SPRINGDALE, AR – The Naturals overcame an early four-run deficit and connected for a season-high four home runs, tying a season-high with 17 hits, in a 9-6 win over the Springfield Cardinals Thursday at Hammons Field.

- Eight of nine Naturals in the starting lineup recorded a hit, including four three-hit performances and runs driven in from six different players.
- Springfield leapt out to a 4-0 lead after the 2nd inning, but Northwest Arkansas slowly chipped away. Right fielder **Seuly Matias** cut the deficit in half, bringing in a run with a sacrifice fly in the 3rd inning and a solo home run in the 5th, his fourth of the year.
- Brhet Bewley** and **Tucker Bradley** connected on back-to-back solo homers to open up the sixth, the first time the Naturals have gone back-to-back this season. After **Maikel Garcia** walked and **Robbie Glendinning** reached on an error, the Naturals rattled off three straight RBI singles, from Matias, **Nate Eaton** and **Logan Porter** to cap the five-run frame.
- Loftin added two more runs in the seventh inning with a two-run home run, his third long ball of the year to put the Naturals up 9-5. While Springfield scored a run in the seventh, left-hander **Walter Pennington** came on for the final two innings and retired all six batters he faced to earn the six-out save, his first save of the season, and preserve the 9-6 win.
- Starting pitcher **Dante Bias** started the night strong, striking out the side in the first inning, en route to a seven-strikeout night, tying his career high, while throwing a career-high 81 pitches.
- Yefri Del Rosario** earned his second win of the year, improving to 2-0 with 3.0 innings of relief, allowing a pair of runs while striking out two.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 8-6 all-time when playing on May 6

On May 6, 2015, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals 8-4 at Hammons Field for the team's 11th consecutive win, the final victory in the longest winning streak in franchise history. The Naturals connected for 14 hits from eight different players, including a 4-for-5 day for second baseman **Angel Franco**. Center fielder **Bubba Starling** connected on his second home run of the season in the seventh inning, a two-run shot. Starting pitcher **Miguel Almonte** threw 5.0 scoreless innings, striking out two Cardinals hitters.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers **Holden Capps**, **Yefri Del Rosario**, **Drew Parrish**, **Stephen Woods Jr.** and **Ángel Zerpa** were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder **Seuly Matias**.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder **Gavin Stupienski** and pitcher **Alec Marsh** both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi**, **Jonah Dipoto**, **Maikel Garcia**, **Michael Massey**, **Jake Means**, **Drew Parrish**, **Zack Phillips**, **Logan Porter**, **John Rave**, **Patrick Smith** and **Ángel Zerpa**.

TOOLS TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America's* 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF **Nick Loftin** is rated as having the "*Best Strike-Zone Discipline*" in the system.
- C **Sebastian Rivero** is rated as being the "*Best Defensive Catcher*" in the system.
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the "*Best Infield Arm*" in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the "*Best Outfield Arm*" in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the "*Best Slider*" in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the "*Best Control*" in the system.

MJ MELENDEZ IS A BIG LEGUER!

In Tuesday's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

- Melendez went 1-for-3 with a walk, collecting his first MLB hit in the bottom of the sixth inning, an opposite field single.
- In the bottom of the second inning, third baseman Bobby Witt Jr. finally drilled his first big league homer, a solo shot to left field, moments before Melendez took his first at-bat.
- Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Francisco Giants on April 12.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 1-11, while 11-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 3-10 when recording nine hits or less, but 9-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 12-2 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-10 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 9-4, whereas 3-8 when the opponent scores first.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 24 games, the Naturals have stolen *36 bases in 42 attempts* (average 1.550steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 6 times*.

- 36 steals ranks first in the Texas League, fifth in Double-A and tied for 25th in the Minors, while a 85.00% success rate on steals ranks 10th among MiLB teams with at least 30 successful steals.
- **Maikel Garcia's** 10 steals (in 12 attempts) ranks tied for fourth in the Texas League and tied for eighth in all of Double-A.

NATE IS GREAT

Utility man **Nate Eaton** has been a consistent presence in the Naturals lineup all season along, playing all over the diamond for Northwest Arkansas as well.

- Eaton's .330 average leads qualified Naturals hitters and ranks eighth in the Texas League, while he's tied with Michael Massey for the team lead in hits with 29.
- Eaton entered last Wednesday's game on a eight-game hitting streak, the longest on the team this season though the streak was snapped last night with an 0-for-4 day at the plate ... between April 23 and May 1, Eaton hit 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS.
- Last week, Eaton hit .417 against Amarillo, 20-for-24 at the plate with four runs batted in, three steals and a 1.087 OPS.
- With 13 starts (114.0 innings) at third base, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in right field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia reached base in each of the first 15 games he played to start the season, but struck out pinch-hitting in the ninth inning to snap that streak ... a 15-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth-longest in the Texas League.
- Among 10 qualified Naturals hitters, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in on-base percentage (.440), slugging percentage (.597) and OPS (1.037), while ranking tied second on the team with four home runs, 15 walks and ranks third in runs batted in (17) and runs scored (18) and fourth in batting average (.299).
- Robbie's .440 OBP ranks seventh in the Texas League, while his .596 slugging percentage ranks ninth in the league and his 1.037 OPS ranks seventh in the league ... 15 walks is tied for ninth as well.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 21 on the season, which is tied for first in the Texas League and tied for third in Double-A.

- In 113 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 49 times, for a .434 on-base percentage (28 hits + 21 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 21 of the 23 games he's appeared in this season ... the only games he didn't reach base were back-to-back games, on April 23 and 26.
- The Venezuelan has reached base at least twice in 15 of 21 games where he has reached base.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied first in walks (21) and tied for fourth in steals (9).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first three-walk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.


#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.



#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.

#6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). A switch-hitter, he owns a career average of .242 as a utility infielder in the big leagues, primarily playing third base, but could play all four infield positions.

#27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschle enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschle previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field.
- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschle was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
