**FISHER CATS BLANK SENATORS:** A pair of early home runs and six shutout innings from Maximo Castillo (W, 9-3) led the Fisher Cats to a 7-0 win over Harrisburg Friday night. Vinny Capra (2-4, HR, 3 RBI, BB) hit his eighth of the season as Tanner Kirwer (2-4, HR, 3 RBI, BB) also went deep in the victory. Capra homered in the first off Senators starter Tim Cate (L, 2-7). Nick Podkul and Kirwer had RBI singles in the second to make it 5-0. Kirwer homered in the fourth for the game's final runs. Castillo went six innings, giving up five hits and no runs. Johnny Barbato struck out five of the six batters he faced before Emerson Jimenez faced the minimum in the ninth to finish up.

**'MAX'IMUM EFFORT:** Castillo's nine wins are second most in the league, and all of Double-A. In fact, only one Triple-A pitcher has nine wins (former Fisher Cat Austin Bibens-Dirkx, who's with Ok. City). Castillo became the first starter to go at least six innings without allowing a run.

**UP NEXT:** Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to Hartford to conclude the season series with the Yard Goats. This is New Hampshire's second and final 12-game road trip of the year. The Fisher Cats have won or split ten of the last eleven series played. The Fisher Cats will face Harrisburg 8 more times this season to round out the season series with the Southwest division.

In the fourth, Chad Spanberger walked, Kevin Smith singled, and Williams singled to make it 1-0. Yennsy Diaz, the first of four New Hampshire pitchers, went five innings for his ninth win.

Nick Fraze (phrase), just promoted from Adv. A Vancouver, makes his first start tonight. Last worked last Sunday for the Canadians against Hillsboro. He suffered the loss, going 4.2 IP with 2 ER and 6 K. 23-year old RHP was selected by the Blue Jays in the 22nd round of the 2019 draft (Texas State). Compiled a 3-2 record with a 2.14 ERA in 11G (nine starts) for Adv. A Vancouver with 46 K in 42 IP and an impressive WHIP of just 0.88. His first 23 career games have all come with Vancouver.

Harrisburg counters with Gerardo Carrillo, a 22-year old RHP from Guadalajara, Mexico. Came to the Nationals organization in the July 30 Max Scherzer/Trea Turner trade to the LA Dodgers. Made his first start for the Senators against Erie last Sunday, allowing two runs in five innings. Went 3-2 for Double-A Tulsa before the trade, and pitched well in July (2-1, 2.35 ERA in 5 GS with 25 K in 23 IP).

The Fisher Cats turn to Reilly Hovis for the series finale Sunday afternoon. He will be making his eighth start since joining the Blue Jays organization. Last worked last Sunday at Delta Dental Stadium in a 10-5 loss to the Yard Goats. Hovis allowed a pair of two-run homers to Coco Montes, but left with a 5-4 lead.

Originally drafted by the Marlins in the ninth round of the 2015 draft (North Carolina), Hovis advanced to Double-A Jacksonville but was cut before the 2019 season. Was playing independent ball for his hometown Gastonia Honey Bears this season when offered the opportunity with the Blue Jays.

This will be his first career start against Harrisburg.
