SWB stormed back with a three-run eighth to overcome the Pigs two home runs. The RailRiders bullpen was on lock, allowing just two hits in the final five frames. The Iron Pigs got on the board in the first inning with Dalton Guthrie's solo shot to deep left field. The home team added another off another home run from Vimael Machin in the fourth to lead 2-0. In the fifth, Jesus Bastidas led off the frame with a base knock for the RailRiders. A bunt single from Michael Hermosillo moved him to second and a groundout shifted him 90 feet from home. Jose Godoy's RBI single brought in Bastidas to trail by just one. The score remained 2-1 in favor of Lehigh Valley until Scranton/Wilkes-Barre batted through the order in the eighth. Elijah Dunham started things off with a walk. Oswald Peraza's double into left field sent home Dunham to tie the game at two. An error allowed Jamie Westbrook to reach and a double from Willie Calhoun put two in scoring position. Bastidas was intentionally walked to load the bases. Then, Hermosillo was hit by a pitch for the second time in the contest, which sent in Westbrook giving SWB a 4-2 lead. Ryan Weber took the start for the RailRiders throwing four innings, allowing just two runs on two hits. He struck out a season high six batters. Matt Krook (W, 1-1) threw 3.1 innings in relief Keeping the Pigs off the scoreboard. Matt Bowman needed just six pitches in 1 -2-3 eighth. INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE - The team's pitching is fourth in the league with a low 3.00 earned run average. The staff is led by the bullpen which has tossed 57% of the innings. SWB has given up just 18 earned runs, while LHV has given up 19 but in one less contest. The Iron Pigs are just below them with a 3.72 ERA. Out of 30 teams in the league, the RailRiders are sixth from the bottom with a .232 team average. However, that is ticks above where they were prior to last night. The Iron Pigs have a team average. average of .237 at the plate.

OSWALD ON THE MOVE- Oswald Peraza leads the team with five stolen bases on six attempts this season. The RailRiders have nine total snags with two more coming from Elijah Dunham. Last season, Peraza had 33 total steals to help the team take 172 bases. This was a season-high record for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18). Randy Vasguez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.


