### JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 5-3 IN EXTRAS

Griffin Conine homered on Wednesday, but Jacksonville lost 5-3 in 10 innings to Nashville. Conine's homer came in the second and opened up the scoring. The Sounds struck back in the fifth with a pair of RBI singles to grab the lead. A **Jonathan Guzman** RBI single knotted the score at two in the sixth inning. The score remained that way until the 10th. **Tyler Black** smacked a three-run home run to put Nashville ahead 5-2. A **Troy Johnston** RBI ground out in the bottom of the 10th made it 5-3, but the Jumbo Shrimp could get no closer in the defeat.

### TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 32 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 36-for-131, slashing .275/.338/.466/.804 with seven doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs, 13 walks and 23 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 18.6 percent this season with Jacksonville.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 27 of Jacksonville's 41 games (65.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including nine of the last 10 contests and 12 of the club's last 14 affairs. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 11 of its last 12 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-14 in these affairs.

### TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last 11 games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 71 runs (6.5 per game), tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 71 runs, a whopping 40, or 56.3 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 128 hits in 115.0 innings pitched with two outs, the second-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .272 with an .814 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the fourth- and sixth-highest marks at the level.

### TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

After falling 5-3 on Wednesday vs. Nashville, Jacksonville has now dropped 13 of its last 14 games - its worst stretch since at least 2005. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 29th in Triple-A in batting average (.222), 28th in OBP (.309), 29th in SLG (.338), 29th in OPS (.647), tied for 24th in hits (105) and 29th in runs scored (50). On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered the sixth-most hits (137) and tied for the 10th-most runs (85) on the seventh-worst BAA (.280) and 10th-worst OPS-against (.824).

### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 33-for-109 (.303/.451/.615/1.066) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 19 RBIs, 27 walks and 18 runs scored in 32 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in OPS, fourth in slugging percentage, fifth in on-base percentage, tied for ninth in walks, tied for 11th in home runs, tied for 14th in extra-base hits (17) and 18th in batting average. After posting a 22.4 percent line drive rate and 30.6 percent pull rate with Triple-A Las Vegas in 323 plate appearances with Triple-A Las Vegas in 2023, Bride has compiled a 29.5 percent line drive rate (26th in Triple-A) and 46.1 percent pull rate this season with Jacksonville.

### WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 147 walks issued are the third-fewest in the International League entering play on Thursday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in seven of the last 11 games. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 22 out of 41 contests (53.7 percent).

### SHRIMP BITES

**Patrick Monteverde** posted a 3.12 ERA in his first five outings of the year. However, over his last two starts, he has ceded 12 runs, 11 earned, in 10.0 innings (12 H, 3 BB, 8 K).

## ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.
