TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes complete their final home stand of the regular season this afternoon with the final game of the regular season against the Lake Elsinore Storm (San Diego Padres). Today, we say thanks to the fans for joining us here in 2022, as it's been another fun year. Kids can Run the Bases after the game today to celebrate the end of the year!

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the last of 30 head-to-head meetings between the two teams and the 12th of 12 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 4-7 at home vs the Storm and 14-15 overall against the Storm in 2022.

LAST GAME: Saturday's action included the completion of Friday's game, a come-from-behind 15-12 victory for the Lake Elsinore Storm in ten innings. Game two of last night's double-header saw the Storm hold on for a 2-1 seven-inning win over the Quakes to sweep the double-header and send Rancho to their fourth straight loss overall. Kyle Froemke (2), Dalton Rushing (8) and Alex Freeland (3) all homered in game one, but the Quakes blew a three-run ninth inning lead. They'd rally in the bottom of the ninth to tie and force extras, but reliever Livan Reinoso (0-1) gave up three in the tenth and the Storm held on to win, 15-12. In the night-cap, the Quakes held the Storm to just three hits, but mustered only four hits themselves in the 2-1 defeat. Rancho starter Luis Valdez (0-1) pitched well, allowing two unearned runs over three innings, while striking out a career-best six batters in the tough-luck loss.

TEAM LEADERS: Today marks the end of the season, so here's a quick look at the team leaders in 2022. On the mound, Benony Robles led the team in victories (6), Jerming Rosario led the team in strikeouts (112) and Madison Jeffrey and Joan Valdez tied for the team lead in saves (4). At the plate, Yuni Garcia led the team in batting average (.305), home runs (13) and RBIs (76). Yeiner Fernandez led the team in hits (106), but Luis Rodriguez, who is playing today, is second with 103 and can catch or surpass him with a strong day at the plate. Luis Diaz led the club in stolen bases with 27.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: Earlier today, catcher Dalton Rushing was sent to Great Lakes, so that he can join the Loons for the upcoming Midwest League Playoffs. The Quakes made a total of four transactions on Saturday, as they moved Friday night's starter, LHP Maddux Bruns and RHP Joel Ibarra to the Arizona Complex League roster. Taking their spots on the respective roster are INF Julio Carrion and C Marco Hernandez. On Friday, LHP Benony Robles and RHP Chris Campos, both of whom made their final appearances of 2022 on Thursday, were moved to the Arizona Complex League roster. Taking their respective spots are LHP Luis Valdez and INF Kyle Nevin, who was activated and in the starting lineup on Friday.

CONGRATS TO THE 66ERS: The 66ers' Tuesday win over Visalia eliminated Rancho Cucamonga from the playoff pictures and gave Inland Empire their first trip to the playoffs since 2013, as they'll face the first-half champion Lake Elsinore Storm in a best-of-three South Division Finals, starting next Tuesday in San Bernardino. The last time the Quakes missed the playoffs (excluding last year's Covid-altered playoffs) was in 2014, when they finished 65-75 under Manager P.J. Forbes.

NORTH UPDATE: The playoff picture is clear up north as well, as Fresno's win on Tuesday eliminated Modesto from second-half contention, meaning, thanks to a better overall record than Modesto, the San Jose Giants earn the wild card and will now host first-half North champ Fresno on Tuesday in San Jose for game one of the best-of-three North Division Finals. The Giants defeated the Grizzlies in last year's Championship Series.

JACOB MEADOR: Right-hander Jacob Meador makes his fifth appearance and second start for the Quakes. In his last outing, he opened game one of this series on September 6, allowing two runs on two hits over 1.2 innings of work in a no-decision. Meador was selected by the Dodgers in the 12th round of the 2022 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

JARED KOLLAR: Right-hander Jared Kollar makes the spot-start today for Lake Elsinore, as he makes his seventh appearance and third start overall. Earlier this series, Kollar allowed one run on two hits over 1.1 innings of relief in a no-decision on September 8. Kollar was signed as an undrafted free agent out of Rutgers here in 2022.
