# **UPCOMING GAMES & PROBABLE PITCHERS**

2026 Opening Day

YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 7-2, for their fourth straight win. Hartford took a 2-0 lead in the second with a two-run homer by Bryant Betancourt. In the bottom of the fourth, Zach Morgan brought in a run with a sacrifice fly to close the score to 2-1. The Flying Squirrels scored six runs in the fifth to pull ahead, 7-2. Diego Velasquez tied the score with an RBI single. Nate Furman worked a bases-loaded walk for a 3-2 lead. Scott Bandura hit a two-out, three-run double and scored on a double by Morgan to cap the frame. Cam Hillier threw two scoreless innings, extending his scoreless streak to 10 innings since being promoted to Double-A. Evan Gates threw 2.1 innings and Chris Wright recorded the final five outs.

**DIAMONDS AREN'T FOREVER:** Today, the Flying Squirrels play the last game of the final series at The Diamond before moving to neighboring CarMax Park for the 2026 season. The Diamond has been home to professional baseball in Richmond for four decades. From 1985-2008, it served as the home ballpark for the Richmond Braves, Atlanta's Triple-A club. Since 2010, it has been the Flying Squirrels' home. Since the first game at The Diamond on April 17, 1985, the ballpark has hosted 16,664,684 fans, including 6,176,462 in the Flying Squirrels' 15 seasons. This week's series has drawn 42,217 fans in five games, an average of 8,443 per game.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,721 fans per home game, which leads Double-A and ranks sixth among all 120 MiLB clubs. They have drawn a total of 436,869, which combined Sunday's sellout will be the highest since 2011. Their current average is the highest in franchise history. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history. The Flying Squirrels have led all 30 Double-A teams in total and average attendance each of the last three seasons, which had not been done prior to 2022. This year will mark the 10th time in the Flying Squirrels' 15 seasons that they led the Eastern League in average attendance. Richmond's 2025 average attendance will be the highest for any team in the Eastern League since 2005.

**A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS:** Today marks the 65th sellout in the Flying Squirrels' 15 seasons at The Diamond and their fifth this season. Today also marks the first time in franchise history the Flying Squirrels have sold out three consecutive games. The team is 47-31 all time in sellouts, which includes four doubleheaders.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game, season-ending series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This is the first series between these two teams since the Yard Goats came to The Diamond last August for a six-game series split. The Flying Squirrels are 9-1 in their last 10 home games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four consecutive games. The Flying Squirrels have not allowed an earned run in three consecutive games. The Flying Squirrels threw 29 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run from the ninth inning of Tuesday's game through the first inning of Saturday's game. In their four-game win streak, the Richmond pitching staff has posted a 0.50 ERA (2 ER/36.0 IP). The only two earned runs in that span were on a second-inning, two-run homer by Hartford's Bryant Betancourt in the second inning on Saturday night. Since Wednesday, the Richmond offense leads the league with a .283 (36-for-127) and are tied for the league lead with 19 runs scored.

THE YARD GOATS are in third place in the Northeast Division second-half standings and were eliminated from the postseason chase on Thursday night. They split last week's series at home against Reading, dropping the final two games on Saturday and Sunday. Hartford's roster features six players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects list, including OF/3B Charlie Condon (No. 2), OF Jared Thomas (No. 3), OF Cole Carrigg (No. 4), LHP Weinton Herrera (No. 12), 2B Roc Riggio (No. 16) and LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 18). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list features nine Hartford players, including Condon (No. 2), Carrigg (No. 3), Thomas (No. 8), Riggio (No. 11), Sullivan (No. 13), Herrera (No. 20), LHP Konner Eaton (No. 22), LHP Michael Prosecky (No. 23) and LHP Ben Shields (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his second start of the season. He last pitched in the first game of the series on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats, allowing one run over 3.2 innings with five strikeouts. It was his longest outing since returning from injury. On September 3, Murphy made his first start since June 1, 2024 after missing the second half of last year and most of this season while recovering from Tommy John surgery. Murphy is in his fourth season with the Flying Squirrels. He first reached Double-A for two starts in 2022 before a season-ending injury. After spending all of the 2023 season at Double-A, he made 11 starts last season, going 1-4 with a 3.35 ERA before an injury kept him out until August of this year. Murphy was selected by the Giants in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne (N.Y.) College. **For more on Murphy, see page two.** 

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Connor Staine makes his 25th start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. In his last outing last Sunday against Reading, he threw four innings and allowed three runs on three hits and four walks. Staine was selected in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Rockies out of the University of Central Florida. He also played two seasons at the University of Maryland. Staine is in his first Double-A season.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey, Zach Morgan, Onil Perez and Drew Cavanaugh have combined to catch 72 stolen base attempts this season, which first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 50 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has set a franchise record for the most caught stealing in a season in Flying Squirrels history, passing Jackson Williams' mark of 35 set in 2015 with his 36th on July 26 against Portland. For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 63 runners caught stealing for his career is the most in franchise history, passing Williams' (2010-11, '15) previous mark of 59.

