Captain's Log

LAST TIME OUT: Last night saw win seven in a row for the Lake County Captains, a 3-1 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps. After allowing a run in the first, Captain starter Jack Leftwich held the TinCaps to just two hits over the next four innings. Lake County offensively got a home run to left field from Johnathan Rodriguez in the sixth, his nineteenth of 2022. Lake County took the lead in the eighth, scoring two runs, helped by a Fort Wayne error.

IS STAT SO?: The Captains are on their longest winning streak since 2015, with seven consecutive wins. The longest winning streak in Lake County history is 13 games, which they achieved from May 27 to June 8, 2003, a season where they won a franchise best 97 games.

JROD'S JULY: Minor League Baseball announced Friday August 5th, that Captains outfielder Johnathan Rodriguez was awarded the Midwest League Player of the Month for July. The 22-year-old posted a slash line of .378/.420/.805 in 20 games played. He led the Midwest League in home runs with nine, runs batted in with 25 and an on-base plus slugging of 1.225. For the month, the Puerto Rican born outfielder had nine multi-hit games and had a homer in back-to-back games twice.

ON BASE STREAKS: Petey Halpin's on base streak was snapped last night at 30 games, the longest of any Captain in 2022. In 23 of the 30 games, Halpin has gained at least one hit. The 20-year-old had 19 walks during the stretch. Angel Martinez has reached base safely in his last 22 games, smacking four of his eight home runs this season in the span.

PLANEZ'S PLACE IN CAPTAINS HISTORY: Alexfri Planez this season strung together a 22-game hit streak. It stands as the longest streak in the Midwest League this season. The 20-year-old was just two hits away from the longest hitting streak in Lake County history. Francisco Mejia, now a Tampa Bay Ray had a hit in 24 consecutive games with the Captains in 2016. Over the stretch, Planez had a .333/.340/.667 slash line with eight home runs, 23 runs batted in and 32 hits. Planez only walked once during the streak. The streak began on June 14th and ended July 14th.

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Doug Nixhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 79 innings over 18 starts allowing 31 earned runs. Today's starter Tommy Mace was taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick, the right-hander has 58 strikeouts in 63.1 innings pitched. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft, his eight home runs allowed is the lowest among qualifying Captains starters. Cleveland selected Jack Leftwich with the 216th overall pick in the seventh round. Leftwich has just eight runs over 31.1 innings with Lake County. Rodney Boone was an eighth-round selection, pick number 246, and has made eight starts including a complete game shutout against the Lansing Lugnuts on July 2nd.

THREE'S A CROWD: Last week three former Lake County Captains made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians. Will Benson was the game winning run, on August 1st, in a 6-5 11-inning Cleveland win over Arizona. Tyler Freeman started at third base, on August 3rd, going 1-3 with a walk. Pitcher Hunter Gaddis earned the start against the Houston Astros on August 5th and is the lone 2021 Captain to reach the Majors.

LAST TIME OUT: Tommy Mace had unfortunate luck in his last start. The right-hander through four allowed two runs both unearned off two errors. In the fifth, after getting two strikeouts, Mace permitted a walk and double then a catchers' interference loaded the bases. The TinCaps capitalized scoring five runs.

IN THE SWAMP: The Florida native pitched four seasons at the University of Florida. Primarily a starter, Mace earned 258 strikeouts in 269.2 innings and a 4.37 ERA. He finished with a 22-7 record.

COMMUNITY SERVICE: Mace was on the SEC Community Service Team in the 2021 and 2020 seasons. The honor goes to players in recognition of their off the field volunteering and community service activities.

WANNA HAVE A CATCH?: As a freshman at Florida, Mace became "catch" partners with Brady Singer, who is currently in his third year as a member of the Kansas City Royals and was their first round draft pick in 2018. Both treated "catch" very seriously, using it as a time to work on their craft. They first became friends after finding out they had a shared interest in golf and became partners there too.

TRUST: Mace was first drafted back in 2017, by the Cincinnati Reds in Round 12. He elected to attend Florida instead and told the Perfect Game Amateur Hour podcast he trusted himself and "wanted to get what he was worth"

GROWTH SPURT: The 6'6 pitcher shot up to that height during his senior year at Sunlake High School near Tampa. During that season, Mace had a 1.29 ERA in 70.2 innings pitched and led the Seahawks to the FHSAA 7A Regional Finals.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

Nine former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Hunter Gaddis: The right-hander made his Major League Debut on August 5th, getting the start against the Houston Astros at Progressive Field. Despite a scoreless first, Gaddis would allow eight runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings. Gaddis quickly worked through the minor league ranks and was a Captains just last season where he had a 4.16 ERA in 20 games pitched.

Tyler Freeman: On August 3rd, Tyler Freeman made his MLB debut, getting the start at third base and went 1-3 with a walk against the Arizona Diamondbacks. The 23-year-old played 61 games with Lake County in 2019, going .292/.382/.424 and starting 57 games at short before being called up to Lynchburg.

Will Benson: Benson in his major league debut came across the plate as the winning run in a 6-5 11-inning triumph for the Guardians over the D-Backs on August 1st. The 2016 Draft's 14th overall pick played in Lake County in 2018 and 2019 and is remembered for hitting four home runs, the most in a game by any Captain, on April 18, 2019 against the South Bend Cubs at Classic Park.

Nolan Jones: The 2016 second round pick, played his first game in the show, on July 8th against the Kansas City Royals. In his first major-league at bat, Jones smacked a RBI double down the right field line. Jones was a Captain in 2018, playing 90 games, compiling 90 hits including 16 longballs.

Oscar Gonzalez: The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts. He made 22 starts in the 2018 season as a Captain, accumulating a 4.29 ERA through 115.1 innings.

Tanner Tully: The left-hander from Elkhart, Indiana, made his MLB debut on April 22nd entering in the fifth inning against the Yankees. He went two innings allowing two hits, and one run over 38 pitches. Tully was a Captain in 2017, where he 16 appearances, eight starts and posted a 3.16 ERA over 77 innings.

Bryan Lavastida: Lavastida caught all nine innings for the Guardians in their 17-3 win over the Kansas City Royals on April 10th. He earned his first big league hit April 22nd at Yankee Stadium. Lavastida was a Captain in 2021 playing in 48 games where he batted .303/.399/.467.
