LRST TIME OUT

(ST. PAUL, MN - Aug 25) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders bested the St. Paul Saints 5-2 on Sunday afternoon. A home run from Jahmai Jones lifted the team to victory so they could split the series against the Saints.

An early pitchers' duel ensued right out of the gate with both starters putting up three scoreless frames.

The RailRiders got their first hits and runs in the fourth inning. Jasson Dominguez doubled and Oswald Peraza singled him home for a 1-0 lead.

SWB's starter Tom Pannone (W, 8-9) worked five innings of shutout ball. He allowed just five hits and a walk while striking out two. Counterpart Aaron Rozek pitched six frames letting up just the one run.

Alex Mauricio tossed a clean sixth and the RailRiders got to work in the seventh. Oswald Peraza notched a hit, his second of the day. After T.J. Rumfield earned a walk, Carlos Narvaez singled to load the bases. JC Escarra batted one home and then Jahmai Jones smacked a three-run homer for a 5-0 advantage.

The Saints battled back in the bottom half. Patrick Winkel led off with a walk and Jeferson Morales doubled them into scoring position. Diego Castillo's groundout plated their first run of the contest. Major League rehabber Brooks Lee followed with an RBI double for a 5-2 score.

Victor González (S, 2) took on the ninth to preserve the win and secure the series split.

NEWS & NOTES

OFF AND MOVING - The RailRiders stole nine bases last week, led by Jasson Dominguez's five. The team has set a season-high franchise record with 197 steals, topping last year's 174 total. This is the most in the International League and second most in Triple-A behind Tacoma's ridiculous 247.

VERSUS LEFT - The RailRiders have seven of fifteen arms as lefties on their pitching staff right now. Four of them are set to be a part of the starting rotation. Southpaw pitchers have held opposing batters to a .233 average against this summer.

FIRST IS THE WORST - The RailRiders have allowed a total of 103 runs in the first inning of play. It is nine more than their next highest frame with 92 scored in the fourth. The team holds a +67 run differential on the season.

BICKFORD TO THE BIGS - The Yankees selected the contract of Phil Bickford as he took the roster spot of Michael Tonkin who was designated for assignment. It will be Bickford's second stint in the big leagues with New York. The righty held a 3.00 earned run average in Triple-A in 45.0 innings of work. He allowed just 15 walks to 55 strikeouts.

STRIKEOUTS > WALKS: Last week the pitching staff struck out 40 batters, compared to just 15 walks allowed. On the season, the team has recorded 1,084 K's to 500 total walks. Two players have achieved triple digit strikeout counts with the RailRiders - Will Warren who has 119 and Edgar Barclay who recently reached 100.

ADDING A DUKE - On August 26, the Yankees claimed Duke Ellis off of waivers from the Seattle Mariners. To add him to their 40-man roster, the pushed Ian Hamilton to the 60-Day IL. Ellis, 26, will join his fourth organization of the season after spending time with Seattle, the New York Mets, and the Chicago White Sox. The outfielder made his Major League debut in June playing in eight games without recording a hit, but stealing four bases.

STEADY EDDIE - Edgar Barclay gets the Tuesday start after spending the entire season on Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's roster. Barclay has totaled 100 strikeouts in a career-high 117.2 innings. He is making his 25th start of the summer, the most in the Yankees farm system. His offspeed and breaking ball pitches have been working for him, but the southpaw has allowed 26 home runs.

ELIGIBLE ENERGY - The RailRiders active roster currently contains 11 players that are also on the Yankees 40-man roster. There are six pitchers all of whom they consider bullpen arms. The team also features five position players who are eligible for a quick call-up, including #1 Prospect Jasson Dominguez and #16 Jorbit Vivas. Oswald Peraza and Carlos Narvaez also remain on the big league 40-man.

2023 TRIPS: Began season on injured list with elbow inflammation. Activated and assigned to Somerset on 5/30, made season and Double-A debut on 5/31 with 11 total relief appearances...Was promoted to SWB on 8/1 where he made 10 starts

Was a 3x Western Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week in his season at Cal State-Bakersfield, where he led the WAC with 111 strikeouts and also led the Roadrunners in shutouts (2) and complete games (2) en route to being named 2019 Academic All-WAC.
