## INOY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians offense was held scoreless for the first time in the 2024 season by the Louisville Bats at Louisville Slugger Field on Friday night, 3-0. With both teams scoreless in the bottom of the fifth frame, Louisville plated the first run of the contest courtesy of a sacrifice fly off the bat of Livian Soto. Soto then brought home the game's next run in the seventh inning on an RBI single to left. The Bats added an insurance run in the eighth with a solo shot from Nick Martini to put the game out of reach for Indianapolis.

SHUTOUT STATS: Entering last night's contest, the Indians were one of just two International League teams (also: Scranton/Wilkes-Barre) and five Triple-A teams to score at least one run in each of their games this season. Across their first 33 games, the Indians scored 173 runs. They were also the lone IL team and one of three Triple-A clubs (aso: Albuquerque and Sugar Land) to have recorded at least one RBI in each game.

BAE ON BASE: Ji Hwan Bae recorded one of six hits for the Indians last night and was one of two batters to reach base safely twice. On Thursday, he went 2-for-5 with the home run and a career-high tying five RBI for the first time since Aug. 22, 2019, with Single-A Greensboro at Delmarva. The two-hit performance was his ninth of the season in 19 games with Indianapolis, and in total he owns a .361 batting average ( 26 -for- 72 ), 18 runs, five extra-base hits, 11 RBI and a .991 OPS. Since his season debut on April 9 , he leads International League hitters in batting average and on-base percentage (.477) while also ranking ninth in OPS (.991).

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 16 games since April 18 after being hit by a pitch in the sixth inning last night. During that streak, he is hitting. 377 (20-for-53) with 10 runs, seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, .456 on-base percentage and 1.022 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 27 of 28 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.359, 33-for-92) while also ranking fifth in on-base percentage (.452) and eighth in OPS (.995).

QUIT HITTIN' BATTERS: Catcher Henry Davis, was hit by a career-high 20 pitches during his 2022 campaign with FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona, was hit four times in his first three games with Indianapolis this season after being hit once in 23 games with Pittsburgh. He has reached base safely in all four games at Louisville, extending that streak last night with a single in the third inning. Louisville's pitching staff has hit at least one batters each game this series and has racked up 35 hit batters this season, the most out of all 30 Triple-A teams and second-most in Minor League Baseball behind High-A Modesto (41).

WELCOME HOME: University of Louisville product Henry Davis returns to his college town for the first time during his professional career this week. Davis began the season on the Pirates' Opening Day roster and hit . 162 (11-for-68) with seven runs, three doubles and four RBI in 23 games with the big-league club before being optioned last week. In 14 Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit . 375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a 516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS. He was the first baseball player from Louisville to be selected first overall and the fourth studentathlete taken No. 1 overall from the school regardless of sport.

TONIGHT: The Indians will try to stave off a series loss in the penultimate game of the six-game set tonight at 7:15 PM at Louisville Slugger Field. The Bats took two of three meetings during the opening series between the two teams from 3/29-3/31 and lead the season series, 5-2. Continuing the series tonight for the Indians is RHP J.C. Flowers (2-1, 6.75), who has given up three earned runs in 1.2 relief innings against the Bats this season. Countering for Louisville is RHP Lyon Richardson ( $0-0,3.81$ ), who has tossed 8.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts against Indianapolis in his career.

SKENESDAY IN PITTSBURGH: The Pittsburgh Pirates today selected the contract of starting pitcher Paul Skenes, their №. 1 overall selection in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft who is currently rated as the No. 3 prospect and top pitcher in Minor League Baseball by MLB Pipeline. Skenes made his major league debut this afternoon vs. the Chicago Cubs at PNC Park and fanned seven across 4.0 innings, exiting with a lead and two runners on in the top of the fifth. He struck out leadoff hitter Mike Tauchman in the first inning for his first MLB strikeout as the second former Indianapolis Indians pitcher to make his big league debut this season, following right-handed starter Jared Jones. The 21-year-old began the season on Indianapolis' Opening Day roster and logged an International League-leading 0.99 ERA (3er/27.1ip) and 0.91 WHIP while ranking third with a .175 batting average against in seven Triple-A starts. He recorded a career-high eight strikeouts in back-to-back starts on April 12 at Toledo and April 18 vs. St. Paul en route to striking out 45 batters with Indianapolis, third-most in the league. In his penultimate Triple-A appearance on April 30 vs. Buffalo, Skenes tossed his first professional quality start with 6.0 shutout innings and seven strikeouts. He also threw 98 pitches clocked at 100 mph or higher, most in professional baseball.

THIS DATE IN 1997: Only three of the 16 Tribe hits were for extra bases in a 14-5 win over Omaha. The Indians put up four runs in the first inning, eight between the fourth, fifth and sixth innings, and three in the eighth to offset surrendering five runs in the fifth. Five of the Tribe's nine hitters notched multi-hit games, and the only extra-base hits were doubles off the bats of Tim Belk and Paul Bako and an Aaron Boone two-run home run.
