NOTES DAVID PETERSON REHAB START: New York Mets left-handed pitcher David Peterson is slated to make a rehab start tonight for Binghamton. The 28-year-old made three rehab starts for Class-A St. Luice (4/28, 5/3, 5/8) and tossed 8.2 scoreless innings, while allowing two hits and one walk with 16 strikeouts. Peterson has pitched for the Mets in each of the past four seasons (2020-2023) and has made 80 appearances and 64 starts. He is 18-21 with a 4.51 ERA in his MLB career. The former 20th overall pick in 2017 spent the entire 2019

CLIFFORD THE BIG RUMBLE PONY: First baseman/outfield Ryan Clifford was promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday. Clifford currently ranks as the Mets No. 4 prospect and the No. 78 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB Pipeline. The 20-year-old began the season with High-A Brooklyn and hit. 216 with a homer and 10 runs batted in over 31 games. Clifford is currently tied for the most walks in all of Minor League Baseball (32). Clifford was originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 11th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Pro5 Academy (N.C.) and was traded to the Mets, along with OF Drew Gilbert (now Mets No. 2 prospect), for RHP Justin Verlander on August 1, 2023.

season with Binghamton, as he came up through the Mets system. He made 24 starts for the Rumble Ponies and went 3-6 with a 4.19 ERA, while holding a 122-to-37 strikeout-to-

walk ratio across 116.0 innings.

BRANDON TO BINGO: RHP Brandon Sproat was promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday. Sproat currently ranks as the Mets No. 13 prospect, per MLB Pipeline. Sproat was drafted by the Mets in the second round (56th overall) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida. The 23-year-old did not pitch after being drafted and made his professional debut in High-A Brooklyn this season. In six appearances and five starts for Brooklyn, Sproat held a 1.07 ERA and only allowed three earned runs all season Among pitchers with 25.0+ innings pitched, Sproat ranked third in the SAL in ERA and fifth in batting average against (.141). He is scheduled to make his Double-A debut on Wednesday.

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs, 4-2, in the series finale at Hadlock Field on Sunday. Kevin Parada homered for the second-straight game and Mateo Gil hit his first homer of the season. Tyler Stuart allowed two runs over five innings of work in the start. The loss snapped Binghamton's eight-game winning streak, which marked the franchise's longest regular-season winning streak since 2017. The Ponies took five of six games at Portland, and won their third-straight series this season.

POWERFUL PARADA: Mets top catching prospect Kevin Parada hit a solo homer on Sunday at Portland and has homered in back-to-back games. Parada now leads the team with four long balls. Over his last three games, Parada has recorded seven runs batted in and drove in eight runs in last week's series at Portland. The 22-year-old is riding a five-game hitting streak with seven hits, two homers, a double, eight runs batted in and four runs scored over that span. Parada is hitting .304 and has a .417 BAbip during his five-game hitting streak.

FOREVER YOUNG: Mets infield prospect Wyatt Young singled and walked on Saturday at Portland and is now riding an eight-game hitting streak and 13-game on-base streak. Young currently leads the Eastern League with a .446 on-base percentage. Over his eightgame hitting streak, the 24-year-old is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with three runs batted in, seven walks and four strikeouts. Over his 13-game on-base streak, Young is hitting .353 with a .560 OBP, 1.0001 OPS, 12 walks, and four hit by pitches.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.


