LAST TIME OUT: Royce Lewis homered twice to help St. Paul rally back from a 4-1 deficit, but the St. Paul Saints fell 7-6 to the Omaha Storm Chasers Saturday night at CHS Field. The Saints offense got started right away as Kaelen Culpepper drilled the first pitch he saw in the bottom of the first to stake a 1-0 lead, Culpepper's 10th of the season and his fourth this year to lead off a ballgame. Omaha took their first lead in the top of the second when nine-spot hitter Dustin Dickerson came through with two outs, a two-run double that flipped it to a 2-1 Omaha advantage. The Storm Chasers added two more in the sixth when Luca Tresh went deep to center, his fifth of the year. In the sixth, Lewis led off with a homer before three consecutive walks against Henry Williams. Ricardo Olivar tied the game at 4-4 with a two-out single. Lewis gave the Saints the lead with his second of the game in the eighth, but Omaha grabbed the lead back in the ninth when Dickerson tagged Alejandro Hidalgo for his first home run of the year.

SIR HENDRY: Following back-to-back games with a homer, Saints outfielder Henry Mendez drew three walks on Saturday night, the seventh time in his career he's drawn at least three free passes in a game. Since being called up to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, he has reached base in 15 consecutive games, the second player in the Saints' franchise history for a player making their debut at the level (see below). The Twins' No. 12 ranked prospect per MLB.com has an active 24 game reached base streak going back to April 21 including his time this year with Double-A Wichita.

LEADING OFF WITH A BANG: After adding two more inning-opening blasts on Saturday, the Saints continue to lead baseball with 26 homers to lead off innings this year. Kaelen Culpepper (6), Orlando Arcia (4), Aaron Sabato (3), Royce Lewis (2), Alex Jackson (2), and Emmanuel Rodriguez (2) have all touched off for at least two home runs to lead off an inning each this year. Culpepper now has 10 home runs this year, four of which have led off games for the Saints, including two on the first pitch:

FEDKO, DON'T YA KNOW: Saints outfielder Kyler Fedko produced his second four extra-base hit game this year on Wednesday, going 4-for-5 with 2 HR & 2 doubles. It marks Fedko's first game with four or more extra bases since his 3-homer, triple game on April 12 @Toledo, a performance in which Fedko tied the Saints' franchise record by notching 15 total bases. Fedko is one of two players in either MLB or MiLB with multiple games of 4+ XBH this season (also: Henry Bolte, in two games vs the Saints on May 8-9 in Las Vegas). Fedko currently ranks 6th in the International League in slugging% (.589) and 9th in OPS (.966) on the season. Starting with his three-homer game in Toledo, the Pittsburgh-area native is slashing, .336/.432/.708, ranking 3rd in the IL in OPS (1.140, min 100 PA) in 30 games over that stretch.

DOMO ARIGATO, MR. SABATO: Saints first baseman Aaron Sabato has homered three times over the course of a current nine-game hitting streak, a stretch where the 2020 first-round pick is 13-for-36 (.361) at the plate with nine extra base hits. His eight homers in his previous 16 games is tied for the most in Minor League Baseball since May 5. After riding the bench in 12 of the first 16 games of the season for St. Paul, Sabato has started 28 of 33 games since April 16. In that stretch, the former UNC Tarheel is hitting .330 (33-for-100) with all ten of his homers this year and is producing an 1.162 OPS that ranks 2nd among all Triple-A hitters with at least 100 PA in that run. Although he is not yet a "qualified" hitter, Sabato ranks 2nd among all IL hitters with at least 80 PA in slugging% (.681) and ranks 3rd in OPS (1.046) overall on the season.

SAINTLY SLUGGERS: After blasting a ridiculous 24 home runs in a seven-game span from May 2-9, the Saints have hit 16 round-trippers in their last 12 games since. Over their last 19 contests (circa May 2), the Saints are tied for the MLB/MiLB lead in homers (484, lead all of baseball in team OPS (.990) and SLG% (.572), and are 2nd in runs scored (150, 7.9/gm). The Saints have homered in 29 of their past 36 games and have not gone back-to-back games without a homer since April 10-11 in Toledo. The Saints currently tout eight hitters with at least five homers on the season, but only as recently as Wednesday saw their first two hitters (Fedko & Sabato) reach double-digits in dongs this season.

YOU'RE HOT & YOU'RE COLD...: Although the Saints have dropped five of their last seven games after Saturday, St. Paul are still 16-9 over their past 25 games since April 25, tied for the 3rd-best record in Triple-A in that span (Rochester are 18-7). During the run, the Saints have outscored their opponents 178-130 (+48) after they were a -38 (112-150) over their first 24 games to start the season in which they went 9-15. Over their last 25 games, St. Paul rank 2nd in the Int'l League in team AVG and runs scored and lead the league in team OPS. Although their staff ERA in that run ranks 9th, their SO:BB ratio of 2.46 is 3rd in the Int'l League.

LAST APPEARANCE: Threw in relief in his Triple-A debut on Wednesday at CHS Field...entered the game in the fourth and retired Drew Waters before allowing a one out double to Kameron Misner...struck out Luca Tresh and Abraham Toro for his first two punchouts at the Triple-A level...issued a one out walk and yielded a pair of two out singles to concede a run in the 5th...faced the minimum with the help of a line drive double play in a scoreless sixth...threw 15 changeups (29%), 13 cutters (25%), 13 sliders (25%), 9 four-seamers (18%) and 1 sinker (2%)...generated six swings-and-misses
