Last Time Out: Garrett Mitchell hit a lead off home run and Alexander Palma followed with a solo shot of his own two batters later to give the Shuckers a 2-0 lead in the top of the first... After the Biscuits tied it in the fourth, Gabriel Garcia launched a solo homer to put the Shuckers up 3-2... Montgomery scored one in the fifth, six in the sixth and three in the seventh to win 12-3.

At the Plate: Making Biscuits: Cam Devanney went 2-for-3 with a double, a home run, 2 RBI, BB on Tuesday against the Biscuits... For the season Devanney is now 12-for-44 (.286) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 2 HBP

Mitchell Report: Garrett Mitchell, the Brewers' #1 prospect, connected for his first Double-A home run on Wednesday night, a leadoff shot to left field... He became the sixth Shuckers' player to hit a leadoff homer and hit the 14th leadoff homer in franchise history... The last leadoff homer came on 8/27/19 when Joangtel Segovia led off with a home run against the Mississippi Braves.

Palma's Hit Parade: Alexander Palma has been the Shuckers hottest hitter in the last 12 contests, going a combined 16-for-46 (.348), 2B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 3 BB, 6 R and only 6 K

Diaz Does It Again: Brent Diaz 19-game on-base streak came to an end on Thurday night, going 0-for-3... Diaz's streak tied for the 8th longest on-base streak in franchise history (25 - Garrett Cooper and Cooper Hummel).... In the month of July, Diaz is second on the team with 8 RBI despite playing in 7 of 12 contests

On the Mound: Crawford Season: In the month of July, LHP Leo Crawford has worked as both a starter and a reliever, posting a 1.00 ERA in 4 appearances, 1 start... Crawford was vital to three Shuckers wins when he came out of the bullpen, recording two holds and his first career save

Save Me: After going 0-for-5 in save opportunities in the month of June, the Shuckers' bullpen is 3-for-4 in save chances in July

League Leaders: Six of the Shuckers relievers rank in the top ten in appearances in the Double-A South: Webb - 24 (1st), Strzelecki - 21 (T-3rd), Vennaro - 21 (T-3rd), Hardy - 20 (T-7th), Hitt - 20 (T-7th) & Hintzen - 19 (T-10th)

The ERA is Too Dang High: In the month of June, the Shuckers' pitching staff posted a 5.23 ERA, the highest ERA in a single month in franchise history... It surpassed the previous high of 5.00, which the 2021 Shuckers posted in the month of May... Coming into 2021, the highest monthly ERA in franchise history was in September of 2016 when the Shuckers posted a 4.50 ERA in five games to close out the season... The Shuckers current ERA in July is 4.99

Long Ball Blues: Biloxi has allowed 91 home runs this year, the 7th most in all of Minor League Baseball (1st - Las Vegas & Reno: 111)... Biloxi did not allow a home run on Sunday evening, the 16th game this season that they did not allow a homer... In those contests, the Shuckers are 10-6... In games in which they have allowed a home run, the Shuckers are 9-36.

What's Shuckin: Sixth Inning Stings: Over the last two contests, the Shucker have allowed break out sixth innings, surrendering five runs on Tuesday night and six runs on Wednesday.

Comeback Kids: In their last two games against Birmingham, the Shuckers came from behind to win... Biloxi overcame two different two-run deficits on Saturday, including a 5-3 hole going to the bottom of the 8th on Saturday... Biloxi trailed 3-0 after 1 1/2 innings on Sunday and came back to win 6-3... It is the largest deficit the Shuckers have overcome this year.

Glad That's Over: With their 3-0 win on 7/1, the Shuckers snapped a nine game losing streak, ending the longest losing streak in franchise history... The previous longest losing skid was six games in 2016 when the Shuckers lost four games at home against Jacksonville before falling in their first two games in Pensacola from 7/5 to 7/10/16.
