. Memphis. He allowed one run on four hits with eight strikeouts across 5.0 innings.

Against the Mud Hens: Plassmeyer has never faced Toledo.

Walk It Off: Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion — three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ...