**BERI BOMBS: Victor Bericoto** has 12 homers this season, which leads all Richmond players for the year. Last Saturday night, he hit the 34th homer of his Flying Squirrels career, moving him ahead **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22) for second on the franchise's all-time homer list. He is three behind **Ricky Oropesa's** (2013-16) franchise record of 37. Bericoto now has 140 career RBIs with Richmond, trailing only Oropesa's record of 165. In his last 38 games since August 1, Bericoto is batting .336 (46-for-137) with four homers, five doubles, two triples, 17 walks and 23 RBIs.

IT'S BO TIME!: Bo Davidson is batting .284 (19-for-67) with five homers, two doubles and nine RBIs in his last 15 games dating back to August 23. He also posted a nine-game hit streak from August 23-September 2. On August 29 against the Rubber-Ducks, he had his second two-homer game at Double-A and drove in three runs. Davidson has reached base in 22 consecutive games dating back to August 15, which is the longest streak by a Flying Squirrels player since 2023.

SECOND-HALF SABIN: In his last 19 games since August 9, Sabin Ceballos is batting .382 (26-for-68) with three homers, seven doubles and 18 RBIs. For the season, he is second on the team with 47 RBIs. He had four consecutive multi-hit and multi-RBI games to close the last home series against Akron. In his last 42 games since July 3, Ceballos is batting .311 (46-for-148) with six homers, 11 doubles and 29 RBIs.

**TAKE A WALK:** Diego Velasquez has worked 70 walks this year, which is the second-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history, passing Hayden Cantrelle's 2023 mark (66). Jacob Heyward set a new record with 80 walks in 2019 Velasquez is second in the Eastern League in walks this season, trailing only Reading's Aidan Miller (73), who has been promoted to Triple-A.

**THE FURMANATOR:** Since joining the Richmond roster on September 2, **Nate Furman** is batting .370 (10-for-27) with five walks and four RBIs. On Friday night, he finished a homer shy of the cycle, going 4-for-4 with a double, a triple, an RBI and two runs scored. In his last week with High-A Eugene before being bumped up to Double-A, Furman was named the Northwest League Player of the Week after batting .458 (11-for-24) with five homers, a double, seven walks and 11 RBIs in a six-game series at Everett from August 26-31, posting a 1.719 OPS for the week. Furman was traded to the Giants from the Guardians on August 26, 2024.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is second in walks (70), fourth in hits (121) and fifth in OBP (.365). Turner Hill is tied for ninth in triples (5). John Michael Bertrand is first in ERA (2.87), third in innings pitched (131.2), fifth in BAA (.249) and sixth in WHIP (1.31). Jack Choate is sixth in strikeouts (123). Joe Whitman is fifth in strikeouts (124) and eighth in ninings pitched (117.1). Tyler Myrick is second in saves (10).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 270 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bo Davidson (No. 3), Diego Velasquez (No. 10), Joe Whitman (No. 11) and Jack Choate (No. 30). John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. Adrian Sugastey is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Aeverson Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 5), Whitman (No. 14) and Velasquez (No. 21).

# THIS DATE IN RICHMOND

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

2021: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 6-3, at UPMC Park. Sandro Fabian hit a two-run homer in the second for an early Richmond lead. Brandon Martorano added a sacrifice fly in the fourth. In the bottom of the fourth, Andre Lipcius hit an RBI double for Erie to close the score to 3-1. With the bases loaded in the top of the fifth, Mitchell Tolman was hit by a pitch and Martorano worked a walk. David Villar hit a solo homer in the sixth to open a 6-1 lead and became the first player in franchise history to reach 20 home runs in a season. Drew Ward hit a two-run homer for Erie in the bottom of the sixth. Akeel Morris started for the Flying Squirrels and allowed three runs over 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts. Frank Rubio, RJ Dabovich and Patrick Ruotolo combined for 3.1 scoreless relief innings.

2023: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 7-3, at UPMC Park to clinch a postseason berth for the second consecutive year. The win secured the Southwest Division's second-half title. It was the Flying Squirrels' 12th win in their last 14 games. Victor Bericoto hit a solo homer in the sixth inning to open a 1-0 lead. Later in the inning, Logan Wyatt scored on a wild pitch and Will Wilson hit an RBI single to open a 3-0 lead. In the top of the eighth, Shane Matheny worked a bases-loaded walk and Brady Whalen hit a three-run double to extend the lead to 7-0. John Michael Betrand threw six scoreless innings, holding Erie to four hits. Tyler Myrick entered to record the final out and close his sixth save. close his sixth save.
