**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels suffered their most lopsided loss of the 2021 season, falling 11-2 to the Altoona Curve. **Phil Pfeifer** started for Richmond and navigated through 2.2 scoreless innings before surrendering a two-run homer to Rodolfo Castro in the top of the third. Daniel Amaral clubbed a solo homer and Ji-Hwan Bae added a two-run single to open a 5-0 lead in the fourth. After a run in the fifth, Altoona scored three runs in the sixth to pull away, 9-0. Richmond broke into the scoring in the sixth when **Sandro Fabian** reached on an error and **Shane Matheny** came in to score. Castro added a second two-run home run in the seventh inning to push the Curve's lead to 11-1. Fabian scored a second run after an error in the bottom of the ninth. On the night, Fabian had three hits and scored a run. **Andy Sugilio** went 2-for-4. Pfeifer allowed five runs (four earned) over 3.1 innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Curve. The Flying Squirrels play six games at Altoona's Peoples Natural Gas Field from August 24-29.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost four of their last five games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 6.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fifth in the league with a 3.59 ERA for the season.

**THE CURVE** have won seven of the last ten games and four of five in this series. They are currently tied for third place in the Double-A Northeast, 3.5 games behind first-place Bowie. The Altoona offense is ranked sixth in the league with a .246 batting average. The Curve pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.58 ERA. Altoona's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (4), Ji-hwan Bae (14), Mason Martin (15), Cal Mitchell (18), Roansy Contreras (20) and Canaan Smith-Njigba (26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Gerson Garabito** makes his sixth start of the season. Last time out, he worked 5.0 innings on Tuesday against Altoona and allowed one run on three hits, but was charged with a loss. He recorded a season-high six strikeouts in the outing. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. *For more on Garabito, see page two.*

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Jeff Passantino makes his fourth start of the season and his sixth overall appearance this year. Last time out, he worked 5.0 innings against Erie last Sunday and allowed three runs in a no-decision. Passantino began the season working as a reliever for his first two outings before moving into a starting role on May 16. The 25-year-old right hander was drafted in the 40th round by the Chicago Cubs in 2017 out of Lipscomb, the 1,215th and final pick in the draft. He was selected by the Pirates in the minor-league phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Draft.

**ADDING IT UP:** Over his last 12 games since May 23, **Shane Matheny** has hit .278 (10-for-36) with four doubles, a homer and seven RBIs. Matheny went on a 16-game on-base streak from May 15-June 3, during which he hit .255 (12-for-47) with 13 walks. For the season, Matheny is ranked tied for sixth in the league with 18 walks.

**FABULOUS FABIAN:** In this week's series against the Altoona Curve, **Sandro Fabian** is batting .538 (7-for-13). He has picked up one home, one double and four RBIs and scored three runs. On Friday, he hit his third home run of the season and picked up his second two-hit game of the year. He followed on Saturday by going 3-for-4 with a run scored, a Double-A career high in hits. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but this week's performance has raised his season average to .258.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the fourth-best bullpen ERA in the Double-A Northeast at 3.07 on the season. The bullpen is tied for the league lead with 11 saves. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for third in the Double-A Northeast with four saves and **Norwith Gudino** is tied for fifth with three.

**RUBIO RIDING HOT:** Reliever **Frank Rubio** entered in the ninth inning on Saturday night and struck out the only Curve batter he faced on three pitches. It marked the tenth consecutive appearance for him this season without allowing an earned run. Rubio is in his third overall season with the Flying Squirrels. He appeared in one game for Richmond in 2018 and made 11 appearances during the 2019 season.

**AMAYA REBOUNDS:** After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever **Luis Amaya** has worked seven straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 9.0 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 3.18. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings, covering 7.1 straight scoreless innings.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 16-13 record is tied for the third-best start in team history through 29 games, matching the start of the season in 2018. It trails only an 18-11 start in the 2010 season and a 17-12 start in 2014.

**GETTING ON THE BOARD:** Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 38 consecutive games. That streak includes all 29 games of the 2021 season. Portland had a streak of scoring in 40 straight games before being shut out in Harrisburg on Saturday. Richmond is the only team in the Double-A Northeast that have not been shut out this year.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

**GOING FOR GOLD:** Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela played in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. Venezuela picked up a 6-5 win over Cuba last Monday and beat Colombia, 3-2, on Tuesday. They improved to 3-0 with a 5-0 win against Canada on Wednesday. The top two teams from each group played in a super round this weekend, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. Venezuela lost its first game of the super round, 14-4, to the Dominican Republic. They fell to Team USA, 4-2, on Saturday night in the final game of the Qualifier. **Tony Diggs** managed the team for its six-game series in Reading from May 25-30, going 5-1. **Jason Wood** is managing the Flying Squirrels during this week's series. He spent the last 10 seasons as a manager in the Texas Rangers organization. He was with High-A Myrtle Beach from 2011-2013, Double-A Frisco in 2014, Triple-A Round Rock from 2015-2018 and Triple-A Nashville in 2019. Wood is currently the Giants' Coordinator of Infield Instruction. Catcher **Andres Angulo** was also away from the team while down to Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier. Colombia was eliminated in the opening round.

**MOVIN' UP:** Right-handed pitcher **Matt Frisbee** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento this week, one day after being named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Month for May. During his time with the Flying Squirrels, Frisbee went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA. For the month of May, he led all of MiLB in WHIP (0.41), ranked second in BAA (.112) and second in innings pitched (29.0). He also ranked fourth in Double-A in ERA (1.24), tied for first in wins (4) and led the level in innings pitched, BAA and WHIP. In the Double-A Northeast, Frisbee led the circuit in ERA, wins, inning pitched, BAA and WHIP. He also ranked seventh in strikeouts (32) and ninth in winning percentage (.800). The Asheville, N.C. native opened the season with 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings across his first two starts. On May 13, Frisbee combined with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo to hold the Harrisburg Senators hitless, the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels history. On Sunday at Reading, Frisbee, closed out the month setting a season high in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8). After allowing a single in the first inning, Frisbee retired the next 21 batters in order to earn his fourth win.
