"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS SQUANDER LOPEZ'S STRONG REHAB START: The St. Paul Saints failed to back a strong outing from the rehabbing Pablo Lopez, who threw 4.2 innings of one-run ball while striking out four, and had the tying run cut down at the plate in a 1-0 loss to the I-Cubs on Saturday afternoon. The St. Paul lineup only managed four hits, two of them from DH Mickey Gasper in his first game after being optioned, and threatened when Gasper doubled with two away in the ninth. After Gasper was lifted for pinch-runner Dalton Shuffield, Emmanuel Rodriguez lined a base hit, but Shuffield was cut down by right fielder Owen Caissie to drop the Saints down 2-3 in the series. Caissie also drove in the game's only run with a 3-0 homer off Lopez to right-center. The defeat was the 10th game in Saints history that ended with a 1-0 final score; seven of them have been St. Paul losses.

WHY ARE THE RUNS ALWAYS GONE?: The Saints rank just 16th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.2/game entering play on Tuesday. The meager runs scored numbers are despite the Saints ranking middle of the pack in terms of team batting average (.250, t-9th) and OPS (.738, 11th). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been hitting with runners in scoring position: St. Paul are hitting .253 in such situations, ranking t-11th in the league in that category. In the seven St. Paul wins this season, the Saints are hitting .319 (30-94) w/ RISP. In the 10 games they've lost, they are hitting .162 (11-68) w/ RISP.

MCCUSKER MASHING: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). The 6-8 slugger has hit five home runs in the past ten games which is tyied for the most HR in the minor leagues since April 9 and now ranks t-3rd in the International League in HR this season. His two-run double on Tuesday in Iowa registered at 111.8 mph off the bat, the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Saint this year. McCusker now has two of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. While his top-end exit velos are impressive, he's also consistently hit the ball hard, and ranks 5th the International League with a 62.5% hard-hit rate, meaning over 60% of his batted balls are put in play at 95 mph or harder.

THEY DON'T CALL IT A "CHALLENGE" FOR NOTHING: After two missed challenges in Saturday's game in Iowa, the Saints have now been incorrect on their last 16 consecutive ABS challenges (Armando Alvarez had the last successful challenge on 4/6 @COL).

BACK, TRACK, WALL... YOU KNOW THE REST: The 12 home runs allowed by the Saints the past four games in Iowa is the second-most home runs the St. Paul pitching staff has allowed in a four-game span in franchise history, eclipsed only by a stretch of 13 homers allowed from June 23-27, 2024 vTOL@IOW (*the most home runs St. Paul have allowed in a five-game span is 16 from June 9-June 13, 2021-all vOmaha). The Saints had entered play last Wednesday giving up just three homers (the fewest allowed in Triple-A at the time) in 110.0 innings through 13 games, an average of 0.25 HR/9. The 12 longballs they've ceded in the last four games translates to an average of 3.3 HR/9, buoyed by the 8 allowed in Wednesday's game two, including 5 round-trippers hit in a nine-run seventh inning (both the runs and homers allowed were the most allowed in a single-inning in Saints history). Despite some big home run totals allowed lately, the Saints rank 4th in the International League in fewest home runs allowed (15) this year and the four HRA by the starting staff is tied for the fewest given up among starting pitchers in Triple-A.

WALKIN' DOWN THE LINE: St. Paul's 88 walks drawn as an offense currently ranks t-8th in the International League entering play Tuesday, but on a walks-per-game basis, they lead the league averaging 5.2 bases on balls per game. The Saints' .358 team on-base percentage is second only to the Iowa Cubs (.364) in the International League. The Saints had drawn at least two walks in each game this season until drawing just one on Saturday in Iowa and have taken four or more bases on balls in 12-of-17 contests so far this year. Mike Ford and Emmanuel Rodriguez both currently lead the Saints with 12 walks drawn apiece. Mike Ford owns a .371 career on-base percentage and has walked at a 14 career BB-rate in his MiLB career. Emmanuel Rodriguez now has drawn 212 base on balls since 2023, his first season in A-ball, which is top-25 in the minor leagues over that span.

START ME UP: The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a solid start to the year, spinning a 3.54 ERA among starters that ranks 7th in the International League. If you throw out Andrew Morris' outing last Wednesday in Iowa (7 ER, 3.2 IP), the Saints starting staff have a 2.77 ERA (20 ER, 65.0 IP). The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so. (It's only the second time ever that Saints starters have not allowed a run in three consecutive games with the last coming from June 29-July 1, 2023 when Randy Dobnak and Blayne Enlow threw 5.0 shutout in back-to-back games before Dallas Kuechel went 4.1 scoreless the following night, all against Gwinnett).

