LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were walked off, 4-3, in 12 innings by the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Saturday night. Bowie tied the game down to their final strike in the ninth via a Collin **Burns** RBI single, before taking a 3-2 lead in the 11th on an **Anthony Servideo** RBI infield knock. After 6 1/3 combined scoreless innings from five different relievers in the Bowie bullpen, Richmond tied the game in the bottom of the 11th on a wild pitch, before walking it off in the 12th on a Turner Hill knock.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B Samuel Basallo was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday, July 13. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the Futures Game and is the first since Adley Rutschman in '21. Basallo has reached base safely in 34 of his last 36 games dating back to May 21, including 14 straight. Basallo is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in home runs (12) and sixth in hits (76). He's the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

ON-BASE BENCOSME

IF Frederick Bencosme has reached base in 19 consecutive games, which is a new career-best on-base streak and is tied for the third longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League. The Orioles No. 26 prospect is tied with Samuel Basallo for the longest on-base streak on the team this season.

FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B Matthew Etzel's 39 stolen bags this season are tied for seventh most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 15 of his first 20 starts at the level.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season - ninth-most in Double-A. The O's No. 11 prospect homered in three of his first six Double-A games last season, joining the Baysox in Altoona on June 20, 2023.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 57 of 69 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect is tied for the team-lead in OBP (.345) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the 4th-most in the Eastern League.

ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff sports the fourth-best collective ERA in the Eastern League this season (3.87) and the second-best since June 1 (3.43). Bowie arms pace all of Double-A with 810 strikeouts. The Baysox bullpen has put in its shift, with the most innings (397.1) at the level and the third-best WHIP (1.19) in Minor League Baseball.

DON'T SWIPE ON SILAS!

C Silas Ardoin has set the standard when it comes to tossing out baserunners. Ardoin's 20 runners caught stealing are fourth-most in Double-A, while his 41.7 CS% is best in Minor League Baseball amongst qualifiers.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE?

The Altoona Curve enter the week with a 34-47 record on the season - 5-7 in the second half. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve roster includes six of the Pirates' Top 30 prospects - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 1 PIT/No. 51 MLB), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 4 PIT), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7 PIT), OF Jase Bowen (No. 18 PIT), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 25 PIT), 3B/OF Charles MacAdoo (No. 29 PIT).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Bubba Chandler is set to get the ball for Altoona. In his last three starts, Chandler has allowed just two earned runs in 21.1 IP (0.84 ERA), while striking out 28 and walking only two. Chandler tossed seven shutout innings with 10 strikeouts and two hits allowed his last time out against Bowie on June 21. A third round pick of the Pirates in '21, Chandler features a fastball, slider, curveball, and changeup.

Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Curveball (best secondary), Slider, Changeup Ranked the Orioles No. 15 prospect, via MLB Pipeline Has thrown 4th most innings in O's system (65.2)

2024: Received no-decision in most recent start on Sun. 6/30 @ REA after delivering 4.2 IP and giving up 1 R on 4 H over 2 BB and 7 K. 7 K was most strikeouts since season-high 8 K performance on 4/14 @ HFD. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Has punched out six or more batters in seven of 15 starts. Owns a 4.35 ERA in seven road starts. Baysox are 5-10 when Bright starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s
