INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Isaac Collins and Francisco Mejía each launched solo home runs for the Nashville Sounds as the Indianapolis Indians suffered their third loss of the road trip on Saturday night at First Horizon Park, 3-0. Two solo home runs were the bulk of the difference in scoring, as Nashville tagged a pair of solo shots off of Indians starter Thomas Harrington in his second Triple-A start courtesy of Collins and Mejía. Harrington tossed 4.2 innings while punching out five hitters, but Collins' home run came on Harrington's very first pitch of the night. The Sounds tacked on another run in the seventh inning thanks to situational hitting from Freddy Zamora, plating Mejía on a sacrifice fly for insurance.

SILENCED BY THE SOUNDS: One day after throwing their fourth shutout of the season behind Bubba Chandler's 7.0 shutout innings, the Indians were shut out by the Sounds, 3-0. It was the fifth time they have been shut out this season and the first since June 20 vs. lowa. Four of those five shutouts have come on the road. It is also the second time they have been shut out by Nashville since the Sounds joined the International League in 2021, the last shutout coming exactly one year prior on Aug. 10, 2023, at Victory Field.

MATTSON'S MAGIC: Isaac Mattson continued his impressive stretch with the Indians since the beginning of July last night, tossing 3.1 one-run innings. In his last eight appearances since July 6, he is 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4er/18.0ip), 21 strikeouts and 1.17 WHIP. He is currently working a career-high tying four-game win streak since June 15, during which he has a 3.08 ERA (9er/26.1ip) and 30 strikeouts. His last four-game win streak came from May 22 (1)-June 13, 2018, with Single-A Burlington.

NICK YORKE, NICK YORKE: Nick Yorke entered last night's game as a pinch hitter and went 1-for-3 to extend his hit streak to 14 games last night. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester, and has 13 hits, four extra-base hits and six RBI in 10 games with Indy since. During his 14-game hit streak between Triple-A Worcester and Indianapolis since July 25, he is hitting .333 (17-for-50) with six runs, six extra-base hits and eight RBI. It is the second-longest active hit streak in the International League, trailing Nick Loftin's 18-gamer with Omaha. Yorke has also reached base safely in 18 consecutive games since July 19, which is the third-longest active on-base streak among IL leaders.

ALIKA ON BASE: Alika Williams extended his on-base streak to 13 consecutive Triple-A games since July 14 last night, going 1-for-4 with a double. It was his second consecutive game with a double, and in 31 games this season he has seven total two-baggers. During his 13-game on-base streak, he is hitting .360 (18-for-50) with 11 runs, five doubles, six RBI, 12 walks and just seven strikeouts. Williams' 13-game on-base streak trails Seth Beer's 15-gamer as the second-longest active streak among Indians batters (counting only games with Indianapolis) and is the 10th-longest streak among Indians batters this season.

BILLY OWNS THE BASES: Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, walked twice last night and now ranks 10th among International League leaders with a.890 OPS in 77 games with Triple-A Norfolk and Indianapolis. Cook has now reached base safely in 10 of 11 games since July 26 (1) with Triple-A Norfolk with a .500 batting average (18-for-36), nine runs, eight doubles, one triple, two home runs and eight RBI between both teams. His streak featured a stretch of two extra-base hits in four consecutive games, the longest such streak in the International League since at least 2015. In seven games with Indy, Cook is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with six runs, five doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .500 on-base percentage and 1.273 OPS.

HAMMERED BY HENRY: Henry Davis went 2-for-3 with two runs, two RBI and his 12th Triple-A home run of the season on Friday night to help the Indians to their 6-0 shutout win at Nashville. He has now homered in each of the Indians last three series, with two homers coming in his last six games vs. Toledo (Aug. 2) and last night. Davis now has 13 total home runs this season between Indy (12) and Pittsburgh (1) after launching a career-high 19 homers between Double-A Altoona (10), Indianapolis (2) and Pittsburgh (7) in 117 total games last season. In 46 games with the Indians, he is hitting .302 (52-for-172) with 25 extra-base hits, 35 RBI, a .403 on-base percentage and .990 OPS.

TONIGHT: The Indians close out a six-game series at First Horizon Park, home of the Milwaukee Brewers-affiliated Nashville Sounds, tonight at 7:05 PM ET. The Indians have gone 11-16 vs. the Sounds since 2021, going 2-4 last year during one series at Victory Field, and are looking to leave Nashville with a series tie tonight. Taking the mound for Indianapolis is RHP Aaron Shortridge (0-1, 5.06), who was tagged with seven runs over 4.0 innings on Tuesday to take the loss in his first career outing vs. Nashville. Countering for the Sounds is RHP Mitch White (2-3, 6.95), who went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2er/10.0ip) and nine strikeouts in two starts vs. Indianapolis with Buffalo in 2023.

THIS DATE IN 1959: The Indians beat Omaha 4-1 at old Victory Field behind a Cloyd Boyer one-hit complete game. Boyer issued just two walks, hit one batter and struck out eight in his eighth win of the season. Walt Matthews tripled and scored in the fifth inning to put the Indians behind, but Indy responded with four runs in the bottom of the sixth inning. Johnny Callison tripled and led Indy with two hits.
