ROCKER SHINES IN DOUBLE-A DEBUT, FRISCO OUTDUELED BY TULSA: The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Tulsa Drillers 2-0 on Friday evening from Riders Field. **Kumar Rocker** was strong in his Double-A debut, striking out Alex Freeland to open the contest and earn his first career strikeout in a RoughRiders (15-10, 59-35) uniform. The Rangers No. 3 prospect delivered 3.0 scoreless, one-hit innings with four punchouts. In the home half of the first inning, **Josh Jung** singled against Tulsa (13-11, 47-46) starter Chris Campos to begin his rehab assignment in Frisco. The former All-Star was stranded at second base. **Cody Bradford**, making his second rehab appearance of the week in Frisco, entered in the top of the fourth. The lefty spun 2.2 one-hit innings while fanning two. Ricky DeVito picked up the final out of the top of the sixth and finished after 1.1 scoreless frames. **Skylar Hales** cruised through a 1-2-3 eighth inning, striking out one before handing the ball to **Andy Rodriguez** (1-1). In the top of the ninth, Dalton Rushing provided the first run of the contest with his second solo homer of the series. Jose Ramos extended the Tulsa lead to 2-0 with a sacrifice fly, scoring Damon Keith. Lucas Wepf (3-0) worked the bottom of the ninth for the Drillers, retiring the side in order to seal the win. The RoughRiders winning streak snapped at three games as Frisco has outhit their opponent in each of their inst three losses. **Alejandro Osuna** logged the lone multi-hit night and provided the only extra-base hit with a double. Jung finished his first rehab appearance in Frisco qoing 1-for-3. Jung finished his first rehab appearance in Frisco going 1-for-3.

I WANT TO BE FOREVER JUNG:

Rangers third baseman **Josh Jung** is slated to rehab with the RoughRiders Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Jung was a star during the World Series run last season with the Rangers, batting .308/.329/.538/.867 with four doubles, three home runs and eight RBIs in 17 playoff games. During the regular season, he was the AL All-Star starter at third base while finishing fourth in AL Rookie of the Year voting. With the RoughRiders in 2021, Jung played 43 games, batting .308 with 10 home runs and 40 RBIs before finishing out the season with Triple-A Round Rock and debuting in 2022 with Texas. In his first rehab game on Friday, he went 1-for-3 with a single.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

FUSH IT OTHE MAXIMO: Maximo Acosta has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders in July, hitting .279 (17-for-61)/.328/.410/.738 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, eight RBIs, 10 runs scored and six stolen bases. As one of six qualified players in the Texas League age 21 or younger, Acosta is hitting .342 (13-for-38)/.395/.526/.921 over his last 10 games. He has also excelled with runners in scoring position, placing third in the Texas League with a .343 average with RISP and first with a .462 average with RISP and two outs.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 34-14 at Riders Field this season. Their 34 wins and .708 winning per-centage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +81 run differential, a 3.57 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .756 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-21 with a 3.41 ERA, but a +17 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .633 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing. 346/.403/.605/1.008 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .346 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium. stadium

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Suna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 19 games, he is hitting .310 (22-for-71)/405/592/997 with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Over his last 16 games, he is batting .328 (19-for-58)/.437/.638/1.075 with five doubles, two triples, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with three doubles and a 1.007 OPS for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 17 games, he is hitting .302 (19-for-63)/.384/.524/.908 with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBIs and seven runs scored. This season, he has a career highs in average (.278), slugging percentage (.470) and OPS (.808) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (72) and home runs (18).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The BULL/PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD: Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.96 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.50), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .227 BAA is on pace to be the bett in the franchisch bittory. is on pace to be the best in the franchise's history.

WE'RE GOING DANCING

WE'RE GOING DANCING: Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. of Minor League Baseball.
