- Dunedin's struggles at the plate continued last night, as the Hammerheads downed the Jays 3-0 for the team's fifth consecutive loss. - Jupiter struck first in the second inning with an unearned run off Jays' starter Juaron Watts-Brown, as Yeral Martinez reached on an error, allowing Brock Vradenburg to score from second base.

- Watts-Brown only allowed two hits in the rest of his four-inning outing – one of which was a Martinez solo homer in the fourth, which made it 2-0. The Jays' bullpen took over for the fifth, and Aaron Munson surrendered a two-out, RBI double to Vradenburg that pushed the deficit to 3-0.

- Dunedin's bullpen settled in after the fifth, as Munson fired a scoreless sixth, and Yondrei Rojas and Jordan Powell followed with scoreless frames. However, the bats never got jumpstarted, and the Jupiter bullpen finished the contest with three innings of one-hit ball.

SLLLIDING

After ripping off six consecutive victories from April 6 through April 12, the Blue Jays have dropped five straight, dating back to Friday vs Clearwater. These streaks mark the first instance of Dunedin having a win streak and losing streak longer than five games in the same month since July 2019, when a 10-game win streak was immediately followed by a five game losing streak.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

Dunedin's offense has sputtered across its five game losing streak, batting .204 with an OBP of .291, striking out 56 times while walking just 16 times. The Blue Jays entered the streak averaging over six runs per game, but have scored just 12 runs in their last five contests.

IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias returned to the Blue Jays lineup in strong fashion last night, going 2-4 to extend his hit streak to six and on-base streak to nine. Before missing four games with shoulder soreness before last week, Arias ranked top 10 in the league in average, OBP, and OPS. The outfielder leads Dunedin in all three categories.

DURAN DURAN

Edward Duran extended his team-leading hit streak to seven games Tuesday with his first inning RBI single. The backstop is hitting .360 with a .907 OPS across the stretch. Duran was acquired by the Blue Jays from the Marlins in the trade that sent Zach Pop and Anthony Bass to Toronto in 2022.

PUTTING 'EM ON THE BOARD

Despite scoring just 12 runs in the last five games, Dunedin's 91 are tied for second in the Florida State League.

THIEVERY

This week's series pits the Florida State League's two best base-stealing teams against each other. Dunedin's 43 stolen bases on 53 attempts (81%) ranks second in the circuit to Jupiter's 54. Dunedin surrendered a season-high six stolen bases last night, while they were held without one for the second time this season.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Saturday night's start on the mound, Lazaro Estrada became the sixth player to make a rehab appearance with Dunedin this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoza joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

ALMOST PERFECT 10

Dunedin's 8-2 start to the season marked the best start by a Blue Jays' squad since 2014, then the team also opened the season 8-2 through its first 10 games. The 2024 D-Jays pushed their record to 13-2 before picking up a third loss.

COMING UP THE PIPELINE

The D-Jays Opening Day roster is loaded with eight of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The 30-man roster includes the Jays' last two first round draft picks; LHP Brandon Barriera (2022) and Infielder Arjun Nimmala (2023). Nimmala is ranked as the third-best prospect in the system, while Barriera is ranked fourth. Opening Day starter Fernando Perez is Pipeline's No. 24 Blue Jays prospect, after leading the FCL Blue Jays in innings pitched in 2023.
