HIGHLIGHTS

HARDMAN HAPPENINGS: Tyler Hardman has homered in all three games he's played this series. It marks the first time in his career that he has homered in three straight games. His most recent home run in the first inning on Saturday had an exit velocity of 111.5 mph, which is a new personal record for Hardman. Austin Wells is the only Patriot to have homered in four straight games this season (5/5-9).

ENTERING ORBIT: Jasson Dominguez enters today with a 10-game on-base streak in tact, tied for his longest of the season. During the streak, he is 10-for-35 (.286/.457/.486) with 11 BB, 7 RBI, 6 R, 2 HR and a .943 OPS. After his eighth multi-hit game of the season on Saturday night, Dominguez is now hitting a season-best .210 on the season.

TOP OF THE HEAP: This week's series features the two teams who represented the Northeast Division in the 2022 Eastern League Playoffs. This season, with three series remaining in the first half, Somerset trails Portland by 3.5 games for first place in the Northeast division. In 11 games between the Patriots and Sea Dogs this season, 6 have been decided by two runs or less. POWER VS. PORTLAND: Last season, the Patriots hit 46 HR in 24 games against the Sea Dogs, which was their most against any Eastern League team in 2022. In 11 games against Portland this year, Somerset has hit 19 HR, its most against any Eastern League team.

SO LONG, SEA DOGS: After today, the Patriots and Sea Dogs will not play each other again until August 29 - September 3, Somerset's penultimate road trip of the season. After today, there will be three weeks remaining in the first half. The Patriots' final road trip of the first half will take place next week in Hartford, before they return home for the only two-week home stand of the season vs. Altoona and New Hampshire. 2023: In his second start of the season and at the Double-A level on 4/12/23 @BNG, Fitts struck out a career-high 10 batters, which was the most he had struck out in a game since high school. Fitts earned his first Double-A win in his fourth start of the season on 4/26/23 @HBG with six shutout innings.

2022: Split his pro debut season between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, winning Pitcher of the Week honors three times en route to being named a MiLB.com Yankees Organization All-Star in 2022. Began the season with 17 GS in Tampa, going 3-8 with a 5.01 ERA (79.0 IP, 73 H, 93 K, 17 BB). Won his first Florida State League Pitcher of the Week award on 6/27/22, after going 6.0 IP with 6 K, BB and allowing just one hit on 6/25/22 vs. CLR. During his final week with Single-A Tampa, won FSL Pitcher of the Week for a second time on 8/8/22, following another 6 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 7 K performance on 8/5/22 vs. CLR. Promoted to Hudson Valley on 8/9/22. Earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week honors after he took a perfect game into the eighth inning on 8/27/22 vs. HIC (8.0 IP, ER, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K). Struck out a career-high nine batters in his penultimate start of the season on 9/1/22 vs. JS. Across 5 GS to end the season in Hudson Valley, Fitts went 4-0 with a 0.55 ERA (2 ER in 33.0 IP) with a 0.61 WHIP and .152 BAA. Cumulatively on the year, he went 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA and his 0.98 WHIP was the lowest of any qualifying Yankees minor leaguer in 2022.

2021: Did not pitch following the 2021 MLB Draft.

College: In three seasons at Auburn (2019-21), went 6-6 with a 5.23 ERA in 40 appearances (14 starts). Heading into his junior season at Auburn, he was named Second Team Preseason All-America by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-America by Baseball America and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.

Personal Notes: Attended Helena High School (AL) and was named a 2018 Rawlings-Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American, after posting 102 K with a 1.68 ERA as a senior. Named a 2017 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention All-American, after he missed most of the season with an injury, but Helena won the AHSAA 6A State Championship and finished No. 1 in a national poll. Named All-Shelby County Honorable Mention as a sophomore. Brother, Trevor, played baseball at Mississippi State, before becoming an assistant coach at Austin Peay and now at the Tigers' High-A affiliate in West Michigan. Fitts grew up a Washington Nationals fan from the point that Stephen Strasburg debuted with the team, because he admired Strasburg growing up. **Career Notes:** Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (1st year)

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. During the summer of 2019, Wells played in the Cape Cod League with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox. Wells spent his preps career at powerhouse Bishop Gorman High School in his hometown of Las Vegas, combining to hit .428 with 87 RBI and 85 during his preps career. He was named team captain and Most Valuable Player as a junior and senior. As a junior, Wells was the 2017 Nevada Gatorade Player of the Year. Upon graduating high school, Wells was originally selected by the Yankees in the 35th round of the 2018 MLB Draft. After electing to play college ball at Arizona, the Yankees selected him again in the first round of the draft two years later, 28th overall. For the second consecutive season, Wells is living with close friend and former teammate Anthony Volpe's family in Watchung, New Jersey.
