LAST TIME OUT: Making his High-A debut last Friday night against the Brooklyn Cyclones, Selvidge allowed only two runs on eight hits, walking two and striking out three. He stranded eight runners on base through his first four innings of work, surrendering RBI singles to Stanley Consuegra and Ryhlan Thomas in the second an third innings, respectively. However, Selvidge worked amny deep counts, having three innings in which he threw 20-or-more pitches, including a 31 pitch fourth to shorten his night.
