## THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2017, Nashville starter Ben Bracewell worked seven scoreless innings against Round Rock before the bullpen polished off a 5-0 shutout win at First Horizon Park. Chris Carter blasted a two-run homer in the win.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Stripers go to battle in their series finale at Coolray Field. The Sounds dropped last night's contest 4-1, snapping a streak of 11 consecutive wins against Gwinnett. Nashville right-hander Janson Junk gets the nod today against Gwinnett southpaw and Tennessee native Justus Sheffield.

**Janson Junk:** 27-year-old Janson Junk makes his 21st start of the season for Nashville today. The right-hander is 6-8 with a 4.37 ERA (111.1 IP/54 ER) in 21 Triple-A appearances this season. Junk had another unlucky outing in his previous start, allowing two runs over 7.0 innings to Charlotte and striking out nine, but taking his second straight quality loss. The native of Washington state ranks among International League leaders in opponent batting average (5th, .256), WHIP (5th, 1.31), ERA (5th) and innings (6th) this season. Junk was acquired by Milwaukee on November 23, 2022 along with RHP Elvis Peguero and LHP Adam Seminaris for OF Hunter Renfroe from the Angels. He was originally drafted by the Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Seattle University.

**Justus Sheffield:** 27-year-old Justus Sheffield makes his 10th appearance (9th start) with Gwinnett this season. The left-hander is 2-5 with a 7.38 ERA (42.2 IP/35 ER) with Gwinnett. In his last start with the Stripers on August 13 in Charlotte, he took no decision after allowing six runs (5 ER) over 5.1 innings of work. Before joining the Braves organization, Sheffield made 10 relief appearances with Triple-A Tacoma (0-1, 14.04 ERA, 8.1 IP, 13 ER). He was released by Seattle on April 27 and subsequently signed a minor league deal with Atlanta on May 4. Sheffield pitched in parts of four seasons for the Mariners (2019-22) and made three appearances with the Yankees in 2018. In his MLB career, Sheffield is 12-12 with a 5.47 ERA in 48 games (33 starts). A native of Tullahoma, Tenn. He was originally drafted with the 31st pick of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft by Cleveland.

**Black Swipes His 50th:** Tyler Black earned his 50th stolen base of the season in the third inning of last night's contest. The speedy infielder stole 47 bases with Double-A Biloxi and has swiped three more in 17 games with Nashville. Black is the first Milwaukee farmhand to steal at least 50 bases in a season since 2021, when David Hamilton picked up 52 in 101 games between High-A Wisconsin and Biloxi.

**Mr. Consistent:** Cam Devanney added another page last night to his strong August, driving in Nashville's only run with a double in the fourth inning. He has hit safely in seven straight games and reached base in 13 straight games, posting a .279 average (12-for-43) and .855 OPS over the on-base streak. This month, Devanney leads the club in doubles (6, tied) and ranks second in average (.313), OPS (.958), and extra-base hits (10, tied).

**Lauer Power:** Though he took the loss last night, starter Eric Lauer struck out a personal season-high nine hitters over just 4.2 innings, including five of six batters in the second and third. Lauer's previous season high was six, which he achieved on five occasions. The southpaw is the first Nashville pitcher to strike out nine in less than 5.0 innings since Aaron Ashby did it in 3.2 frames on July 25, 2021 in Jacksonville.

**El Toro Loco:** Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 16 games with a single and two walks last night. Over the span, which dates back to July 9, he is batting .409 (27-for-66) with 10 doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, 18 runs scored and a 1.184 OPS. Toro's .487 on-base percentage over the span is the third highest of 194 IL hitters with 75 plate appearances.

**Chasing the Sox:** Despite Nashville's loss last night, they lost ground to just one of four teams ahead of them in the International League standings- the now league-leading Worcester Red Sox. Lehigh Valley, Durham, and St. Paul all dropped their contests. Nashville is now two games back of first place in the International League's second half standings, tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for fifth.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's recently updated Top-30 Milwaukee prospects list. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 5 prospect and No. 56 in baseball, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 6 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the organization's No. 30 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet collected his 306th win at the helm of the Nashville club on Friday. He trails Rick Renick (1993-96) for second place on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. In order for Sweet to pass Trent Jewett (1998-00, 2003-04) for the most wins in Sounds history, Nashville would need to win 15 of their next 25 games. Sweet has a 306-238 record in four seasons as Nashville's skipper.

**LAST OUTING:** Junk turned in yet another quality start, but once again was hit with the loss. He allowed two runs in 7.0 innings, punching out a season-high seven Charlotte Knights, but took his second consecutive quality loss in Nashville's 5-1 defeat.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Junk has faced Gwinnett twice in his career, both coming earlier this season. He is 1-1 with a 6.35 ERA (11.1 IP/8 ER) and seven strikeouts. He earned a quality win (6.0 IP, 3 ER) on June 17.

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made his first start in the Brewers organization on April 2, allowing one run in 5.0 innings.
- Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings of relief on April 7 at Memphis, earning the win.
- Recalled to Milwaukee on April 11 to make start at Arizona on April 12 (L, 4.2 IP, 5 R, 4 ER)...optioned to Nashville on April 13.
- Earned the win in a start at Jacksonville on April 19...was the first win by a Nashville starter this season.
- Saddled with loss on April 27 vs. Omaha...home run allowed in second inning snapped Junk's 13.2-inning scoreless streak with Sounds, dating back to April 2.
- Went 0-3 with a 6.66 ERA (25.2 IP/19 ER) in five May starts.
- Snapped eight start winless streak with victory on June 17 vs. Gwinnett.
- Turned in back-to-back starts of 7.0 innings for the first time in his professional or collegiate career on June 23 vs. Norfolk and June 29 at Memphis.
- On August 19 vs. Charlotte, took first seven-inning loss of his career... was 6-0 in first six career starts of 7.0+ innings
- As of August 22, has second-lowest road ERA (3.02) of 42 Triple-A pitchers with 40+ road innings... trails only Gwinnett's Mike Soroka (2.74)
