LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox held off the Altoona Curve on Tuesday in a 3-2 victory at Prince George's Stadium. Jud Fabian broke the tie in the seventh with a go-ahead sac fly to bring home **Collin Burns**. Burns opened the scoring with a two-run homer down the left field line. Cameron Weston twirled 5.1 innings and did not allow an earned run while Dan Hammer earned the win with 1.2 innings of relief. Dylan Heid collected a two inning save to bring Bowie back above .500.

TEENAGE DREAM

C Samuel Basallo is just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian is now the Eastern League's active leader in home runs (12) after the promotions of Somerset's Agustin Ramirez and Ben Rice. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. He's hitting .243 through 54 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season. His batting average on balls in play has jumped over 50 points in that

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B Matthew Etzel has made quite a first impression since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on June 11. Etzel has collected a hit in all six games played for the Baysox thus far, including his first multi-hit game at Double-A last night. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B Dylan Beavers has reached base in 46 of 53 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.365) and leads the team in walks (33), tied for the third-most in the Eastern League. On Saturday, Beavers reached base at least three times in a game for the 10th time this year.

SHOVING THE SHOVE

Bowie's pitching staff has recorded the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League in the month of June at 3.12 behind league-leading Hartford (3.09). The Baysox own the second-lowest WHIP (1.10) in all of Double-A this month and are tied with Tulsa (Double-A Dodgers) for the fourth-lowest ERA this month.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (303.2) and strikeouts (350). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is tied for the third-lowest in Double-A.

ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Drake Fellows takes the hill for his fourth start of the season with the Curve. The 26-year-old was transferred from Triple-A Indianapolis to Double-A Altoona on June 11 and two days later, he threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowed five hits, no walks and struck out four to collect the win against Erie. In six appearances and three starts with the Curve this season, Fellows owns a 1.23 ERA over 22 innings with 22 strikeouts over just nine walks.



Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Curveball (best secondary), Slider, Changeup Ranked the Orioles No. 16 prospect, via MLB Pipeline Has thrown 5th-most innings in O's system this season

2024: Took loss after delivering 4.0 IP and giving up 4 R (3 ER) on 6 H over 1 BB and 4 K on Thu. 6/13 @ HBG in most recent start. Has punched out six or more batters in six of 12 starts. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 3.56 ERA in seven home starts. Baysox are 4-8 when Bright starts but have lost last five in a row. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activated that the chesapeake in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticuthe began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assist ant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2023 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
