### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, kicking off the second half of the season. Omaha will counter with LHP **Bailey Falter**. Columbus is 6-14 (.300) versus left handers this year. Falter has pitched against the Clippers twice in his career, both during the last week of last season, going 0-0 with a 0.00ERA (2.1IP, 1H, 0R, 0ER, 3BB, 4K).

### vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 47 of the last 76 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 76G, the Clippers are 10-45 (.182) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha (3-2 in last 5G), while going 19-2 (.905) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **Kody Huff** has played 16G against Omaha in his career, hitting .315 (17x54) with 4HR and 10RBI.

### Close-ing the Gap

Sunday's loss snapped a 6G winning streak in 1-run contests, but the Clippers are still 8-2 in the last 10G (10-8 on the year, .555, 6th in the IL). They are now 15-6 in the last 21G with a margin of three or fewer (29-20, .592, 3rd best). In total, over the last 31G (20-11), the Clippers have a +6 run margin (164-158). On the year, Columbus is at -9 (14th; all other IL teams with at least 40 wins average +59).

### Getting There

**Cooper Ingle** reached the qualification level for rate statistics in the IL on 6/7 and his .422OBP ranks 4th in the IL, despite slumping to a .296OBP over the last 21G (19x85, .224, 10BB, 24K). Ingle was 4x4 with a double and 3HR on 6/18 vs. Scranton/WB to jump back over .300, but is 0x7 since. At catcher, Ingle has a 1.293OPS (11HR) in 31G (.440OPS and 1HR in 17G between DH and LF).

### Brito Slump

**Juan Brito** is hitting .148/.292/.167 in his last 15G, with half his hits coming on 6/13 at Indy (4x5). He became the 53rd Clipper to amass 1,000PA on 6/19, with 900PA coming while batting second in the order (198G since IL debut on 9/19/23, +109G and 504PA on 2nd place, Omaha's **Drew Waters**; only batter with more games and PA at a particular spot: Omaha's **John Rave**, 199G and 930PA at leadoff).

### Naying It

**Bo Naylor** has reached base in 17 of 19G, posting a .398OBP (14BB in last 60PA; also has 4HR and 19K, yielding a 62% three true outcome rate). Since joining the team on 5/27, he is tied for the most RBI on the team (14), while scoring the most runs (15). Columbus catchers are hitting .302/.439/.576, leading the IL in all three categories by a wide margin (2nd in all is Memphis: .279/.389/.496).

### Run Production

**Kody Huff** tied a career high with his 47th RBI on Saturday (59th game, had 47RBI in 101G last season), while embiggening his career high for homers (10). He scored his 45th run on Sunday, tying his career high there (60th game, 45 in 98G with Akron in 2024). Since 5/3, Huff has 25BB to only 18K in 33G (12BB and 24K in first 27G), as his 37BB in 246PA have tied his total from last year (407PA).

### Struggling Slugging

**CJ Kayfus** snapped a 119AB homerless streak with Columbus on Friday, doing so out of the third spot in the order. The #3 hitter for Columbus has 8HR this year, with only the cleanup man and ninth batter hitting fewer (7; **Ralph Velazquez** has batted cleanup in all 25G he has played, 1HR in 95AB). The most powerful spots for the Clippers have been leadoff (16) and second (12).

### Tough Way to Go

**George Valera** saw his 21G on base streak snapped with a pinch-hit strikeout on 6/11 (5/5-6/10, .418OBP). Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but reached over half the time in the last 13G (.527OBP in 55PA; hit .366, 15x41 with 14BB and 6K). Valera responded with a hit in each of 2G since (2x5), including a pinch-hit RBI single on 6/13.

### Out(field) of Position

**Cooper Ingle** will be playing his sixth career game in the outfield tonight (all this season), alongside **Dayan Frias** (19th career game, 16th this season) and **CJ Kayfus** (85th game). Last week, **Milan Tolentino** made his first career appearance in the grass, while **Ralph Velazquez** played twice (26G in career). On the infield, **Kody Huff** is making his ninth start at third base (all this year).

### This Date in Clipper History

6/23/1983

The Clippers won 15-8 at Toledo as **Brian Dayett** chipped in with 3RBI on his way to establishing a franchise record 108RBI. The 1983 Clipper of the Year, Dayett also set the club record for HR in a season with 35. He narrowly missed out on winning the IL MVP (**Tim Teufel**, Toledo), marking just the second time from 1979-85 that a Clipper did not win the award.

### First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,447 to 1,396).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 107-92 (.538) in pitch reviews, with batters going 56-62 (.475) and pitchers/catchers going 51-30 (.630). They have run out of challenges in 35G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 4-3 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 54-36 when playing past regulation (.600, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 90G to require extra play, 71 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

### On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 836, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

### On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 94 through the first 74G (on pace for 189SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 24CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

### Crazy Eighths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 117 runs while crafting a .939OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 50 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +67 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 187-120 from innings 5-7).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,945RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.36 through the first 74G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 173HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 10th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 39G this season (25-14, .641), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** bunted the winning run into scoring position in an extra-inning win at Indianapolis on 6/14. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 88-23 (.793) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 5-2 mark this season (.714, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers have the 2nd most last at bat wins this year (12, Syracuse at 13) while playing in the 2nd most games decided in the last at bat (20; Scranton/WB has played 21). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 94G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 46-48 (.489, 15th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 427-439 (.493), 397-393 with Columbus (.503).

**Unfortunate Run:**

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

**From the 'Pen:**

After 10GS to start the season, Avila began June by pitching in relief on starter's rest. He gave up 3ER in both outings, 6/5 vs. Omaha and 6/11 at Indianapolis, turning in a 7.1ERA (7.0IP, 8H, 8R, 6ER, 2BB, 6K).

**Out of Here:**

Giving up 7HR in his last 5G (95BF), Avila is the only Clipper pitcher to surrender double digits this season (12HR, tied for 9th most in the IL; 244BF). Most of that damage has been done at Huntington Park (9HR to 136BF, .574SLG; 3HR to 108BF on the road, .385SLG).

**2026 Spring Training:**

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.

**Last Season:**

Pitched for Yakult in Japan... in the Central League (Majors) went 7-8 with a 4.04ERA in 15G (82.1IP, 70H, 41R, 37ER, 30BB, 61K)... in the Eastern League (minors) was 0-1 with a 1.33ERA in 6G (20.1IP, 12H, 3R, 1ER, 12BB, 13K).