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MiLB.com and nine according to Baseball America while also touting four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MiLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & CJ Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (7-15) were swept over the weekend in Atlanta and have lost 7 of their previous 10 games. The Twins rank 26th/30 in MiLB in runs scored (75, 3.4/gm); three of the bottom-5 lowest scoring teams reside in the AL Central (also: KCR, CHW). Luke Keaschall is 4-for-12 (.333) with a pair of doubles & 2 RBI in his first three games in the majors since going up. Brock Stewart was activated from the 7-Day IL on Saturday, taking Kody Funderburk's roster spot after he was optioned to St. Paul. Double-A Wichita (8-7) are back above .500 after taking both games of a doubleheader in Tulsa Saturday to put a stop to a four-game losing skid. Outfielder Tyler Fedko, a 12th round pick out of UConn by the Twins in 2021, has reached base in 11 consecutive games to start the year and is hitting .364 (12-33)/.512/.818, ranking top-4 in the Texas League in all three triple-slash categories, with 3 HR, High-A Cedar Rapids (9-5) and Low-A Fort Myers (8-7) have each won back-to-back games entering Tuesday.

LAST APPEARANCE: Went five innings with no more than a run allowed in his third consecutive start to open the season on Tuesday night in Iowa. Went six-up, six-down to begin the night before a leadoff double by Carlos Perez in the third. Faced three over the minimum with the help of two inning-ending double plays in the third and fourth. Struck out the last three hitters he faced to leave a pair stranded in the fifth. Struck out three on the four-seam fastball, three on the slider, and one on the changeup while inducing 10 swings-and-misses.

HITTING THE GLOVE: Last season, Matthews opened up the year on an incredible stretch without walking a batter. He issued his first walk of the season on May 22, seven starts into the campaign (also his 24th birthday). He struck out 49 batters before issuing a walk, facing 141 hitters before issuing a free pass. Since 1893, when the mound was moved to its current position, only two Major League pitchers began a season with more strikeouts before issuing a walk: Kenley Jansen with the Dodgers in 2017 (51 K) and Corbin Burnes for the Brewers in 2021 (58 K). Matthews led the Minors with a 16.29 K:BB ratio last season among all arms with at least 40 IP, and was 6th among all MLB rookies with at least 35.0 IP with a 3.91 ratio during his time in the Bigs to end the year. Since going pro, his career 10.55 K:BB ratio in the minors leads MiLB entering the season (min 200 IP).

TINKERING WITH THE ARSENAL: A big reason for Matthews' success over the past two seasons has been a jump in velocity, which he attributes to attending the Twins' velocity camp before the start of Spring Training. He went from a college pitcher who sat in the low-90's, sometimes touching 96 mph, to a guy who regularly sits at 96 with his fastball while occasionally reaching back for 98. Working with Tommy Bergians in the Spring of 2024, he scrapped a sweepy slider he threw in 2023 for a harder slider in 2024, which pairs well with his cutter, curveball, and changeup.

WHAT THE HECK IS A CATAMOUNT?: After starting his college career at Walters State Community College (TN) in 2019, Matthews transferred to the Divison 1 ranks at Western Carolina, where he would put together one of the best careers for a Catamount pitcher in school history. After being limited to just 61.1 innings due to an elbow injury as a RS sophomore, he put together a 1st Team All-Southern Conference campaign in 2022, striking out 122, the only pitcher in the SoCon's history to eclipse the century mark; it was the third-most strikeouts in a single-season in program history for Western Carolina. When he went in the 8th round (234th overall) in 2022, he became the highest draft pick in Western Carolina history.

HIGHS & LOWS: While a high school pitcher, Zeby once gave up a walk-off homer in the 2nd round of the 2A NCHSAA playoffs while with Smoky Mountain High. After the game, he retrieved the ball from beyond the fence and kept it as motivation. The ball stays on his shelf next to the ball from the game he threw a perfect game in during his senior season.

- Jim Rantz Award Winner (Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year)
 - Entered the year as the Twins No. 15 prospect by Baseball America, No. 24 by MLB.com
 - Ascended from High-A Cedar Rapids to to the Big Leagues in the span of a season, becoming the first Twins pitcher since Randy Dobnak in 2019 to pitch at four separate levels in the Twins organization, including Minnesota, in one season...was one of three rookies in the Twins starting rotation (along with David Festa & Simeon Woods-Richardson) in 2024 to be leaned on in the final months of the Twins' postseason push
