NEWS & NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: LUGNUTS 1, CHIEFS 0 (SIX INNINGS)

The Lugnuts scored their lone run in the first inning before a pitcher's duel ensued until lightning and rain shortened the game, handing the Chiefs a series loss in the sixth inning last night at Jackson Field...Peoria starter Jacob Odle hit Pedro Pineda with his first pitch of the game...Pineda stole second, advanced to third on catcher Cade McGee's throwing error and scored on Daniel Bucciero's RBI single to give Lansing a 1-0 lead...The game turned into a pitcher's duel from there...Peoria stranded the bases loaded in the third before having two runners cut down at the plate in the fourth...Odle exited in the fifth after allowing just one unearned run on three hits over 4.2 innings...He struck out seven and walked two...Marcheco tossed 5.2 scoreless innings, giving up four hits while walking two and striking out five...Petrutz hit a two-out double in the top of the sixth before Lugnuts manager Javier Godard took the ball from Marcheco...As Lansing reliever Mitch Meyers threw his warmup pitches, lightning struck in the vicinity, sending the game into a delay before rain quickly followed...After a 55-minute delay, the game was called with the tying run at second with two outs in the sixth...

ONE-RUN WOES

With last night's one-run loss, the Chiefs have now dropped eight of their last 13 one-run games, including three this week against Lansing. It also marked Peoria's 13th series loss of the season and third straight since sweeping the Kernels in Cedar Rapids from July 28-Aug. 2. The Chiefs were just 2.5 games out of first place on Aug. 14, but less than 10 days later sit 9.5 games back after dropping seven of their last eight.

TRIPLE THREAT

Anyelo Encarnación went 4-for-4 with two triples, a double and three runs scored Friday night, finishing a home run shy of what would have been Peoria's third cycle of the season (Tai Peete, 2). He became the first Chief with two triples in a game since Juan Yopez in April 2018 and just the seventh Chief since at least 2005 to record a multi-triple game. Harrison Bader (2015) and Tommy Edman (2017) are also on that list. The four-hit night marked Encarnación's second career four-hit game, with both coming as a Chief after he also completed the feat last August. Anyelo went 0-2 last night.

FLO-ING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

-Chiefs infielder Jalin Flores' 100th hit of the season was a solo home run Thursday night. He became the fourth Midwest Leaguer to the milestone this season, joining Great Lakes' Chuck Davalan and Eduardo Quintero and Quad Cities' Asbel Gonzalez. Only six other Chiefs have racked up 100 hits in a season since 2021: Nathan Church (127, '23), Jimmy Crooks (112, '23), Brody Moore (105, '24), Jon Jon Gazdar (103, '25), LJ Jones (103, '22) and Osvaldo Tovalin (103, '23). Of those 100 hit seasons, Flores is the only player with more than 13 HRs. Flores now has 101 hits. -Flores' 17th home run of the season Thursday night tied Jack Gurevitch for the most by a Chief in a single season in the High-A era. Gurevitch was promoted to AA-Springfield on August 4 after hitting 17 homers with Peoria. He has added one homer in 14 games with Springfield. The Chiefs' all-time single-season record is Joe Freitas' 33 home runs in 1997.

WELCOME TO HIGH-A

The Chiefs' eight new offensive additions since August 4 combined to hit just .196 (42-for-214) with a .606 OPS, five home runs, 87 strikeouts and 22 walks before breaking out Friday night. The group went 7-for-20 (.350) with a home run and five RBIs. However, five of the eight in last night's lineup combined to go 0-for-11 at the plate.

CLEAN NINTH

Christian Worley's scoreless ninth inning on Friday lowered Peoria's ninth-inning ERA to 1.82, fourth best in affiliated baseball. The Chiefs have allowed a ninth-inning run in just two games since June 20.

EXTRA, EXTRA

Eight of the Chiefs' 14 hits Friday night went for extra bases, their first game with 8+ XBH since July 29. Peoria has reached that mark nine times this season. The Chiefs' 407 extra-base hits lead the Midwest League and rank third in High-A, behind Greensboro (Pirates) and Everett (Mariners). Two of Peoria's four hits yesterday went for extra bases.

TRENDING CHIEFS

- Sammy Hernandez's on-base streak is 20 games, batting .308 this season with a 1.025 OPS and six of his 10 homers during the stretch. He also had a 22-game streak from May 8-July 11.
- Anyelo Encarnación is 5-for-11 (.455) with 3 XBH (2 3B, 1 2B) this week.
- Michael Dattalo is 1-for-11 (.091) this week with a double and a strikeout.

