YESTERDAY: The Richmond Flying Squirrels came from behind to beat the Altoona Curve, 8-4. The Curve struck first in the second with a two-run homer by Conner Scott. Nick Gonzales added to the lead with an RBI double and a second run scored on an error to give Altoona a 4-0 lead. In the fourth, **Sean Roby** hit a solo home run to get the Flying Squirrels on the board. He added a second solo shot, his fifth of the series, in the sixth to close within two. In the seventh, Richmond scored on a wild pitch before Roby drove a go-ahead, two-run single. **Frankie Tostado** added an RBI single to extend the lead to 6-4. The teams cleared the benches following a pitch behind **Jacob Heyward** in the bottom of the eighth inning. Later that frame, **Brett Auerbach** pushed the lead to 8-4 with a two-run homer. **Chris Wright** picked up his first save of the year, working the final six outs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. This series is the only trip to Richmond for the Curve this year. The Flying Squirrels will play 12 games in Altoona, including six-game series from May 17-22 and July 12-17. The Flying Squirrels and Curve will play 18 games against each other this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are back in action after posting a 57-56 record in 2021, the first winning season for the franchise since 2015. That mark placed the team fourth in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division standings, 13 games behind first-place Akron for the year. This year marks the Flying Squirrels' 12th season. This year, they tied for first in the Southwest Division. Richmond won two-of-three in last weekend's series at Bowie to open the season.

THE CURVE went 58-59 last season, finishing one game behind the Flying Squirrels in fifth place in the Southwest Division and 14 games behind first-place Akron. The Curve opened the season at home last weekend against the Senators and dropped two of three games. Altoona is currently tied for first in the Eastern League with five home runs. The Altoona roster features 11 of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Nick Gonzalez (1), RHP Quinn Priester (4 - on IL), SS Liover Peguero (6), OF Matt Frazier (10), RHP Mike Burrows (11), RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (14), RHP Kyle Nicolas (19), 3B Jared Triolo (20), INF Tucupita Marcano (25), RHP Tahmaj Thomas (29) and OF Jack Suwinski (30). Altoona roster also includes RHP Colin Selby, a native of Chesapeake and a former DIII All-American at Randolph-Macon College in Ashland.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Tristan Beck** makes his first second of the season. He started the Flying Squirrels' home opener against Altoona on Tuesday and allowed three runs (two earned) over four innings in a loss. He made four starts for Richmond last year before going on the injured list with a back strain on June 9. Beck began a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League in August and made two relief appearances for Low-A San Jose. Beck was selected in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Stanford by the Atlanta Braves. He was traded to the Giants on July 31, 2019 along with RHP Dan Winkler in exchange for RHP Mark Melancon. Beck was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 30 Giants prospect entering the 2022 season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Kyle Nicolas takes the mound for his second start of the season. In his Pirates organization debut on Tuesday, he pitched 3.2 scoreless innings with five strikeouts. He was picked up by Pittsburgh on November 29, 2021 in a trade along with right-hander Zach Thompson and outfielder Connor Scott in exchange for catcher Jacob Stallings. Nicolas was the 61st overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Ball State. He made his professional debut last season for High-A Beloit, going 3-2 with a 5.28 ERA in 13 outings. Nicolas was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on July 21 and went 3-2 with a 2.52 ERA in eight starts, striking out 50 in 39.1 innings. He was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 29 Pirates prospect entering the 2022 season and ranked No. 19 by MLB.com.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Through Saturday, the Flying Squirrels hold the seventh-highest average attendance of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball at 6,950 fans per game. It is the second-highest average among the 30 teams in Double-A, trailing only Portland (7,191). The Flying Squirrels have sold out all 12 of their home openers, including Tuesday night. That game tied the third-largest crowd for the team at The Diamond in franchise history, evening the July 4 games in 2017 and 2018. The only two crowds with larger crowds were the home openers in 2018 and 2019, which drew 9,845 fans. Tuesday's crowd at The Diamond was the largest crowd in Double-A so far this season and the fourth-largest crowd of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

POWER SURGE: On Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels set a pair of franchise records. In the fourth inning, **Jacob Heyward**, **Shane Matheny**, **Brandon Martorano** and **Sean Roby** each hit home runs, breaking the team record for homers in an inning with four. The previous record was three, which has happened three times, most recently in the 5th inning of the Flying Squirrels' game at Bowie on August 15, 2021. The Flying Squirrels also broke the franchise record for home runs in a game with five total, starting with a 440-foot homer off the scoreboard by Roby in the second inning. The previous record of four homers has been achieved nine times, most recently in the game on August 15 last year at Bowie. The Flying Squirrels currently sit first in the Eastern League with 14 home runs this season.

BIG BATS: The Flying Squirrels offense is leading the Eastern League in team batting average (.278) and hits (76). The team is also in the league in homers (14) and ranked second in OPS (.841).

GETTING ON: The Flying Squirrels' offense is currently ranked second in the Eastern League with a .368 on-base percentage and are second in the league with 35 walks. **Sean Roby** is fourth in the league with a .516 on-base percentage and **Will Wilson** is tied for fifth with seven walks.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the league in homers (6), SLG (1.120), OPS (1.636), total bases (28) and he is tied for the league lead in RBIs (11) and extra-base hits (6). Roby is also fifth in the league in batting average (.400), fourth in OBP (.516), tied for eighth in walks (6), tied for fourth in hits (10) and tied for second in runs scored (8). **Brett Auerbach** is tied for fourth in the league in hits (10). **Will Wilson** is tied for fifth in walks (7). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for fourth in steals (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is ninth in ERA (1.86) and sixth in innings pitched (9.2). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (2).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

WHATS OLD IS NEW AGAIN: This year, Minor League Baseball's 11 leagues returned to their historical names after using regional names for the 2021 season. With the restructuring of the player development system prior to last season, the former Eastern League was referred to as the Double-A Northeast. This year, the circuit was renamed back to the Eastern League, which dates back to 1923. However, the league's divisions will continue with the new names adopted last year. The Flying Squirrels play in the Southeast Division, which was previously called the Western Division. The former Eastern Division was renamed the Northeast Division last year.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

SQUIRRELS AROUND THE WORLD: The Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster features players from four different countries, including 25 players who were born in the United States, spanning 14 states. Eight players are from California, three are from Washington, two are from Florida and North Carolina and one each hail from Alabama, Arkansas, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Rhode Island and Texas. **Kai-Wei Teng** will become the second player born in Taiwan to play for the Flying Squirrels. **Franklin Labour** is a native of the Dominican Republic and **Diego Rincones** was born in Venezuela.

FAMILIAR FACES: This year's Opening Day roster includes 12 returning players from last year's squad, including pitchers **Tristan Beck**, **R.J. Dabovich**, **Matt Frisbee**, **Frank Rubio**, **Patrick Ruotolo** and **Ryan Walker**, catcher **Brandon Martorano**, infielders **Shane Matheny**, **Frankie Tostado** and **Will Wilson** and outfielders **Jacob Heyward** and **Diego Rincones**.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tristan Beck** (30), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes **Dabovich** (17), **Wilson** (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