The Cardinal Nation - Scouting Report:

Brian Holiday is a polished, undersized, pitchability righty who doesn't have loud stuff but put up great numbers in college and on the Cape while throwing a ton of strikes. He's a fastball heavy pitcher with his four-seamer accounting for over 50% of his pitches in his final season at Oklahoma State but he also throws a slider, a curveball, and a changeup.

The fastball and the slider look like solid pitches, but the curveball and the changeup lag a bit behind, and the stuff overall isn't too loud. The real plus is Holiday's above average command which enabled him to walk just 4.2% of the batters he faced in 2024.

SEASON NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - Allowed five runs on nine hits in his final start with Palm Beach before his promotion to High-A Peoria...Struck out six without issuing a walk for the second straight start...

GOOD COMMAND: Has walked just 12 batters in 60.1 innings during his first professional season...Hasn't issued a walk in 9.1 innings this month...

STRIKEOUT MACHINE: Has struck out 71 batters in 60.1 innings this season... Fanned a career-high 12 in his first of two August starts...

HOME vs ROAD: Has posted a 2.78 ERA at home compared to an 8.04 ERA on the road..

WHAT A DAY - 8/5 : Struck out a career-high 12 without a walk over 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits in his Aug. 5 start against Jupiter...

ABOUT JACOB

DRAFT DAY: Drafted by Cardinals in 3rd Round of 2024 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State...Cardinals scouting director Randy Flores called Holiday "competitive, intriguing and compelling", saying that the right-hander "gained momentum and continued to improve".

JUCO BANDIT: Zero scholarship offers to play college baseball; spent two years as a reliever in JUCO...Walk-on at Florida Southwestern State in 2022 to the even smaller Central Florida in 2023...At Central Florida, Holiday led national JUCO pitchers in strikeouts and helped his team win the Junior College World Series, for which he was named Most Outstanding Player...

BIG-12 DAYS: Allowed 82 hits and 19 walks with a conference-best 128 strikeouts in 113 innings in his junior year at Oklahoma State...Coached by Josh Holli-day, brother of former Cardinal Matt (different spelling and unrelated to Brian)

THROWBACK: Sports an old-fashioned high leg kick and 12-6 curveball...

TOMMY JOHN: Underwent TJ surgery May 2025...made pro debut May 2, 2026

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO ESPINOZA

MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

MIKE HABAS

HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.

MICHAEL OH

PITCHING COACH

Michael Oh, 28, joins the Chiefs for his second season in the Cardinals organization. The Northbrook, Illinois native began his time coaching in the pro ranks with the Palm Beach Cardinals last season, guiding a number of future Chiefs hurlers. Oh pitched four seasons of college baseball, one at North Iowa Area Community College, two at North Carolina and one at Charlotte. After completing his career with the 49ers in 2022, he was added to the Charlotte coaching staff as the pitching coordinator. He was promoted to pitching coach for the 2024 season, where he guided the 49ers to the program record 10.45 K/9 rate.

JASON EARY

BENCH COACH

Another newcomer to the Cardinals organization, Jason Eary will spend his first season coaching professional baseball in Peoria. Eary joins the Cardinals organization after three seasons with St. Louis University, where he coached Billikens infielders. Eary got his coaching start at UNLV, where he served in a player development role. A Las Vegas native, Eary earned an undergraduate degree in Kinesiology from Cal-State Fullerton, where he worked as a baseball manager for four seasons, including the Titans run to the College World Series in 2017.

WADE STAUSS

ASSISTANT COACH

A familiar face to Chiefs fans, Wade Stauss will spend his first full season as a coach in Peoria. Stauss, 26, was signed by the Cardinals as an undrafted free agent in 2021 after four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. The catcher played 26 games with the Chiefs across two seasons, including a two-home run game on June 28, 2022 at Quad Cities. Stauss played at all four full-season levels of the Cardinals system and appeared in 138 games before transitioning to coaching prior to the end of 2025.

KILY GILBERT

ATHLETIC TRAINER

Kily Gilbert is the Chiefs certified athletic trainer after she joined the Cardinals system in November after a previous stint with the Houston Astros. Gilbert originates from southern Oregon and attended Oregon State for her undergraduate and master's studies. She obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in kinesiology in 2019 and her master's degree in athletic training in 2021. Gilbert worked with the OSU football team when she was a student. She was a former intern for the San Francisco 49ers.
